Dear Rabbi Silver:

During your absence from the city, a great deal of excitement arose when, following the latest anti-Jewish outbreaks in Germany, the local Yiddish news papers, led by Leon Wiesenfeld, convoked a conference of delegates representing the various Jewish organizations of the city, to plan for a huge mass meeting in the Public Auditorium to protest against the Nazi discriminations.

The call to attend this conference came exclusively through the columnsof these Yiddish publications (World, Forward and Freiheit) A few days before the scheduled date of the conference, Mr Wiesenfeld phone me and Mr Kollin as officers of the American Jewish Congress and invited us to sponsor the meeting jointly with the Jewish Labor Committee. As this conference was consonant with a similar gathering held in New York, Boston, Chicago and other communities, under A.J.C. auspices, we consented, although I objected to the manner in which the conference had been called, pointing out that only those who had the good fortune of reading those worthy Yiddish journals had notice of the meeting and it was then too late to use other methods of notification.

However, the conference assembled and more than 300 delegates representing 82 Jewish organizations attended. Mr Kollin presided, and despite the fact that the meeting was packed with radicals, it was very orderly and dignified. Following some addresses, resolutions which I had prepared, were adopted. I enclose the Plain Dealer article concerning the gathering.

As with few exceptions the delegates were representative of only one segment of local Jewry, I suggested that before any further procedure was taken regarding the proposed mass meeting, matil the views of such leaders as E.M. Baker, Eugene Wolf, Louis Bing, Max Simon, Mrs Sigmund Herzog, et al., should be first obtained. Accordingly, these and about fifteen additional men and women were invited to a luncheon meeting at the Hollenden to discuss the problem. Louis Bing, speaking for himself and Mr Baker, objected to a mass meeting, and similar sentiments were voiced by Mr Simon and others. As a result, the meeting adjourned without any definite action being taken.

Then followed a series of articles and editorials in the Jewish World, denouncing those who opposed the mass meeting and attacking Mr Kollin for not obeying the "mandate" of the conference of the 82 organizations by immediately organizing the protest meeting.

In order to determine whether or not these delegates would still favor a mass meeting despite the opposition of the "Hollenden group," it was decided to call a second conference - again through the medium of the Yiddish papers.

A group of "left-wingers" led by Mr Bendoff of the Freiheit, demanded

the immediate calling of the protest meeting, and a motion to that effect was made and seconded.A substitute motion was offered by way of an amendment providing that the entire question be referred to a committee of 25 or more. The latter motion prevailed, and a committee of 55, comprising a fair cross-section of the Jewish community, was appointed.

Mr Kollin, who had been acting as chairman of these meetings, left town for several weeks (probably suffering a breakdown from the verbal bombardments he was then receiving) and I was asked to ast as chairman in his stead. Only a few of the reformed element on the committe of 55, attended its meeting.<sup>The</sup> sentiment of those who expressed their views was overwhelmingly for the protest meeting, but Eugene Wolf and Sidney Weitz sponsored a motion that the question be again referred - this time to a smaller committee consisting equally of those who represented the views of those who attended the Hollenden meeting, and those who favored action. As chairman, I appointed a committee of 26 in compliance with Mr Wolf's motion and this group assembled at the Temple. Among those who attended were Mr Wolf, Sidney Weitz, Louis Bing, Max Simon, Mrs Herzog, Mrs Benj. Levine, Mrs Emil Brudno, Elmer Scheuer, Henry Rocker, and Philmore J. Haber - in addition to the sponsors of the original conference.

After much discussion the committee approved the following plan which I suggested as a compromise between the mass meeting advocates and those who wished to maintain a discreet silence:

The calling of a city-wide conference of representative leaders of Jews, Catholics, Protestants, labor, the Masons and other groups opposed to the Nazi policies. This conference is to concern itself with the intensifying of the economic boycott, and with the endeavor to bring about America's withdrawal from participation in the Olympic Games scheduled to be held in Berlin next year.

I appointed a small committee to lay the plans for this conference, but it was informally agreed at the meeting that no definite action be taken until you and Rabbi Brickner returned and were consulted regarding the matter.

In the meantime, however, at the request of New York headquarters of the American Jewish Congress, I personally undertook to do some preliminary work regarding the Olympics question. By reason of my former editorial connections with the Press and the Plain Dealer, I was able to prevail upon Stuart Bell, sports editor of the Press, to turn over his column to me for a day, to discuss this matter. (I enclose the article) I believe I will be able to do the same with the other newspapers.

But more important, I contacted James Lee, the Cleveland representative of the American Amateur Athletic Union who will be the local delegate to the U.S. Olympics Committee which convenes in New York in December to pass final judgment on the question of America's participation. I induced Mr Lee to invite me or any one we may wish to delegate to attend the annual meeting of the Cleveland Committee of the "thletic Union, scheduled for October 7th, and to present a brief supporting the contention that the Cleveland delegate should vote against America's participation in the Berlin Olympics.

I have compiled a great deal of material on the subject, but before preparing this brief, Mr Kollin and I would like to meet and discuss the situation with you. We believe that in view of the nation-wide agitation against the games, America's withdrawal is within the realm of possibility and no opportunity should be lost to bring about this telling blow against Hitlerism, which if accomplished, would be as effective as an official pronouncement from our government itself.

As there remain only a few days within which to prepare for this October 7th meeting of the local Athletic Union, may I suggest a conference between yourself, Mr Kollin, myself and one or two others who may be helpful in this matter.

Some action must also be taken regarding the Jewish-Gentile conference sanctioned by the committee of 26 a few weeks ago.

I will phone you for your suggestions regarding these questions.

HE question of Catholic and Jewish athletes appearing in the 1936 Olympic games at Berlin, capital of a nation whose government has waged unmitigated discrimination agaist these faiths, has become so agitated that this column is being turned over today to Al Woldman, attorney. He says: Dear Mr. Bell:

Jeremiah T. Mahoney, New York, president of the Amateur Athletic Union of the United States, has publicly announced that he would vote for the withdrawal of American participation in the 1936 Olympic games scheduled to be held in Germany in 1936, if reports of Nazi discrimination against athletes on religious grounds were confirmed.

The Commonweal, national Catholic weekly, editorially calls for a Catholic boycott of the Berlin Olympiad because "participation in the approaching games means indorsement of willful and violent persecution."

### American Indians Could Be Ruled Out, Too

A NYONE who cares to "confirm" the seemingly endless reports of Ger-A many's violations of the Olympic ideal of fair play and good sports-manship needs only to refer to the following: The recent government order dissolving the Deutsche Jugendkraft, a

Satisfic sports organization. Numerous discriminating and destructive actions against German organ-ized labor, Catholic youth and liberal groups, which necessarily prevents the athletes of these elements from participating in the international games.

Decree of Sept. 22, 1934, categorically forbidding Jews from participating in sports or exercises in a body.

The application of the "Aryan" paragraph of the German law, if strictly enforced, would exclude the participation of Negro athletes, such as our own Jesse Owens. It would also exclude American Indians, Asiatics and teams from nations whose dominant bloodstreams are not within the German definition of "Aryan."

Barring of Jews from tennis, skiing, cricket and chess clubs and lifesavers' associations.

Government order forbidding German-Jewish Maccabee team of 100 athletes to participate in the World Maccabiade in Prague. "Hagibor," Jewish sports association, declared illegal at

Jewish sports association, declared illegal and its property confiscated.

Ban on Jewish coaches by Nazi student associations.

Edict by Hermann Wilhelm Goering, premier of Prussia, barring "non-Aryan" horsemen from participation in horse shows and tournaments.

Order of the Deutscher Turnverein and affiliates expelling all Jewish

members.

Peace-Loving Swiss Already Have Withdrawn NUMEROUS police orders forbidding the calling of any meeting of any Jewish association, including sports clubs.

Various government edicts imposing on all German Jews humiliating conditions which automatically bar every self-respecting Jew from participation and make it virtually impossible for any self-respecting Jew from any part of the world to enter Germany without subjecting himself to the degradation that would be involved in his participating in the Olympiad either as a contestant or an observer. Space limitations alone prevent a detailed recital of the entire sordid

record.

