My dear Rabbi Silver:

There seems to be some difficulty about the prompt delivery of my telegram to Mr. Wohl in Cleveland.

We had Dr. Wise booked for the 16th on a Sunday, but he has been away so long from New York that he finds he simply must keep his Synagogue engagements and cannot leave New York before 1 P. M. on any Sunday. Consequently we have had to change the date to ~~Friday~~ *Thursday* the 20th.

You will appreciate the fact that we have over a million dollars to raise in New York and that with so many of our people abroad we are working under extremely great difficulties. We appreciate deeply your participation in the work in Cleveland.
