My dear Fnanuel:

Following up the conversation we had yesterday, I am enclosing herewith a contribution from the Abba Hillel Silver Charitable and Educational Fund to the Zionist Organization of America. I hope that you will arrange to have funds made immediately available in Israel for Kfar Silver, p. Terably by cable. Ale Goodman told me last evening when we discussed the matter with Turover, May, and Harris Levine that the amount of money owing Kfar Silver because of earmarked contributions will be immediately forwarded, using bonds which the ZOA has and which Levine would undertake to transfer. I have myself, as you know, given him a \$5,000 bond.

If these moneys can be made available in Israel in the next few days, they can proceed with the building at Kfar Silver which has been interrupted because of the failure on the part of the ZOA to make good on its commitment.

I have already put the check through the ZOA and have received a check in exchange. I am depositing it in another account which is under my control. I shall now make arrangements to have the proceeds made available to our friends in Israel for Kfar-Silver at a favorable rate of exchange. They will get the money the latest upon my arrival there - and sooner, if possible. I am also trying to apprise them at once so that they can act accordingly. I am glad you informed me about the talk you had with May, Goodman, et al and will do what I can to see to it that in the future regular remittances are made by the ZOA to Kfar-Silver. At the Convention we made a fairly good start for the AZF for the coming year - largely as a result of strenuous efforts which I made prior to the Convention. Due to this beginning there is a more hopeful atmosphere and I think a greater determination to improve the financial position of the Organization - although for the present it will apparently be necessary to make a substantial bank loan or bank loans to tide over the next few months. The Convention ended well. May's election to the Presidency was received with genuine acclaim. Needless to say, your own address was not only the highlight of the Convention but was a great contribution to the strengthening of the Organization, itself. I am sailing on Thursday and expect to arrive in Israel on the 11th of July together with Fan. We will stay, most probably, I think, at the King David Hotel.
