My dear Rabbi Silver:

Mr. Zuckerman just returned from Cleveland and brought us the pleasant news that the representatives of the Zionist District in Cleveland are willing to arrange a luncheon in honor of our distinguished guest from Palestine, Mr. Zalmen Rubashov, who is scheduled to be in Cleveland the end of January.

They state, however, that the luncheon will be more successful if you will take the initiative in issuing a call for it. It is for this reason that I take the pleasure of addressing this letter to you.

You are no doubt acquainted with the great service that Mr. Rubashov has rendered to the Zionist and Labor Movement in Palestine and in the field of Jewish learning. He is also the vice-president of the Zionist Action Committee and the message which he brought from Palestine has aroused considerable interest and encouragement all over.

I am therefore convinced that if such a luncheon will be arranged in Cleveland, it will stimulate the Zionists to greater activity and it will help the Gewerkshafte Campaign for the Histadruth in whose behalf Mr. Rubashov arrived to this country.

Knowing, dear Rabbi, the interest you take in Jewish labor in Palestine, I am sure that you will consent to issue such an invitation and in general to assist our work in whatever way possible.