The holding of the Olympics in a country which has thus trampled upon every standard of civilized conduct is an affront to all humanity and a travesty of the spirit of sportsmanship.

One nation-Switzerland-has already withdrawn from participation. Sports leaders of England, France and Italy are deliberating similar action. Shall liberty-loving America do less?

Silence and inaction at this time are tantamount to an indorsement of the Nazi policy of discrimination and oppression.

You, Mr. Bell, and other sports editors can render a monumental service for the cause of clean sports, decency and fair play by urging and prevailing upon the American Olympic Committee not to send our athletes to the German Olympics until Germany satisfies the world that all and not merely some of the fundamental principles of sport and of the Olympic games have been restored. Congress and President. Modeling its procedure somewhat

Modeling its processing in New after a similar gathering in New York Monday night, the Cleveland Jewish community last night in an emergency conference moved to marshal public sentiment for a national protest against the latest measures of the Hitler regime against the Jews of Germany.

The conference, which was held in Forest City Hall of the Hebrew Benevolent Association, 10512 Hathaway Avenue N. E., was sponsored jointly by the local division of the American Jewish Congress and the Jewish Labor Committee. It was attended by 250 official delegates representing 79 Jewish organizations. Similar conferences are being held in other cities.

In ten-minute addresses, emphasized by applause, A. A. Woldman, executive secretary of the local division of the Jewish Congress; Meyer Weintraub of the Daily Forward, Rabbi David Genuth of the Kinsman Jewish Center, Leo Weisenfeld of the Jewish World, Rabbi Israel Porath of the Oheb Zedek Congregation and David Copland, president of Cleveland Lodge, B'nai B'rith, spoke in favor of six resolutions, which were later passed unanimously, and urged a public demonstration of protest at an early date in Public Hall.

#### Call on Congress.

These resolutions, substantially the same as those adopted by the New York meeting, called upon Congress and the president to express official condemnation of Nazi treatment of dissenting religious and minority groups, appealed to American citizens to strengthen and extend the economic boycott against Germany, called upon the League of Nations to exercise clauses dealing with abstention of trade agreements and the United States to abrogate existing agreements with Germany, American refusal to particitrade urged in the forthcoming pate games at Germany's invitation, asked American educational institutions to refuse further exchange of professors and students from Nazi Germany and urged that all Jewish agencies pre-sent a united front in support of these proposals.

Action was taken authorizing the calling of the public meeting of protest, in which Catholic and Protestant organizations are to be invited to participate, as soon as a representative committee can make proper arrangements.

Copland, Louis Singer, Joseph Bendoff, A. Resnick, Charles Auerbach and Meyer Adkin were named to help Abraham Kollin, president of the local division of the Jewish Congress, who presided, to nominate and organize this committee.

Kollin read telegrams, originally addressed to the New York meeting, expressing the sympathies of several United States senators and congressmen with the purposes of the meeting, among them messages from Senator Arthur Capper of Kansas, Senator Robert F. Wagner of New York, Senator Edward P. Costigan of Colorado and Senator William E, Borah of Idaho.

My dear Mr. Silver:-


The meeting of the American Olympic officials is only two and a half months away, and yet we Jews have done little or nothing in the way ofprotests or opposition, which should be reflected at that meeting.

The time is short, and the least we could do is to organize groups in all cities to solicit signatures against American participation in the Olympics on the grounds of descrimination, which is so un-American. There is no hope for any action by Congress. None of them would risk such action during an election year. If we start out now to get ten million signatures, on the order of the Crusaders, and this should be taken up by us as a Crusade, and the only weapon we have at the present time, which we may regret afterward for not having used it, it may have a decided beneficial influence at that meeting for a decision for withdrawal, and may even cause other countries to follow our decision.

As one of the outstanding Jewish leaders in this country, I call upon you to take up the fight now.

My dear Doctor Silver:

We wired you last night in answer to your telegram, we received the following communication from Mr. Albert M. Greenfield after I had tried continuously for three days to get in touch with him by phone or personally:

Dear Mr. Harriman:

I have your letter of September 19th and regret that the pressure of matters here in the past few days have prevented my speaking to you when you telephoned.

It is rather late for me to attempt to contact His Eminence as he is probably at the Eucharistic Congress. However, I hope to be able to speak to Cardinal Daugherty on the subject of your communication, upon his return to the City.

I do believe that Greenfield will do what he can and I certainly shall keep after him to work on Cardinal Daugherty.

We are in the midst of a great many activities which comprise the following: We are as you know, sending out a quarter of a million appeals to the Hebrew Congregations during the High Holy Days. Already some 250 Synagogues have been contacted and their Presidents have agreed to distribute the appeal letters. As of this morning, the Synagogues represent 190,000 seat holders. It looks as if we should have a good representation by the time the job is finished.

Also, in connection with the Olympics, we are distributing 100,000 business reply cards at the Yankee Stadium tonight, prior to the Louis-Baer fight. Whese cards read as follows: <u>Read - Sign-Mail</u> <u>I am against the participation of American athletes in the Berlin</u> <u>Olympics in 1936</u>. Then there is a check space offering further information and room for signature and address of the recipient. We should secure some very good names for solicitation from this distribution.

Of course, you know about the Eucharistic Congress pamphlet which you have undoubtedly seen but of which I am sending you a further copy, just in case.

Now, all this brings me up to the main point. These activities which are, I believe, in line with what you have advised and what you think is right. cost a great deal of money. The High Holy Days appeal has meant an investment of approximately \$1100.00, this including printing, folding, distribution, etc. etc. The Stadium card project has cost, or will cost, around \$250.00. As a result our funds are getting desperately low, and the Executive Committee have asked me to approach you to see if you cannot help us out. Of course, this money spent is largely in the form of an investment. It seems incredible if an appeal to one quarter million people should not produce returns. If only five out every hundred answer our appeal, and this is certainly not a high figure, we should receive 12500 contributions. But in the meantime we are absolutely strapped and if you can send us some money to tide us over until we start getting back some of our investment. you will be helping us tremendously.

You realize, of course, that at the moment it is absolutely impossible to go to Mr. Untermyer. He is in such a state of mind that it is hard to say what he might do were he again approached for funds. This is the consensus of opinion of the Executive Committee as well as my own and you will remember that we decided at our meeting last week that if we are to do things on our own and really get somewhere we will have to do it without Mr. Untermyer's financial assistance. I need not tell you why.



With reference to your letter of September 30th and October 1st, both of which reached us today:

Regarding the first, we are going after the Paramount people through the Independent Theater Owners Association, Inc., a group of exhibitors of which Mr. Louis Myers is a director. They will bring pressure upon the Paramount people as they have already done in the case of the Olympic film. I understand that the Paramount people returned a rather evasive answer to the exhibitors regarding the Olympic film, but under our direction they are going further in order to force the Paramount people to stop the practice of showing German newsreels. Paramount's excuse is that they do not show propaganda but merely news pictures which are comparable to news published in any newspaper. There is a certain amount of truth in their statement for as recently as Sunday last, the New York Times published a picture of the open air theater being built in connection with the Olympics and surely one cannot accuse the New York Times of publishing Nazi propaganda. However, if the exhibitors take a determined stand that they will not show these German reels thereby letting Paramount know how they feel in the matter a good effect may be achieved.

With reference to your letter of October 1st, regarding the "Move the Olympics Committee" of which Mr. Maccabee is Chairman, this is not our Committee, which will function under the name of the Fair Play In Sports Committee. However, as

our Committee does not intend to distribute petitions and as the Maccabee Committee may be able to do some good work along these lines, I believe that it will be most helpful to them if you can aid them in their distribution work in your district. In fact, if it were possible to distribute them very widely in Catholic districts and among the labor people, it would be decidedly helpful. By that I do not suggest for a moment that no Jewish names should go on them, but I do think non-Jewish names should be particularly sought.

I may tell you that the Fair Play in Sports Committee has approached some 100 of the most prominent men in this country to join them and I am very hopeful as to its prospects. I will keep you fully informed as to its progress.

By the way, you have not as yet let me know if we can expect help through your organization or Cleveland friends. We do really need money badly and I do trust that you have been able to do something for us.

