My dear Rabbi Silver:

We are now about to engage in a campaign for the Palestine Restoration Fund, intending to raise \$3,000,000 within the next 30 days.

I am writing to you to ascertain whether it will be possible for you to give us your services for a period of a week or ten days to address specially arranged meetings in some of the large cities of the Middle West. The cities that we should like to have you visit are Detroit, Chicago, Milwaukee, Minneapolis and St. Paul. We would, naturally, provide all the necessary expenses involved, and if you so desire, we would make special arrangements with you for compensation for the services rendered.

I should like to be in a position before the end of the week to take this matter up with my committee and to get their approval of the plan that I have in mind.

Will you please let us know as soon as possible whether you can give us the week or ten days that are required for this service in the Middle West?

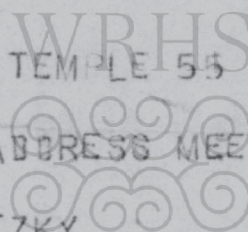

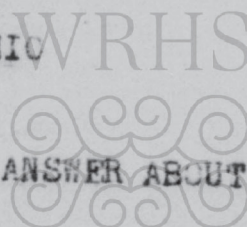


I regret, of course, that you cannot be with us in St. Louis.

My dear Dr. Silver:-


