Considering, however, that this Gallery is in the Council Chamber where it is always on view and whence it will eventually be moved to its permanent home in the Town Hall which we hope to build in the not-too-distant future, for the edification of future generations as to the men whom the City delighteth to honour - we think that portraits the handywork of an artist would be more appropriate. Invariably such portraits have been presented to us by the families of the Freemen or by Institutions with whom they have been connected. Thus the painting of Rabbi Stephen Wise came from the family, that of Henrietta Szold from Hadassah and the one of Bronislaw Huberman from the Philharmonic Orchestra.
