

Dear Rabbi Silver:

July 10, 1945, will mark the fifth anniversary of the death of the great leader of the Hebrew people, Vladimir Jabotinsky. These five years without Jabotinsky were the most tragic in the history of Hebrew martyrdom; these were the years when one third of our people were annihilated by a merciless foe. Jabotinsky, long before his death, foresaw the advent of the bloody storm. His passing on that fateful day in 1940, was the greatest shock to every Jewish community the world over. Never did his people need him more than during these terrible war years and the coming transitional period.

The fifth anniversary of Vladimir Jabotinsky's death will be honored by Jewish communities everywhere. In Palestine, it will be observed by a week of mourning. The Mayor of Tel-Aviv, Israel Rokach, is heading a Committee to arrange for the observance of this anniversary.

In New York, a Mass Memorial Meeting will be held on Tuesday evening, July 10, 1945, at Town Hall. We expect a most representative audience to be present to pay tribute to the memory of this great Hebrew leader.

May we ask you to accept our invitation to act as principle speaker at this Memorial Meeting.

We are anticipating a favorable reply.

This past year has been one of great strain and exertion and I must give myself a few weeks of absolute rest and recuperation. I am sure that you will understand.

I had the privilege of knowing Mr. Jabotinsky, not intimately, but sufficiently to recognize and admire his extraordinary spirit, the flame of his inspiration and his enkindling speech. He was a devoted and loyal son of Israel, of stout heart and dauntless vision, and he will be forever remembered as one of the architects of our national rebirth.
