September 15, 1955 Dr. Abba Hillel Silver 19810 Shaker Blvd. Cleveland, Ohio Dear Dr. Silver: Again a year has passed by and I take this opportunity to send you and Mrs. Silver our best wishes for a happy and prosperous and Healthy New Year. I heard from Harold that you had a nice vacation in Europe. In the meantime, the elections in Israel and the general political conditions there have done nothing to clarify the situation. Also, here in the U. S., I have felt, while visiting several communities, that there is a better feeling towards the Zionist Movement than a few years ago. In the year ahead, we shall unfortunately have to go to a Zionist Congress, if the present leadership of the Movement does not decide to postpone it once more. I was very happy to hear that Daniel returned from Israel full of enthusiasm and I hope to have an opportunity to invite him to address our young group in New York in order to infuse them with a more militant attitude toward Zionism. All newspapers and radio described him as the greatest man in American Jewry and emphasized that he dediced to interrupt his long silence."
