Your services in previous Loan campaigns have been of the utmost value to the Liberty Loan organization. They will mean just as much in the Victory Loan and in the preliminary work which opens about April 1.

The selling plan for the Victory Loan will be very different from that heretofore employed in Cleveland. There will be no industrial sales division, taking subscriptions in the larger manufacturing plants and commercial establishments of the city. There will be no special sales division, working upon a selected list of names. There will be a single general selling organization, which will make its appeal to every home in Cuyahoga County.

Doing less than this does not render the deserved co-operation.

need speakers for all sorts and conditions of

addressing in which your actual expenses will be
paid. We need speakers for schoolhouses, churches,
factories, theatres, public places, street corners,indeed, we want to reach the people wherever they
may be. To do all of this, and do it effectively,
we must not only have more speakers than we have
hitherto had, but they must work harder.

This letter is an appeal personal to you to enroll yourself as one willing to speak under the auspices of the Speakers' Bureau of the Fourth Liberty Loan. Please do not "pass the buck" to somebody else. It is quite likely that that somebody else is just as busy as you are. Please accept promptly. Fill out the enclosed return in detail and with accuracy.

Having enrolled, let us suggest that so far as possible you refrain from accepting personal invitations to address Liberty Loan meetings. Our scheme will work out better for you and for us if you would simply advise such invitors that you are speaking under the auspices of the Liberty Loan Committee, and refer them to the Committee.

You can appreciate how very out of place it would be for an over-zealous chairman to announce to the audience that he had pleasure in introducing Mr. So and So, the distinguished candidate for the office of - - - on the - - - ticket at the coming November election.

Having enrolled yourself, please always co-operate to the fullest extent with the Speakers' Bureau at Main 1. Try never to fail a meeting which you have accepted, and above all things, please never fail a meeting without notifying the Bureau sufficiently in advance for it to supply some one in your place. If you should, upon returning to your office at any time, find a request to call the Speakers' Bureau upon the telephone, please be good enough to do so. If you should ever visit the Liberty Loan headquarters and see how exceedingly difficult it is to get people upon the telephone, you would help out by calling up yourself when requested to do so. The secretary has frequently called up a given man as many as a dozen times a day and perhaps then without being able to catch him in his office.

We wish you would suggest additional speakers, but to help us in this respect please suggest only those whom you know to be willing and able. Very many are able, but perhaps unwilling, while very many are willing but wholly unable to deliver their message in the right way. We do not want you to assume in making suggestions that just because a man is a preacher or a lawyer he is therefore fully qualified to do this work.

Please send in your reply promptly, because organization meetings at which speakers will be required will start soon, in advance of the regular campaign.
