Dear Friend:


At a conference held in New York on June 10th it was decided that the Palestine Development Associates (Temporary title) should be run on such lines that no part of any contribution made for Palestine should be used to cover the expenses of the organization. To that end, an Administration Fund was started, and towards the suggested budget of \$25,000 about \$13,000 was immediately pledged, the larger part being individually subscribed by the few present at the meeting.

Offices have been opened, and arrangements made for a formal conference at Pittsburgh, Pa., on July 3rd and 4th. It is our earnest hope that the whole of this Administration Fund will be covered prior to our assembling at Pittsburgh so that the conference can deal with practical Palestinian prospects, and so that the solicitation of any funds, undertaken at Pittsburgh, if that be the wish of the conference, shall be for Palestinian purposes only.

In order to accomplish this we are appealing to all our friends to make their contributions to the Administration Fund, if possible by return mail. Make your check as large as possible, but the smallest contributions will also be accepted with gratitude.
