

Nothing would give me greater pleasure than to spend some time with you and your charming family. Unfortunately I can not see my way clear to come to you in June. I am pretty heavily dated up with local engagements and I have accepted some out-of-town engagements in the interest of the Allied Jewish Campaign. Besides, there are three or four important conferences that I must attend during that month. I regret more than I can say that I have to decline the invitation from you. But I do hope that at some future time, not far distant, I may be able to come to Canada in behalf of the Palestine cause.
