(House Joint Resolution No. 45)

JOINT RESOLUTION

Relative to the rights of the Jewish people.

WHEREAS, The future prosperity and peace of the world depends upon a just and equitable settlement of the European war whereby each and every nationality, however small, shall be granted the liberty to determine its own destiny and the opportunity of living its own life; and

WHEREAS, The government of the United States of America is recognized as an ardent exponent of the rights of small nations; therefore be it

Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Ohio:

That in its opinion the national aspirations and historic claims of the Jewish people with regard to Palestine should be recognized at the peace conference, in accordance with the British government's declaration of November second, nineteen hundred and seventeen, that there be established such political, administrative and economic conditions in Palestine as will assure the development of Palestine into a Jewish commonwealth, and that the American representatives at the peace conference should use their best endeavors to facilitate the achievement of this object; be it further

Resolved, That it is the opinion of the general assembly of the state of Ohio, that express provisions be made at the peace conference for the purpose of granting the Jewish people in every land the complete enjoyment of life, liberty and the opportunities for national development to the end that justice may be done to one of the most suffering people on earth,—the Jewish people; and be it further

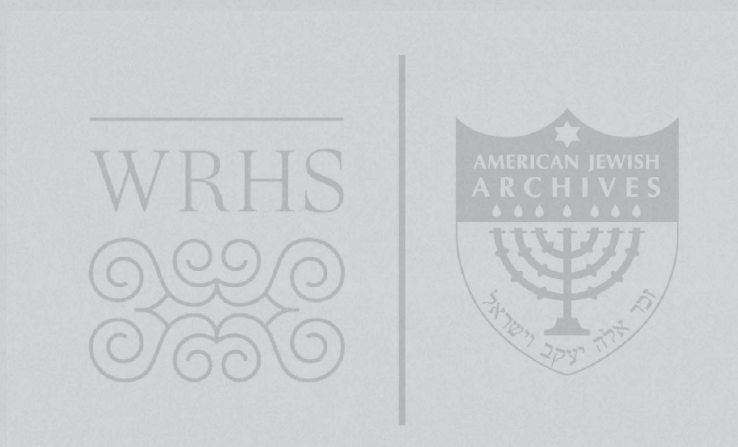
Resolved, That the secretary of state be and he is hereby directed to send duly certified copies of this resolution to each of the repre-

sentatives of this state in the senate and house of representatives of the United States and to each of the representatives of the United States in attendance as members of the peace conference assembled at Paris.