Thank you for your letter of October 15th with reference to Sears-Roebuck carrying German goods. Sears-Roebuck are now flagrantly violating the boycott. We have tried pressure on General Wood and on both the Rosenwalds. So recently as last week J. David Stern used his influence on Lessing Rosenwald.

He reported that his efforts were unsuccessful, that Rosenwald replied that as an officer of a company whose stock was held by the public, he did not feel justified in allowing his personal inclinations to rule the company's policy. A very weak and evasive answer.

To our own communications Messrs. Rosenwald had never replied. Might I suggest that a strong personal letter from you be sent to these gentlemen and that you induce as many of your prominent friends as will do so to write similar letters.

Mr. Clarence H. Low, who has joined our Board and whom I hope you will meet on Monday, claims to have a strong contact through Mr. Rosenwald's sister which he has offered to use.

The only possible thing to do is to exert pressure and more pressure on these gentlemen, although William Rosenwald is not of as much importance as Lessing.

Dear Dr. Silver:

During the past few months I have become involved in the boycott movement, serving as chairman of our local Conference of Jewish Organizations. We have made considerable progress, checking over a hundred stores, contacting merchants, and publicizing adherents to the boycott.

Yesterday, I had a two-hour conference with Bishop Gallagher of Detroit. I discussed with him the possibility of getting the active participation and support of the Catholic church in our movement, and he is much interested and, of course, greatly disturbed by conditions in Germany affecting the Catholics.

He was much impressed by a conversation that he had had with a German-Catholic churchman attending the recent Eucharist Congress. The latter, after telling Bishop Gallagher of German persecutions, was asked: "What is the answer?" The German priest replied: "Boycott:"

Bishop Gallagher told me that he would bring the entire question of German protest and of our boycott before the coming Conference of the Catholic Church in America, to be held at the Catholic University in Washington, D. C. on November 11, 12 and 13. He said that he was anxious to have and expected the active support of Bishop Schrembs of Cleveland and Archbishop Curley of Baltimore. He agreed that it would be a good thing for me to ask you to have a talk with Bishop Schrembs and to prime him with information on the boycott, its desirability, and promises of success.

If you can see your way clear to have such a conference with Bishop Schrembs--and possibly figure out some approach to Archbishop Curley--I think it may be possible to work out an arrangement whereby the full power of the American-Catholic public can be put back of the boycott.

I hope that you and your family are enjoying the best of health and that you are not permitting pressure of business to affect your poise and good nature.

As for the anti-Olympic work in other countries, I can report to you that some of it is being done, particularly in Holland and in the Scandinavian countries. There appear to be greater limitations for the European nations than for the United States, since so many take their cue from their Foreign Office. We have, however, been incontact with leaders in other countries and are hoping for the best.

The Mahoney statement is being reprinted and will shortly be circulated to where it can do the most good.

We agree with you that the campaign ought to speak of transferring the Games. While we are attempting to do that, the opposition is, however, using its howitzers to create an impression that it is Berlin or nothing.

Although we are sure that you are generally familiar with recent events in Germany, as reported in the press, we are confident that you will be interested in receiving the accompanying digest of the latest legislative and administrative decrees and judicial decisions affecting the status of Jews. These include the official text of the so-called Nuremberg decrees, which deprive the Jews of their citizenship, prohibit marriage between Jews and "subjects of German or racially related blood," forbid Jews to engage non-Jewish domestic help under forty-five years of age, etc. The digest also contains the decree providing for the separation of Jewish from non-Jewish pupils in public and private schools, and recent judicial decisions which show how the courts are applying the Nazi race dogma in disputes involving relations of all kinds between Jews and so-called "Aryans."

We need not tell you, I am sure, that the Committee is fully alive to the profoundly serious implications of these latest developments, that they are the subject of continuous and unremitting consideration, and that the Committee may be relied upon to cooperate actively with those forces which recognize the vital importance of combating the spread of the pernicious doctrines now prevalent in Germany.

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

My dear Mr. Levinson:

I want to apologize sincerely for not having previously replied to your letter of October 7th, but during the past few weeks I have been able to spend very little time in the office.

The principle involved has been given a great deal of consideration by the officers of this company.

The amount of goods imported from all countries is exceedingly small, and from Germany alone our imports are insignificant. Being a national institution, and serving people from coast to coast, we have come to the conclusion that it would be inadvisable for our company to attempt to eliminate suy certain class of goods simply because a certain portion of our customers desired us to do so.

As an individual, I believe I am as ardently Jewish as any one with my background could possibly be. Personally I do not knowingly purchase goods from Germany. I consider this my personal affair and can exercise my own judgment as an individual in purchasing what I desire.

Insofar as the company is concerned, I am, as an officer of the company, forced to have different views from those which I hold as an individual. We have a large number of stockholders and have the entire population of the United States purchasing from us. As a consequence, I do not feel it incumbent upon me to use my position as an officer of the company to force my opinion on our stockholders and customers, possibly to the detriment of the company.

In the above, I have tried to give you as clearly as I possibly could my personal and the company's position with regard to this rather difficult problem. I trust this will be of some assistance to you in answering the correspondence which you have received on this subject, the copies of which are being returned to you herewith.

Please accept my thanks for bringing this matter to my attention.

I have read in the papers that the testimonial dinner tendered to you was an outstanding event, and I am sorry I was not there to personally witness the worthy and glorious tributes that were paid you.

The subject of German-made goods pops up every now and then--the enclosed is a confidential release that speaks for itself.

Sears are now buying less than ever from Germany. Gloves are about the only items we buy in any quantity, and the reason is that these particular gloves cannot be obtained at any other source.

These gloves supply a definite customer demand -and, in good merchandising, the first principle is that "the customer must be served."

The glove buyer, who will soon leave for Europe -and who, by the way, is a good "Yehudi" with whom I have become acquainted intimately -- tells me he is planning his trip in an effort to find sources other than Germany for this particular glove. Thus far, he has been unable to find outside of that country the material, the necessary skill, or the facilities for making these gloves in sufficient quantities.

This buyer has the same feeling in the matter as you and I. But there is no choice--unless he is able to create another source of supply.

Sears catalog mentions the source of manufacture when merchandise is of foreign origin, and the customer buys at his own discretion.

In the stores, the place of manufacture is stamped or labeled on imported articles, and again the customer is left with the choice.

I hope this information helps to clarify the situation somewhat.

At Rabbi Silver's request, I have to-day sent you the following telegram over his signature: PLEASE EXPLAIN WHY KRESGE AND NOT WOOLWORTH IS AGAIN LISTED IN ECONOMIC BULLETIN AFTER OUR PROTEST?

I repeat what I said in my previous letter that until recently the Kresge Company has handled practically no German goods in their Cleveland stores and that they now inform us that since they are credited with handling German merchandise they see no reason why they should not meet their competitor, the Woolworth Company, that is handling a great deal of German merchandise.


I tried to explain to them that the Economic Bulletin was published and generally circulated in New York and that perhaps the Kresge Company in New York did handle German merchandise and the Woolworth Company did not. The Kresge Company emphatically denied this stating the imports from Germany for all of their stores was very small in comparison to that of the Woolworth Company. They also pointed out that these Economic Bulletins make no statement that these are New York stores and that these Bulletins are mailed all over the United States and that there is a large mailing of these Bulletins in Cleveland.

We feel that the Kresge Company has a strong point and that it has not been dealt with fairly in this score and we feel that after calling your attention to this, the name of the Kresge Company, especially when the name of the Woelworth Company is cmitted, should not have appeared in this issue of the Economic Bulletin. We are fearful we have lost the progress made with the Kresge Company. Can you advise us what to do in the light of the present situation?



I have been away from Chicago most of the time since your letter of November 14 arrived. It would be very much more satisfactory to have a personal talk with you but as that is not probable I shall submit a few observations.

The questions involved in the Hitler regime are fundamental to the code of civilization. While the paramount plank in the Nazi platform is ruthless and official antisemitism, the same principle, or lack of principle thus exhibited, was bound to make itself felt with respect to the other religions and races. The throttling of freedom, in which there was set loose an unbridled license to people who were given a taste of power for the first time, has produced a type of sadistic cruelty without parallel in modern times. The Mazi attack on Judaism was bound to eventuate in an assault upon all religion. The mask of "Aryanism" is as false as hell. It is really barb-groundsm.

