Yes the Valley Kfar Silver Women, s Committee will give a check for a full scholership of 600 dollars on Jan. 17, olso a pledge of perhaps one or two more in the near future, but the purpose of my wtiting to you is not to inform you of this, that you will find out from the regional office, my writing to you is to inquire of wtot happend to the Dr. Fred M. Falkman memoreal. Do you remember your promise to me in Washington at the Convention. that you will submit a sketch for approvel to Rabbi A.H. SilverPresident of the Cleveland Zionist Society. I would appreceate if you will pleace answer promptly. I dont know if it is proper for the widow to pursue action as I am, however had Fred Falkman not been my husband I asure you I would have presed more stongly for the completion of the memoreal. I am very mach ashamed and hart, after 2 years and 9 months with the funds avalable and knowing how inactive the C.Z.S. is since my husband died that there is no one in the Z.O.A. officce to think of preserving his name in Israel, for all his hard labor. I am going to Israel, araving April 3. antil April 21. I hope to visit Kfar Silver and if there is some kind of work for me there I shoul return after my tour is ended. I recived a card from Fraces Solomon today from Israel, how long will she be there. My best wishes to you and everyone I know in the office for a happy New Year.

Dear Mrs. Falkman:

I was delighted to receive your letter dated January 3rd, contents of which I have noted. I would like to congratulate you on obtaining your first full scholarship of \$600 in behalf of Kfar Silver.

With regard to your comments on the memorial for the late Dr. Fred Falkman, I am at a loss to understand what you write.

On the 30th of July, 1959, I wrote to Mr. W. G. Evans of Cleveland, asking him for a suitable text for the plaque to be placed in the clubroom. I am enclosing herewith a copy of the letter. We have informed the Cleveland Society on several occasions that the room, situated in dormitory No. 1, has already been set aside in honor of Dr. Falkman. Since it is their project, it is only right and proper that they give us the wording that they would like to have put on the plaque. Despite repeated requests to them we have been unable to elicit a reply from them. I would suggest, therefore, in order to ensure that this matter is taken care of prior to your arrival in Israel in April that you write personally to get the wording of the plaque. Once I receive the text I will forward it immediately to Israel and have the plaque made up and put into position in the clubroom. I know full well Mrs. Falkman how you feel on this subject and, of course, I am completely in agreement with you. I want to assure you, however that we here in the National Office have done everything we can to ensure the completion of this project. However, we have had very little cooperation from the people in Cleveland. Won't you please, therefore, let me hear from you further on this matter?

I returned from Israel last week after spending seven weeks there in behalf of the ZOA on matters related to the ZOA House and Kfar Silver.

I am sure you will be pleased to learn that Kfar Silver has developed into one of the most beautiful agricultural schools in Israel and the progress we made there is unbelievable. Should you happen to visit Israel in the near future you will derive a great deal of satisfaction from what you will find there.

While in Tel Aviv, Kfar Silver called my attention to your letter of last December 11th regarding an announcement made by Mr. Louis Kahn, an attorney in Memphis, who stated at a Bond meeting in your presence that one of his clients bequeathed a sum of \$10,000 to Kfar Silver.

All our attempts to locate Mr. Kahn have proven of no avail so far and I wonder whether you know him personally, or could give us his address or any other pertinent information in this respect.
