February 2, 1947 Mr. Gottlieb Hammer Jewish Agency For Palestine 16 E. 66th St. New York, N.Y. My dear Mr. Hammer: On the 12th of January I sent a cable to the Executive in Jerusalem, and on the 13th, to London. The Jerusalem cable amounted to \$50.16, and the London cable, \$20.24, making a total of \$70.40. There will from time to time be similar expenses which I, as chairman of the American Section of the Jewish Agency, will incur. Do you wish me to pay these bills here and then refund to me, or do you wish to pay them directly from New York? In connection with my visit to New York on Wednesday, December 29, I shall divide my expenses between the Jewish Agency and the Emergency Council inasmuch as I attended a meeting of the Emergency Council also on that day. The share of my expenses to the Agenc in connection with that meeting will therefore be \$25. With all good wishes, I remain Very sincerely yours, AHS: BK