The report published yesterday by High Commissioner James G. McDonald should, I think, convince you and those associated with you of the inescapable duty that rests upon us to cope with this menace to all we hold dear. McDonald advises the League of Nations to make exception to the general rule and lodge a severe protest with Nazi Germany against the vicious and inhuman treatment of German Jews and Christians. That, I say, is an exception to the rule that nations should not interfere in the domestic problems of other nations. I have contended throughout this campaign (contrary to the desire of many of my coworkers) that we should not urge our government to take any drastic action against or even file a formal protest with Germany. The reason is that, in my study of international law and relations, I have found that when a stern rebuke, or a boycott, or a "sanction," is official, that is, where it is done by a government, it is regarded as an "unfriendly act," and may easily lead to war. But when the same thing is done by individuals in their capacity as free men, it is not only allowable and proper, but it is a sacred duty. For example, I have recently protested to the Department of State against the United States be coming involved in the so-called "sanctions" against Italy for the reason above given. But the refusal of Jews, Catholics and Protestants to resent by the use of the only peaceful weapon we have, to wit, the economic boycott, in order to bring home to the Nazi leaders that we condemn their brutal outrages on innocent people is scarcely short of cowardly.

The only way in which Hitler and his tribe can be stopped within a reasonable time is by economic pressure. That is an effective and legitimate weapon. It merely constitutes a refusal to deal with a man, or a corporation, or a nation, that is criminal, cruel, or fraudulent. I can not imagine you, Lessing, buying anything yourself for your own personal use made in Germany. Our protest can be heard in no other way inside Germany, for public opinion is blindfolded and freedom of the press extinct.

The fact that your imports "from Germany alone are insignificant" would seem to relieve you altogether of any business reason. But in these times when the world is all agog, when the very fabric of civilization is being torn to tatters, when the theory of totalitarian government is even making headway in its economic aspects in this country, we must look to the high-minded business men of the country to put on such economic pressure as may be necessary to destroy the last vestige of this imminent peril. If it succeeds in Germany it is bound to succeed in other countries. According to a recent great British authority, there is only onethird of civilization that is free, only one-third of the people of this earth who really enjoy liberty. We are trustees for them. We are trustees for one another and we must subordinate every motive of materialism to this call to the spirit, if we would protect and preserve our beloved America.

For the first time in the history of antisemitism the Christians, both Catholic and Protestant, are lined up on the side of justice in defense of conscience against the scourge of antisemitism. This is the time of times to crush the serpent of antisemitism. It is not enough to scotch it; it must be destroyed.

I make bold to suggest that you should not let your modesty or the fact that you are a Jew prevent you from standing for a principle as wide as humanity and as deep as freedom. When men like John Haynes Holmes, S. Parkes Cadman, Harry Emerson Fosdick, and a hundred others of the greatest ministers of the country go the limit against this Nazi cruelty and injustice, it would be of tremendous value for a house so eminent and influential as Sears, Roebuck & Company to take its stand with them in defense of civilization and liberty.

Dear Professor Einstein:

I cannot tell you how happy I am over your letter. It brings me the heartening reassurance which I need in the midst of a great difficulty.

I am happy that you wrote as you did to Justice Brandeis and I shall see him on Saturday morning in Washington. I wish you might join me, but I presume you cannot.

I wonder whether you know that the proposal put forward, and you express it rightly, as a "ballon d'essai", has been mooted for sometime. You may recall that it was broached at Geneva about two months ago and we had some word about it from Dr. Goldmann. In one word, it is a worldwide extension of the transfer or Haavarah agreement.

Rothenberg, Lipsky and I telephoned to London to Simon Marks, who is a disciple and close friend of "eizmann, and we did so because of our consternation over this proposed oriminal folly. Simon brushed it aside by saying it was Rot and yet the "Times" of today and the Jewish Telegraphic Agency for days have been mooting in different terms a proposal which I have no doubt springs from the fertile brain of Schacht, supplemented and reinforced by a group of German Jewish banking millionaires.

As soon as the thing happened, I wrote a statement for publication in the daily press and "The Congress Bulletin". I send you a copy herewith. My colleagues in the Governing Council of the Congress thought it was our duty to wait until after we could confer with the Joint Council, made up, as you may know, of representatives of the Emerican Jewish Committee, the American Jewish Congress and the B'nai B'rith. We have tried to meet with them. They put us off on the ground that we must now wait until these three gentlemen arrive, and that will not be until the 21st or 22nd, before making any statement.

You know well that the "New York Times" is almost as accurate as any newspaper can be. They did not guess at this thing or imagine it. It came from authoritative sources and I feel that the Congress must repuridate it on every ground. As I see it, this proposal has referred to the saving only of Jews in Germany who have possessions, many of whom could have left Germany in the last two years but who have refused to do so because they continued to love their country and because they were unwilling to make sacrifices. Now that they cannot emerge from Germany with their possessions, they are willing to permit us to facilitate their emigration provided we can save the whole or a goodly part of their possessions. If these leave Germany, no one will be left to care for the poor German Jews who will remain.

More important than that consideration is the truth that in setting up of a bank with Jewish capital to facilitate the transfer with their possessions of German Jews to England or America, -- and neither England nor America will assent to the proposal, would serve notice that we are prepared not only to break the boycott, but that we are even prepared to be the industrial agents, the commercial travelers for the Hitler regime and its; industry provided we can get German Jews with possessions out of their country.

There are these further considerations which to me are of supreme importance. We Jews dare not try to save ourselves without saving the other victims of the Hitler regime. If we break the front with our fellow-victims, the non-Jewish world has the right to say that we cannot be depended upon to battle on as long as we can make any kind of a peace, however dishonoring with our oppressors.

If there can be a more important consideration, it is this, and surely you must have felt it. To help Germany to export her goods and wares to other lands now, in other words, to support the Hitler regime industrially, is to serve notice upon Roumania, Poland, Latvia, Hungary and even Austria, that they treat Jews badly enough their fellow-Jews may be trusted to serve the oppressing country by facilitating its export through transfer or some other skillful device that may be invented.

We have a right to ask that England shall do one thing--open wider the gateway to Palestine or that England permit the immigration of Jews in large number into Transjordania.

This proposal is fatal to the Jews in every way and deadly to us insofar as it will proclaim to the world that Jews have no sense of responsibility to their fellow-sufferers and that they are concerned only with their own physical security irrespective of any hurt done to their honor.

I trust that Mrs. Einstein is very much better. I wish that sometime Miss Dukes would have the kindness to write and tell Mrs. Wise and me how Mrs. Einstein is.

We have, of course, released it to the Anglo-Jewish papers and Catholic press also.

We are watching the situation very carefully and we will work with other organizations if any liquidation plan is brought up. According, however, to the WNS report the purpose of the English visitors is not connected with the International Bank at all.

It is entirely tentative and on the face of it can apply only in a few cases. The dispatch reads more like Nazi propaganda than anything else.

I had some letters from Mr. Untermyer this morning, the first word we have had from him since he left for the coast. He is evidently in a little better shape. In one of them he expressed his high regard for you and his deep appreciation of the services you have rendered in the cause of the boycott. He complains rather plaintively, however, that you have ceased communicating with him and that he valued your advice and assistance very highly, and feels rather lost without it. Thank you for your good letter of January 28th.

I am more than glad that Miss Chadsey is to visit us next week and you may rest assured that I will give her every assistance and attention. I have wanted to meet her for a long time for I believe and I think you will agree with me that she has been splendidly efficient in her conduct of the Cleveland office.

We will check the papers carefully for your "No Liquidation" editorial and forward them to you. We did not know until yesterday that you had released it to the Anglo-Jewish press. Had we known in time we would have asked you to mention that it was appearing as an editorial in our Bulletin. It is a small matter but it might have been helpful.

Now as to the proposed plan brought to this country by the British high hat delegation. Doctor, they have no plan. The only thing they know is that whatever money is raised there must be nothing done which will in any way help German exports. They have been thoroughly scared off the idea of a public liquidation bank. They announced it in St. Louis and at the reception given them by the Joint Distribution Committee which I attended. One speaker after the other reiterated the slogan "no increased exports of Germany are contemplated in our plans nor will any plans which might lead to such an eventuality be considered."

