Dear Dr. Silver:

In accordance with your request, I am forwarding to you herewith information received from underground sources in Palestine concerning the security situation there:

Brigadier Clayton conferred repeatedly with the Mufti in Cairo last August, offering him British support in arms, money and military advisers for the organization of a large-scale revolt against the Yishuv;

According to reports Clayton is now traveling through Syria and Lebanon for the purpose of organizing Arab bands to invade Palestine;

A fortnight ago, O'Sullivan, Assistant Deputy Commissioner of the C.I.D. in Jerusalem, distributed arms to Arabs in Jenin;

Capt. Pullman of the C.I.D. in Jerusalem was in the Negev at the beginning of September where he distributed large supplies of British arms of the latest models to the Bedouins;

The Bedouins in turn sold the arms to Jewish underground emissaries and informed them of the British transaction;

Major Farran, accused of murdering a young Jew, was recently exonerated by a British Court in Jerusalem and has established headquarters in Nablus;

He and his 12 assistants are distributing arms among the Arabs, training and organizing them for attacks on Jews;

It has been disclosed that the British plan of action is to direct Arab attacks against isolated Jewish settlements,

and cordon off the populated Jewish sections in order to prevent Jewish security forces from sending aid to the attacked.

The above information is authentic and thoroughly reliable.



Your Excellency,

Your late father, Dr. Sun Yat-sen, as champion of true democratic principles and ideals, wholeheartedly supported the Zionist movement, and in this most critical moment when the destiny of the Jewish nation is to be decided by the United Nations Organization, we feel bolstered by the faith that the UNO is governed by the same principles.


If, indeed, the present UNO decision is to be based on justice and human rights, we feel the UNO cannot but endorse the decree internationally sanctioned by its predecessor the League of Nations, so that the Jewish nation, which so devotedly served the cause of the Allies, will be restored in an independent state in Palestine, the absence of which caused, in the last decade, the extermination of practically one-third of our people.

Typical of the words of the greatest of leaders and statesmen, the utterances of Dr. Sun Yat-sen bear added vibrance and significance with the passage of time, and his statements on behalf of Zionist aims are timely and appropriate today, for they are a product of a deep understanding of human and political problems.

We feel confident of China's sympathy for our cause, and would greatly appreciate to receive from you a letter expressing your sentiments in endorsement.
