Dear aba Hillel Silver,

I have just read an article in the Readers Digest of August 1942 by Mr. Herbert Hoover entitled "The Problems of Lasting Peace". It reminded me of our luncheon meeting with him when I was in New York at the beginning of 1941 and of your friendship with him.

In this article Mr. Hoover speaks of the need to restore the independence of all the peoples who have lost it. He mentions them all by name, including the handful of Albanians and Luxemburgers. He has thought of them all. Of one people there is no mention, even though they number 16 millions. I know it can be said he intended those whose independence was taken from them during the last few years. But he is elaborating a plan to solve the world's problems so that there be lasting peace. Is the Jewish problem then to remain unsolved?

I thought you might wish to write Mr. Hoover on the subject, if indeed you have not already done so.