In this connection it is interesting to note that the resolution passed by the audience contained these words, "the plans in no way contemplate or include any measures which will aid or facilitate in the export of German goods" to which was added that this assurance is regarded "an essential condition". It was really amusing to see William Rosenwald presenting this resolution. I am writing that gentleman today, pointing out how ridiculous his proposal of such a resolution is in the face of the Sears Roebuck attitude.

Frankly, I think that they are sincere. What these gentlemen had in their mind, to begin with one does not know. But the world objection to even a thought of such a proposal has had its effect. I understand that there was a good deal of friction between them and the people whom they consulted. Some of their American contacts were afraid that any plan so wide in scope and entailing such a large sum would interfere with domestic campaigns on the way. Frankly, and I say this advisedly, I do not think they will make any appeal to the public. They will try to get their money from a small group of very very wealthy men.

You ask whom they have consulted. Their main contacts has been with the Joint and Welfare Federations. As you know, they have also been talking to some of the Zionist leaders and will appear at the Zionist Conference at which you are scheduled to speak. Felix Warburg and Baerwald, of course, have been very much in the picture. They naturally would be. So far as we can learn they have not talked officially to the American Jewish Congress, although Lipsky, who advised them on their arrival is connected with both the Zionist and Congress organizations. We were not called in, which, under the circumstances is quite natural.

We did release a blast against the scheme proposed, which was followed by yourself but that was about as far as we could get. However, we feel that the danger of any boycott wrecking plan is over, for the time being at least. There is some talk of a private liquidation bank for the wealthier Jews which would take over the German Jewish property for gradual liquidation. This, however, is very nebulous, there is nothing official about it and is only a rumor. Perhaps you might be able to get further information on it while you are in Washington.

This is not another open letter. I just want you to know that there reached me this morning, from one of the best and wholly neutral sources in Palestine not only a considerable review of the aavarah but the following enclosures:

1 Clipping from L'Aurore, French Egyptian paper giving an acount of a massmeeting in Cairo in which the leading Jews unanimously condemned Haavarah, dated Jan 2, 1936

2. Haavarah correspondence dated Nov 21, 1935 covering a protocol between " aavarah and E.I.A. (Entente Internationale de l'Acier) for a pooling of interests and a tonnage program in German metal importation, about 100,000 tons.

3. Copy of Arthus Luss of Haifa circular announcing he is accredited agent of Haavarah, and giving his prices for German typewriters.

4. Figures showing "aavarah under bids the "erman base price about 15%

5 Copy in French of Haavarah letter, dated Jan 19, 1935 written to German Minister in Cairo for aid in winning market for German goods.

I shall as opportunity offers make this all public. It con firms the worst, shows this German agency was busy to the end of 1935, and boasted that it had increase German business in Palesti 400 %. That Lipsky, "The Reconstructionist" and "Every Friday" argue for the new Haavarah deal suggest your associates are not kosher on the boycott, and skirts are not cleared by resolution. It will be a question who holds the cash, and if your Left friendo will control the U.P.A. the results are too obvious.

#### My dear Rabbi Silver:

Men do not take each other's advice otherwise my answer to you would be simply this, don't patronize.

Now I called your attention to the existence of a doument dated November 21, 1935, which covered a contract entered into on that date, which presupposes that the <sup>4</sup>avaarah was doing business and proposed to do some more. It is not quite reasonable to presume that <sup>1</sup>aavarah was let in to a metals-cartel because it was not doing business. Nor is there any reason to believe that the Egyptian Jews protested against what happened a year ago.

I read the announcement you mention in the London "Jewish Chronicle" before it appeared in the JTA and as it does not square with a defense made for the Haavarah arew weeks before nor with the Shimson Computy transaction, I have ignored both statements and have invited some of my correspondents to give me independently the low down on the situation. For the moment I conclude that the German stoppage of transfer has been used as an argument for if there has been a real suspension of this business Ben Gurion's defense, Lipsky's argument, the "Rewish Frontier," and other apologies would have been needless.

It is perfectly true that I have been opposed to the Histadruth, to all those phases which have assumed the characteristics of a racket. A whole series of events from the Stafsky case on, have that distinct appearance, and unfortunately Jewish life in other directions is not free from the aspersion that some organizations are run for the benefit of payrolls.

In this particular matter I did not even know that the His-

tadruth was involved because I had never enquired into the component parts of the "Nir," and even now do not pretend to know the set up. What first caught my eye was the participation of the Jewish National Fund which I condemned as unworthy and improper. I know the Hanotiah people, and they are not Socialists, not even socially-minded. If you can clear your mind of the thought that I am animated in this by any party or other animus.

Just because I believe that the liquidation is in process and no one can stop it I believe the utmost caution must be exercised both as to the effect on the boycott and on Palestine. I am not at all persuaded that the Haavarah type of liquidation is essentially necessary, and if it is true that by their contract with the Reich they are entitled to a rake off of the emigrant's assets whether or not he uses their facilities, it appears that their interest is something else than that of salvaging German capital for the benefit of the emigrant.

Out of the whole mass of contradictory reports it still seems to be clear that the emigrant can cash in about as much by not using the Haavarah as by using its system. If that is the case what is the point of an organized breach of the boycott with all the pressure on Palestine and the opening up of new markets in the Near East?

The saving of capital in order to build up Palestine does not thrill me because it is not necessarily true as to the fact5. One of my correspondents, a cold and somewhat distant person writes me that the Haavarah has smashed Palestine business, and he does not hesitate to tell me that the Palestinean depression is due to the German dumping which has forced all other goods

out of the market, and put a severe kink into all local manufactures. I do not know whether this is a fact, nor whether the surmise very current in Palestine that the British have viewed this dumping with sympathy because of its all effects on the National Home is justified. These statements do however suggest that the results are not the simple two and two of money coming out of Germany and going advantageously into Palestine. A detached observer of the Washington conference writes me,"I don't think the Britishers will raise much money here." Were I the kind of partizan you imagine me to be I ought to rejoice. In reality I am depressed because I think you have hurt the Jewish cause.

The liquidation of assets is no doubt an intricate problem. It is being worked at in other countries besides Germany. If everywhere the theory you uphold were set in motion paralysis would follow. The one thing a determined boycott could do would be to force Germany to permit the Jews to go on fairly decent terms. You and others have spoiled a moral cause by all this emphasis on "assets," and I have good reason for thinking the general Jewish public agrees with me.

Wise is refurbishing his end of the boycott which implies I presume that he knows he has sustained a defeat. The Non-Sectarian League in my judgment missed its cue. If it had forced Samuel to a show down of a black and white program an interesting situation would have developed.

Of course I think the clear thinking is on my side, but we will I hope live to fight another day.

Dear Dr. Silver:

I was relieved and delighted at the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant. From your long silence I had begun to fear that I had in some unknown and unintended way offended you, and was greatly distressed at your long silence. You may not realize the depth of my appreciation of all your services to the boycott cause, and of your having in addition to the many other burdens assumed the tasks which I have been for the past year unable to perform because of my long continued illness. I do not know what we would have done without you, and want to take this opportunity of expressing my appreciation and that of the Cause for the extent to which you have taken up the burdens that I should have and would have liked to have carried.

My health is still poor, but I believe that it is on the mend, and that on my return to New York in the spring I shall be able, at least to some extent, to shoulder the burdens; meanwhile, I am relying on you and our Executive Committee in New York to carry the load.

I heard of your visit to the Pelestinian Conference in Washington, at which you unanimously put through the two resolutions on the boycott. I have been especially interested in the re-statement of the position of the American Zionists in favor of the boycott, and in pledging its vigorous prosecution, and especially in that part of the resolution to the effect that "whatever plan will be adopted to assist the emigration of Jews from Germany must in no way be tied up with any scheme which would increase German exports or in any way strengthen the economic position of the Nazi Reich." I was very fearful of the effect of the adoption of the plan, and am thoroughly relieved that the protests against it in this country forced its abandonment.

