Dear Dr. Silver:

The Committee which is planning the Memorial Assembly for the late Rev. Masliansky to be held here at The Educational Alliance has asked me to communicate with you our invitation that you deliver the principal address at the Memorial.

The date has not been fixed and can be set at your own convenience, possibly, at the time of your visit to New York during April.

The audience to be invited consists, in the main, of those who were associated with Masliansky here at the Alliance, those who worked with him and those who were influenced by him. So far, about 50 men have responded to our invitation to act as sponsors for the Assembly, including quite a number of the members of the Dr. Herzl Zion Club.

In addition to the principal address of the evening, our present plan calls for one briefer address in English on "Masliansky, the Americanizer", one brief address in Yiddish and a five-minute talk in Hebrew. Then, of course, the Hazkarah chanted by a cantor.

We are, however, holding off on the other invitation pending your acceptance and information as to date, the general scope of your talk, etc.

Let me add my personal hope, as a colleague and fellow alumnus of the Hebrew Union College, that you will accept our invitation.
