



RECOMMENDATION SUBMITTED BY BRIGADIER GENERAL JULIUS KLEIN, PAST NATIONAL COMMANDER OF THE JEWISH WAR VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES, TO THE JWV AWARDS COMMITTEE.

I wish to place the name of Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver before
the JWV Awards Committee to be considered for the JWV Award of Merit,
the annual award given by JWV to an American for his outstanding
service to his fellow man and to his country.

I need not recount Rabbi Silver's contributions to his co-religionists and to his country. His many years of constant service and devotion to his fellow man and to the cause of democracy is legion.

No one has done more in influencing world opinion toward establishment of the state of Israel than Rabbi Silver. No one has worked more fervently and passionately toward the establishment of the citadel of democracy in the Middle East. Israel will always be an ally of the United States because of the support it received from leaders such as Rabbi Silver.

World-renowned, he reflects credit not only on American Jewry but more important on the entire concept of American democracy.

I strongly feel, therefore, that we, the Jewish War Veterans, would be remiss if we fail to give him the recognition he deserves and recommend that when the Awards Committee meets to choose the recipient of the 1951 JWV Award of Merit, it give favorable consideration to the name of Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver.

Since the Senator considers you one of his good friends, I am asking you to be kind enough to let me have your ideas and suggestions on how we can best lay the foundation for a successful campaign and resultant reelection of Senator Taft.

It is an open secret that certain labor circles are ready to spend millions to defeat Taft in Ohio. I believe he will be reelected if we all unite and give the best in us to retain the services of this great statesman. Won't you please let me have your views. I will as sthem on confidentially to the Senator and his close group of advisors.