With respect to the Palestine Transfer Agreement, I am distinctly consoled with the official statement, which I now learn was made at the Berlin Headquarters of the "Haavarah", that "Not a single deposit has been accepted in Germany during the year 1935 by the Haavarah for Transfer to Palestine." For a while, after hearing that you had agreed to the Transfer Agreement, which seemed to me to be a great blow to our entire movement, I was greatly disturbed and at a loss to know what to do. I did not want to take any action without consulting you, and I was rather surprised that I had not heard from you, but in the light of what you tell me we have apparently not been hurt. I am sure that the whole thing is capable



Dear Rabbi Silver:

At the very outset I want to assure you that we have bought nothing in Germany excepting religious material (books and a very few pictures). This material was purchased only from Jewish concerns, provided it was made or printed by Jews and published by them. We would not even buy a Jewish book if the printer was a non-Jew. What we did import was only on order from a rabbi or institution. We have been very strict adherents to the boycott rule. But it never occurred to us, for one moment, that this Jewish material was included in the ban. Nor did any one, at any time, call our attention to this.

Now that we understand the situation better, we have cut off any importation, are returning material sent us recently on order, or putting it aside not to be sold. It may interest you to know that ever since Houghton-Mifflin Co. issued the Hitler book, we have not purchased anything from it, have taken all its Jewish books from our list and shelves and have refused to supply any of these to customers wanting same.

I have always differentiated Jewish books from all other merchandise made in Germany. Now that it has been explained to us that one of the purposes of the boycott is to prevent sending any money into that country, no matter even if it is for Jewish publishers, we will abide by the rule.

We would like to have your advice on the following points:

- 1- Are we at liberty to sell books from Germany that were published before 1933, purchased and paid for previous to that date? We have many such books, some being in stock for years. Having been paid for, no money would be sent abroad. As all such books are dated, there can be no evasion if they were purchased since 1933.
- 2- What ought we do in a case like this? The first three volumes of the Heb.-Eng. Pentateuch with Rashi were printed before 1933, the other two volumes since then. The books are published by a London concern and bear its imprint.

> The printing, however was done in Germany. This London publisher has no doubt paid for the printing long ago. Is he to be penalized by Jewish booksellers refusing to purchase any more copies, or would we be permitted to continue to import from the English publisher and owner of the books?

3- What should we do in the matter of subscriptions that had been placed through us on such works as the "Encyclopedia Judaica", the tenth volume of which was sent to you not long ago. This volume was sent to us in June, 1934. Must such subscriptions be cancelled if further volumes are to be issued? What is to be done with subscriptions to Jewish periodicals published in Germany, of which there are a fair number? Most of the subscriptions for books or papers have not been paid for in advance. Any countermanding or cancelling thereof by individuals or booksellers would make them, I believe, legally responsible for further issues, especially of subscription sets.

It is not a matter of profit, as our importations from Germany had not amounted to \$500.00 per year. I am thinking more of the loss that must be sustained by the innocent Jewish printer and publisher in Germany who have made their investments in Jewish literature. The only pictures we have imported were those by Bender, and of which about ten sets per year have been brought over.

I met with Mr. Harriman of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League the other day, who explained the matter and for the first time I had a clear picture of the whole problem and with which we are in full sympathy and have given our full support since the beginning. As I said before, it never occurred to us, nor was it ever brought to our attention that we should cut off all Jewish literature published in Germany. So far as we are concerned, there will be no further importations nor anything sold that bears a date from 1933. Of course we are deeply interested in anything that we can do on the question No.1. Here, we would be the only losers, as all such books were paid for and no payments are due German dealers.

I certainly appreciate your very friendly letter and can assure you that you will not find us remiss in any way after you tell us just what our policy should be. Until then, we are strictly adhering to no sale of German material.

Regarding the Times story of the German penetration of the boycott we enclose herewith a release which we issued the same day the news story appeared. It covers, I believe, the very points you bring up in your letter. I trust that you will consider it an answer to the Tolischus story. We could not get it into the Bulletin because the Bulletin was already on the press at the time the story broke. We may, however, make a feature story of the whole incident in our next issue. In fact, I shall advise the editor to do so. This release was sent out generally and I believe will click.

I am turning over the B'nai B'rith magazine letter to the Research Department and we will get into action regarding Sloane's. So far as the boycott in St. Louis is concerned, the situation is not satisfactory although we received word only last week that the town was pretty clean with the exception of two stores which were not cooperating and which our St. Louis friends asked us to name in the Bulletin and which was done.

Have you heard anything regarding the proposed Joint American Boycott Council to be formed by the Ameri-

can Jewish Congress and the Jewish Labor Committee. The Congress, of course, has been trying to put the boycott burden on other shoulders for some time past and have been talking about this American Joint Boycott Council since early last summer. They tried to draw us into it which would have been fatal to our organization for while the boycott is a loud talking point and a money raising one for the Congress, they have other fish to fry as well. So it is with the Jewish Labor Committee. Had we joined forces with them it would have meant that we were out of business.

Vladeck, who is the bright shining star of the Jewish Labor Committee has assured us again and again, as recently as yesterday, that this tie-up does not mean that the Jewish Labor Committee will not cooperate with us as well. We believe, however, that this Joint American Boycott Council is a bad move and have sent the accompanying letter to the Chairmen of the first joint meeting as well as releasing the same to the Yiddish press. Speakers on our radio programs, and as you no doubt know, we have two Yiddish broadcasts apart from two English programs, stress the same, which we also point out in our letter of protest. I would greatly appreciate your comments on this whole situation. Frankly, I do not think it means a great deal. They will make a lot of hullabaloo but it will not amount to much after all is said and done.

My dear Mr. Bloch:

Please pardon the long delay in answering your letter. I have been away from the city a good deal of the time and my correspondence has lagged. In the last few days I have been confined to my home with a cold.

I am glad to know that you are now pursuing a policy of active participation in the Boycott. I can understand the reasons which caused the confusion in the past. In reply to your specific questions, permit me to say that there is, of course, no objection at all to selling books from Germany that were published and purchased before 1933. In regard to the second question, I would suggest that you can render a service to the cause by contacting with the publishers of the Hebrew-English Pentateuch with Rashi and suggest to them that they ought to discontinue having their printing done in Germany. As regards the third question, I believe that an exception can be made in the case where subscriptions for sets have been ordered and where there is a clear legal responsibility to pay for the sets or the annual subscriptions.

I believe that your own good judgement can be trusted in all these matters. The important thing is that in this life and death struggle with the Nazi Government in which our one effective weapon is the economic boycott, that we exert ourselves to the utmost to employ that weapon most consistently and vigorously.

Dear Dr. Silver:

I am sorry to learn that you have not been well, but hope you have completely recovered by this time. I want to assure you again that we are still continuing our boycott of German made articles. We are probably the only Jewish booksellers here who do observe the rule; our competitors are not particular about it.

We are not importing any books and are not putting any on sale excepting those which we purchased and paid for before we were asked not to continue our dealings with the German publishers.

Some material, which was ordered before the lid was put on, has been received. We feel in duty bound to pay for this, as they were legitimate purchases. We shall not, however, put this material on sale.

As for the Pentateuch published in London but printed in Germany; we believe that these have long been paid for by the publishers and to refuse to purchase further copies would only be hurtful to these publishers, as the Nazi government can derive no benefit. I also feel certain that they are not having any more printing done in Germany, but shall write to them in regard to the matter to be certain of this.

Since the matter was first taken up with us by the Anti-Nazi League, we have refused to accept any orders which would require us to import the book from Germany or to sell anything we bought since that time.


I can only assure you again that, being in thorough sympathy with the Boycott movement, we shall continue to adhere strictly to it.

Dear Mr. Harriman:

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of March 14th and would like to tell you how the incident to which you refer occurred. The buyer for the Gift Department of the New York Store purchased a large quantity of merchandise for the pre-Christmas trade, and through inadvertence, and not by design, certain pieces of so-called Dresden china figurines were included by the supplier in the purchase. The number of these figurines probably was less than a dozen, and their inclusion in the purchase was not intentional on our part. They have all been disposed of, and we do not intend to purchase such merchandise in the future.

