HIS EXCELLENCY, MR. LEVI ESHKOL, FINANCE MINISTER OF ISRAEL, WILL BE THE GUEST OF THE CLEVELAND JEWISH COMMUNITY ON MONDAY EVENING, OCTOBER 10, 1960. WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, ARE INVITING A LIMITED NUMBER OF MEN FROM OUR BUSINESS AND INDUSTRIAL COMMUNITY TO MEET WITH MR. ESHKOL. WE TAKE PLEASURE IN EXTENDING TO YOU AN INVITATION TO BE OUR GUEST FOR DINNER THAT EVENING AT THE OAKWOOD CLUB AT 6:30 P. M.

THE PURPOSE OF MR. ESHKOL'S VISIT IS TO ACQUAINT US WITH THE ECONOMIC GROWTH OF ISRAEL AND WITH ITS NEW PROGRAM FOR STIMULATING INDUSTRIAL EXPANSION THROUGH PRIVATE INVESTMENT. On July 5, 1961, the Government of Israel announced the following:

"At 4:41 a.m. today, a successful attempt was made to send a meteorological rocket into space from the Mediterranean shore. The rocket was planned, built and fired by a crew of Israeli scientists and technicians. The purpose of the experiment was achieved.

The firing was witnessed by Premier David Ben Gurion and other officials. The purpose of the experiment was to obtain information on conditions in the stratosphere and ionosphere.

The rocket, the "SHAVIT 2" (Meteor 2), used a solid propellant fuel developed in Israel. "SHAVIT 2" is multistaged. It weighs from 550 to 660 pounds and is capable of reaching a maximum altitude of 50 to 60 miles. The final stage of the rocket exploded a cloud of sodium at its maximum height, enabling scientists to determine prevailing conditions at that altitude. The rocket did not contain transmitting equipment.

Israel is the 7th country to send a meteorological rocket into space. The others are the United States, the Soviet Union, France, Britain, Italy and Japan."
