DR. SILVER RETURNS TO U.S.; DENIES HE INTENDS TO SETTLE IN ISRAEL

TEL AVIV, March 15. (JTA) -- Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, American Zionist leader, left Israel today for the United States following a short visit to this country. He denied reports that he intended to settle in Israel. "American Jewry is now more in need of leadership than Israel," he said, adding that he could not see what there was for him to do in Israel.

Dr. Silver stated that he had been impressed by the progress made by Israel in the economic and security fields but that he felt that "not enough is being done to educate the younger generation in the spirit of Zionist principles or toward a better understanding of the Jewish people and the diaspora."

MR. AND MRS. ARCHIBALD SILVERMAN HONORED FOR SERVICE TO JEWRY

PROVIDENCE, R.I., March 15. (JTA) -- Mr. and Mrs. Archibald Silverman, noted figures in the Zionist movement, were honored at a dinner given here last night by the Roger Williams Lodge of B'nai B'rith on the occasion of Mrs. Silverman's 50 years of service to world Jewish causes and Mr. Silverman's 80th birthday.

Mrs. Silverman is the founder of the Israel Synagogue Building Fund, which has financed the construction of synagogues in settlements throughout Israel. The fund is under the auspices of the Keren Hayesod. Mr. Silverman has been active in the United Jewish Appeal and in the Zionist movement.