During the rush of the pre-Christmas period, our advertising agency unfortunately, released an advertisement to the B'nai B'rith Magazine on very quick notice in order to make the closing date of the February issue of that magazine. In the copy of this advertisement, the figurines illustrated were described as "Dresden china figures". We understand that the advertising agency felt that the term "Dresden" had come to be used as a generic term for a type of decorative article rather than a piece of merchandise specifically made in a particular country.

We regret this incident which, you will appreciate, was an inadvertence due to the hectic rush of holiday business and which we hope did not embarrass the magazine or offend any of our customers.



#### FIFTY-FIVE JEWISH EDITORS DEMAND RESIGNATION OF JOSEPH M. PROSKAUER FROM AMERICAN LIBERTY LEAGUE

Joseph M. Proskauer, former Justice of the New York State Supreme Court, is asked to resign forthwith his membership in the executive committee of the American Liberty League or to withdraw from the Jewish organizations with which he is affiliated, in an open letter addressed to him by Joseph Brainin, editor of the Seven Arts Feature Syndicate, which represents 55 English-Jewish publications throughout the country. This letter, published today in English-Jewish publications from coast to coast, bases its demand on Mr. Proskauer on the recent disclosures by the Senate Lobby Investigating Committee of anti-Semitic activity by leaders of the Sentinels of the Republic, an organization proved to be closely allied with the leadership of the American Liberty League.

Labeling the Sentinels of the Republic "an exact replica of Nazi organizations in Germany before the advent of the Hitler government, Mr. Brainin's letter accuses Mr. Proskauer of being "in exactly the same position as that handful of rich Jews in Germany who, under the delusion that they were safeguarding their own wealth and security, gave financial and moral support to the Nazi movement and have a share in the responsibility for the terror which Hitlerism has visited upon the German nation." At the same time the Seven Arts Feature Syndicate addressed a letter to Dr. Cyrus Adler, president of the American Jewish Committee, urging him to discom Mr. Proskauer, who is a prominent member of the American Jewish Com-

mittee and a former president of the Federation for the Support of Jewish Philanthropic Societies of New York.

The text of the letter to Mr. Proskauer is as follows:

"For some time now your name has been associated with the American Liberty League, as a member of this organization and as a leading force in the direction of its policies.

"In the past fortnight it has developed that the leaders of the American Liberty League have simultaneously endorsed an organization known as The Sentinels of the Republic and have expressed their endorsement through funds subscribed to maintain this organization.

"The Sentinels, through their officers, have clearly indicated that their group is anti-Semitic in purpose and that it looks to a United States Hitler to solve American problems. You can verify this for yourself in the exchange of letters, which are now public property, between Mr. Cleveland Runyon and Mr. Alexander Lincoln.

"We should like to know how you, as a Jew and one who has laid claim to Jewish leadership as a member of the American Jewish Committee and of other organizations, reconcile yourself to membership in the American Liberty League. From the outset it has been obvious that the Liberty League is Fascist in purpose. The Fascist character of the organization is proved beyond all doubt through the espousal of the anti-Semitic Sentinels organization.

"The Seven Arts Feature Syndicate represents 55 Anglo-Jewish publications in this country with an aggregate circulation of over half a million readers. Speaking in behalf of that large body of public opinion, we demand your immediate resignation from the Liberty League, and your public condemnation of its policies.

"There can be no question that your continuance as a leader of both the American Liberty League and Jewish organizations in this country is distasteful to every self-respecting Jew who feels that the recent revelations of the activities of the Sentinels are an exact replica of the development of the Nazi movement before Hitler's ascension to power, and consequently a direct threat to Jewish security in this country.

"You are in exactly the same position as that handful of rich Jews in Germany who, under the delusion that they were safeguarding their own wealth and security, gave financial and moral support to the Nazi movement, and have a share in the responsibility for the terror which Hitlerism has visited upon the German

nation.

"You must therefore decide whether you wish to withdraw from the American Liberty League or from organized Jewish life.

"Because the subject of this communication is of such vital interest to so large a body of Jewish public opinion, we are addressing you in an open letter, to which we are giving simultaneous publication in all of our affiliated magazines and newspapers.

"We look to you for an immediate reply, which we will release to the same publications upon receipt."

The text of the letter to Dr. Cyrus Adler is as follows:

We address ourselves to you in behalf of that large body of Jewish public opinion which we serve through fifty-five newspapers in the United States, on a matter which vitally concerns the welfare of the Jewish people.

"We refer to the recent disclosures of a close connection between the American Liberty League and the Sentinels of the Republic. The Sentinels, you will recall, are an organization which is anti-Semitic in purpose and which looks to a United States Hitler to solve American problems. The exchange of communications between Mr. Cleveland Runyon and Mr. Alexander Lincoln, President of the Sentinels, is now public property, having been published in the press throughout the country. The Sentinels are subsidized by men who are leaders of the American Liberty League.

"It is with deep regret that we must point out to you that one or more leaders of the American Jewish Committee are also associated with the American Liberty League and therefore must be held responsible for its policies. For instance, the Hon. Joseph M. Proskauor, a member of your National Executive Committee, is associated with the American Liberty League and serves as a member of its Executive Committee.

"We have addressed ourselves in an open letter to Mr. Proskauer today, asking him to condemn the policies of the Sentinels, to resign from membership in the American Liberty League, or else to read himself out of the Jewish community by giving up all the offices which he holds in Jewish organizations, including your own.

"We feel that this matter is of such gravity that the American Jewish Committee should take immediate steps to define its own position in the light of Judge Proskauer's record since the rise of Hitlerism.

"It is our considered conviction that the American Liberty League is Fas-

cist in purpose and that its development in the United States parallels exactly the development of the National Socialist movement in Germany.

"We should like to recall to you that in the early days of the National Socialist movement there was a small group of wealthy Jews who gave financial and moral support to the Nazi regime. These Jews must share the responsibility for the terror which has been visited upon the entire German nation by Nazism and by the threat which Nazism constitutes today for all civilization.

"Mr. Proskauer, if he should retain his membership in the American Liberty League, places himself in precisely the same position as the rich Jews of Germany who supported Nazism.

"In this connection we recall to you that a little more than a year ago Mr. Proskauer gave utterance to a statement in the public press of this country indicating his espousal of the Liberty League policies. In an article which appeared in the New York World- Telegram of February 5, 1935, he brought an accusation of divided loyalties against Jews who regard themselves as members of the Jewish race and who act as a group to preserve Jewish rights. He identified the American Jewish Committee with these views. That statement was challenged by every selfrespecting American Jewish citizen and by every Jewish group in the United States. The American Jewish Committee, however, remained silent on Mr. Proskauer's statement.

"We believe that this lack of disavowal of Mr. Proskauer's statement by you a year ago, and his continuance as a member of your organization, which is pledged to the defense of Jewish rights, is harmful not only to the American Jewish Committee but to the Jewish community of this country.

"We therefore ask, in the interests of the Jews of America, for a clearcut statement by the American Jewish Committee on its attitude toward the American Liberty League and corollary organizations as they reflect upon the Jewish position in this country, its views with regard to Jews who are members of these organizations, and the immediate resignation of Judge Proskauer and others of his associates in or donors to the Liberty League as members of the American Jewish Committee.

"We believe that the Jowish community of America has the right to request such action by you as an expression of your deep concern about the possibility of Fascism in the United States and the danger it represents to Jewish rights and Jewish existence in this country."

I wonder whether the letters I sent to Mr. Joseph M. Proskauer and Dr. Cyrus Adler, copies of which are enclosed, have come to your attention. My dear Mr. Brainin:

Please pardon the delay in answering your letter of April 27. I have not been well and my correspondence has lagged.

I am not persuaded that the American Liberty League is an anti-Semitic organization. I understand that within the last few days it has publicly disavowed any anti-Semitic taint. I do not believe that we serve the best interests of our people when we force an anti-Semitic label upon an organization which has no anti-Semitic program. There are plenty of the other kind whom we have to fight and there will be plenty more. That certain leaders of the American Liberty League have also supported the Sentinels of the Hepublic does not, of course, change the status of the Liberty League.

