# **Latest Portrait Of Rabbi Silver Going to Israel**

This oil portrait of Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver of The Temple was requested by the Republic of Israel to hang in its Gallery of Free Men in Tel Aviv.

It was painted by Sylvia Cohn Saul, 2258 Harcourt Dr., Cleveland Heights, who was graduated in portraiture under Rolf Stoll from the Cleveland Institute of Art.

After Tuesday, the portrait will be on display for several weeks at The Temple, E. 105 St. at Ansel Rd., before it is shipped.

Eventually the portraits of all men so honored by the Israel government will be permanently installed in the Tel Aviv city hall, which is to be built soon.

Thank you for giving this matter your early attention.

Of course a photograph will do if no oil painting can be made available and indeed, out of the 33 pictures of the Freeman several are photographs. Considering, however, that this Gallery is in the Council Chamber where it is always on view and whence it will eventually be moved to its permanent home in the Town Hall which we hope to build in the not-too-distant future, for the edification of future generations as to the men whom the City delighteth to honour - we think that portraits the handwork of an artist would be more appropriate. Invariably such portraits have been presented to us by the families of the Freeman or by Institutions with whom they have been connected. Thus the painting of Rabbi Stephen Wise came from the family, that of Henrietta Szold from Hadassah and the one of Bronislaw Huberman from the Philharmonic Orchestra.

Should you decide to let us have a photograph may we ask that it be 50X 60 cms (preferably on a dark background) this being the uniform size of all the photographs.
