My dear Rabbi Silver:

We are now about to engage in a campaign for the Palestine Restoration Fund, intending to raise \$3,000,000 within the next 30 days.

I am writing to you to ascertain whether it will be possible for you to give us your services for a period of a week or ten days to address specially arranged meetings in some of the large cities of the Middle West. The cities that we should like to have you visit are Detroit, Chicago, Milwaukee, Minneapolis and St. Paul. I should like to be in a position before the end of the week to take this matter up with my committee and to get their approval of the plan that I have in mind.

### United States Circuit Court of Appeals

Woolworth Bldg., New York, Jan 30, 1919.

Dear Rabbi Silver:

Your telegram was addressed to me to Chicago last Sunday instead of to the Woolworth Bldg., as I requested you in my letter to you. The result is that instead of re-telegraphing it to me on Monday from Chicago, they mailed it to me in time to reach me on Tuesday morning, but unfortunately they addressed the envelope containing all of Monday's mail incorrectly, so that it did not reach me until this morning. I give you this explanation because I sent you another telegram on Wednesday in reference to the same matter.

I regret, of course, that you cannot be with us in St. Louis.