You probably know that I have had "set tos" with Judge Proskauer before. I recall writing an editorial some time ago about the Judge in connection with some statements which he made on the subject of the Anti-Nazi Boycott. You will therefore readily understand that I am not interested in defending him. But he is a conservative or a reactionary in his politics and in his economics - which is the right of every man in a free country, if he so chooses, - and many such people are finding their way into the American Liberty League.

#### EXCERPTS FROM INTRODUCTORY ADDRESS BROADCAST BY REV. CHARLES E. COUGHLIN OF DETROIT

el de al

On behalf of this audience and on my own behalf may I welcome this opportunity to folicitate the gentlemen of the radio world who believe in practicing the spirit of free speech and who adhere to the sound philosophy that truth need have no fear of sophistry and of falsehood, its twin rivals. As long as this policy is adhered to these independent radio stations need have no fear of being nationalized or socialized under any government.

\*\*

Without you to whom this hour belongs in every sense regardless of your race, your color or your creed---without you I could not even purchase twenty-six seconds of time let alone twenty-six hours. This I dare not forget, nor will I ever forget it, as I read letters from humble taxi man, from disparaged Jew, from colored washer-woman as well as from Protestant and Catholic and from citizen of no religious affiliation. And this I will not forget as I plan to chart my course safely distant from the destructive sheals of racial, of religious and of national bigotry.

I make mention of this because those who are hired to defend the tainted interests of the exploiting class both by innuendo and by malicious suggestion have endeavored at one time to turn against me, for instance, the good will of the Polish people and at another time to arouse resentment in the hearts of the Jewish people because of imaginary slanders supposed to have originated over this microphone.

In passing, may I remark that if there is anti-Jewish propaganda being maliciously circulated it will never find support from a Catholic pulpit. And be it recorded for the benefit of the slanderers of the Jew that to my knowledge not many Jews of any importance held office in Washington during the period of the past twenty years which was recently characterized as the "period of conspiracy against the poor." On the other hand I admire the majority of our Jewish people for withholding their support from the frenzied few who clamored for embargoes against Germany where Protestant and Catholic citizens are suffering at the hands of a Hitler a religious persecution surpassed only by the Communists of Russia and of Mexico.

In this contest for financial freedom both Catholic and Protestant, Jew and Gentile, black and white must stand shoulder to shoulder undivided by the paid agents of those few Jews or few Gentiles who either through ignorance or malice hold us fast in financial servitude. Not all Jews are in this. Thanks be to God, the vast majority of them as well as the vast majority of Gentiles are fellow sufferers and, if needs be, fellow battlers for our independence.

This admonition I leave with you today as we face the future unperturbed. Like the majority of you I am burdened with a debtof exactly \$179,000 but with immediate resources to carry on this work of broadcasting for three weeks longer.

Because of this I do not worry. For believe me, I can truthfully say that it is no personal pleasure or happiness to find myself constantly in the limelight of the public eye. Not that I fear it. But I detest and abhor being made into commercial copy when I view the serene lives of those, my more fortunate fellow priests, who unheralded and unsung accomplish their work in the silence of a simple countryside distant from the turmoil of the battlefront where I find myself today.

But returning from that excursion into the land of egoism, let me dwell once more on the theme of bigotry. I believe that it was a story book judge who on seeing the prisoner asked the clerk of the court: "What is this man charged with?" "Your Honor", said the clerk, "This man has three wives. He is charged with bigotry." "Why, you poor ignoramus," said the judge, "you don't know what the legal terms are. Bigotry is where you have two wives. When you've got three its trigonometry." -2-

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My friends, we must learn this much from the judge's definition before we can carry our fight for liberty to a successful conclusion. We must avoid the three mistakes of being led astray by either racial or religious or political bigotry. "Together we stand. Divided we fall," is true today as of yesterday.

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I have been an ardent supporter of this so-called new deal. I will never be a supporter of those who wish us to return to that yesterday which is as dead as feudalism. I make mention of this as I endeavor to gauge the future as bounded by the next few years. The past two years of the new deal, to my mind, witnessed the accomplishment of several notable changes for the betterment of society. Gold has been nationalized. Its price has been revaluated in theory only. Silver has been nationalized but not used to any great extent. The principles for the regulations of industry have been established. The control of credit by the Federal government has been enunciated. These are a few of the infants which we have brought to birth and placed in the newly-made cradles. Let me emphasize that they are only infants, totally undeveloped. While we have been busy rocking cradles, we have been likewise busy, engaged in digging graves. In one we have placed the corpse of child labor. In another are the remains of the sweatshops. In a third is the hide-out holding company which, by the way, at least as far as Michigan is concerned, received its unhely interment but last week in our State Supreme Court when the stockholders in these holding companies, seeking to avoid the payment of double liablity, were dismissed with empty hands and saddened hearts. It is because of these graves and because of these cradles that we have hope in tomorrow. It is because we still have faith in the courage of our Prosident and in the stalwart uprighteousness and integrity of his Secretary of the Treasury, Henry Morgenthau, Jr., faith in these men to nurse the financial infants into maturity and to keep the international bankers and Wall Street profiteers at a healthy distance from the Treasury Building. Because of our confidence in these gentlemen, I fully anticipato that the strike engineered by the capitalists soon will be dissipated. I fully anticipate that money will soon be loaned by the banks, oven by banks that are half-owned by the R. F. C., banks which today are just as hard-hearted as the banks owned by Wall Street. Let them get started and get money out of the R. F. C. banks, one of which we have in Detroit and which is frozen tighter than an iceberg. Annual wages shall supplant the new impractical hourly wago system; that want in the midst of plonty shall coaso and that our system of unbearable taxation shall be romodolod.

Of course, there are many new deal ideas with which I am not in sympathy. But I realize that our President and his associates are pioneering and therefore experimenting. But I am not at all in sympathy with the organized propaganda so adreitly conducted to damn him for feeding the hungry, for clothing the naked and for sheltering the homeless---conducted by men' whose only philosophy has been negative as they cling to the past with its pagan theory in the supromacy of financial rights.

This is the reason that you were not informed earlier.

Dear Doctor Silver:

Thank you for your letter of May 26th received this morning and postmarked Cleveland June 2nd.

During the past fix months we have approached every Jewish Welfare Federation throughout the country, using every name listed in the Jewish Year Book. I therefore cannot understand why the drive leaders informed you that they had received no request from our office. I know that we have on many occasions received forms from several funds requesting information as to our activities and from others letters advising us that our request will be put before their board when the question of allotment comes up. If you consider it wise we shall send a special letter once more, although as I previously stated, every one of them has been approached, including the Federation in Buffalo.

We received the letter addressed to you from the United Jewish Campaign for Foreign Relief and Rehabilitation of Buffalo which we returned to your office yesterday in which was stated that we were not included in this particular drive. However, this seems on the surface, to be a special emergency fund and not the general Welfare Organization.

I am however, writing to this organization as suggested by you and trust that this action and your presence may be helpful to our cause.

My dear Mr. Saperston:

With the inception of your drive to raise funds for worthy causes, I have been requested by Mr. Samuel Untermyer, President of our League, who is at the moment forbidden by his physicians to handle his correspondence personally, to request most urgently that our organization be included among those to be benefited by your campaign.

Cipy - Dr. Silver

For over three years we have been in the forefront of the fight against Naziism. We have inaugurated, conducted and expanded the boycott of German goods and services, believing that this is the only method by which Hitlerism can be destroyed.

Our efforts have been largely successful in reducing German imports into this country by 43% in the year 1935 as against the 1932 figures. We are affiliated with a world boycott organisation which was set up at the direct instigation of our League and which, under the leadership of the World Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi Council in London, directs boycott activities of organizations in 21 countris. We have established the only Research Department which can and does furnish American merchants and manufacturers with substitute sources of supply for German wares. We publish the only organ devoted exclusively to anti-Nazi activity, our Anti-Nazi Economic Bulletin, copy of which is enclosed. We have organized groups throughout the country for hoycott work and have issued propaganda continuously against the Nazi menace.

We enclose herewith copies of two of our most recent pamphlets, both of which have been received enthusiastically throughout the country.

In conclusion I may say that we have been supported entirely by public subscriptions and we trust that Alfred W. Saperston, Chairman (2)

because of the importance and necessity of our work, you will find it feasible to include us among the organizations to be aided by your community.
