My dear Sam:

I tried to reach you by phone today, but was told that you would not be back in the city until Monday. Abe Luntz, with whom I discussed it, is also leaving for the East and I am leaving for Boston Sunday night and shall probably not be back before Wednesday.

Dr. Israel Goldstein, Treasurer of the Jewish Agency, is visiting five or six of the larger cities prior to his departure for Israel the end of this month. His objective is to raise a loan of a few million dollars to tide over the Jewish Agency for a period until the funds from the 1948-49 U.J.A. campaign are available to it. On account of the situation in Israel, the Jewish Agency has had to practically empty its treasury and meet the emergency demands of the war in Israel and of the huge immigration which is pouring into the country (18,000 in October alone; probably 25,000 in November).

This would be a short-time loan, as I understand it - 6 months or a year - on which interest would be paid. The notes would be those of the Jewish Agency guaranteed by the income of the Jewish Agency for 1948-49. This would probably amount to 80 to 90 million dollars. A similar loan was made last year and has been repaid.

I should like to invite about 40 to 50 people to a dinner meeting at the Oakwood Club to meet Dr. Goldstein and to listen to his story. It would be nice to have a letter of invitation sent out over the signature of 4 or 5 people. I should be glad to add my own signature to the number. I would suggest that the invitees be yourself, Abe Luntz, Mr. Glass, Mr. Ratner and perhaps one or two others.

My secretary, Miss Rice, will call you Monday. If the arrangement is agreeable to you, she will send out the invitations over these signatures. I would appreciate if you would contact the 3 or 4 signees and
