November 26, 1943 Mr. Marvin A. Kane, President Jewish National Fund Council of Cleveland 3081 Washington Blvd. Cleveland Heights, Ohio My dear Friend: May I send to you and through you to the officers and members of the Jewish National Fund Conference my heartlest felicitations and good wishes for a successful year of service to our great cause. I had hoped to attend the Conference but unfortunately I must leave the city for the East in connection with the work of the Zionist Emergency Council. As you begin your new reject for the coming year in behalf of the Jewish National Fund, may I bespeak the whole-hearted cooperation of our community in this important and vital service to the cause of the upbuilding of the Jewish National Home. We have entered the hour of decision. Whatever we do now by way of acquiring new land in Palestine will strengthen our position when final decisions will be made. This is a time to mbbilize our maximum forces and to make our greatest sacrifices if we mean to win through to a better and happier day for our sorely tried people. Very cordially yours, AHS: BK
