to wipe out the long-standing deficit of the Zionist Organization  
of America.

the handicap of this debt for some years and it has seriously  
hampered its activities.

At the last convention in Cleveland, I made  
an appeal to the delegates to lift this burden and over  
\$100,000 was pledged, of which Cleveland, being the convention  
city and the one in which the final peace was consummated between  
the warring factions in the Movement undertook to raise \$10,000.  
I personally pledged \$1500.

My dear Dr. Garber:-

You will probably recall that at the last Zionist Convention we pledged the sum of \$10,000 as Cleveland's share in wiping out the deficit of the Zionist Organization of America.

I am sure there must be quite a number among them who are gratified at the results of the new union which has been consummated and who would wish to facilitate the work of the new leadership by lifting the burden of debt. Would it be possible for your physicians' group to raise, say, the sum of \$1000?

While the pledges should be made now, payment of them can be made over a period of six months.

Dear Friend:-

A new era in American Zionism began with the union of all the forces in the movement which was accomplished at the Convention held in Cleveland last month.

Justice Brandeis of the United States Supreme Court and Judge Mack have officially returned to the leadership of the movement. The hope is universally held that the movement will now enter upon a great period of growth and development.

One of the serious problems which confronted the new administration was a deficit which had accumulated over a period of years and which had to be liquidated in order to enable it to function smoothly and without financial embarrassment.

At the Cleveland Convention I appealed to the delegates present to wipe out this deficit and a sum well over \$100,000 was pledged by the spokesmen of the various communities in this country. Cleveland, as the convention city, pledged the sum of \$10,000.

I am writing to a small group of men in our community urging upon them to contribute to this deficit fund, thereby insuring the uninterrupted progress of the movement in this country. The burden of the debt once lifted, our leaders will be able to devote themselves to the many pressing problems which ~~face~~ we are involved in the Palestinian situation today.

It is, of course, impossible to launch any extensive campaign for this purpose. The appeal must necessarily be limited to a very small number. I will appreciate any helpful contribution which you may make to this cause.

My dear Rabbi Silver:-

I have given your letter serious consideration and I came to the conclusion that a campaign among physicians to cover the Zionist deficit is hardly advisable.

To begin with the deficit of the Zionist organization is a matter of concern only to organized Zionists. So-called sympathizers with Palestine, lukewarm Jews, are not much concerned with our inner difficulties and are not likely to respond to our appeal to help us lighten our burden.

Just about a year ago, I have raised some money among the Zionist doctors of Mt. Sinai for same purpose, and I fear that unless they suffer a lapse of memory they will remind me of those contributions they have made. Personally, I have contributed twice before to cover this same deficit within the last two years. I am ready to contribute again \$50.00 for same purpose.

In addition to the general depression the difficulty in this matter is also

Justice Brandeis of the United States Supreme Court and Judge Mack have officially returned to the leadership of the movement. The hope is universally held that the movement will now enter upon a great period of growth and development.

One of the serious problems which confronted the new administration was a deficit which had accumulated over a period of years and which had to be liquidated in order to enable it to function smoothly and without financial embarrassment.

At the Cleveland Convention I appealed to the delegates present to wipe out this deficit and a sum well over \$100,000 was pledged by the spokesmen of the various communities in this country. Cleveland, as the convention city, pledged the sum of \$10,000.

One of the serious problems which confronted the new administration was a deficit which had accumulated over a period of years and which had to be liquidated in order to enable it to function smoothly and without financial embarrassment.

At the Cleveland Convention I appealed to the delegates present to wipe out this deficit and a sum well over \$100,000 was pledged by the spokesmen of the various communities in this country. Cleveland, as the convention city, pledged the sum of \$10,000.

I am writing to the registered members of the Zionist District of Cleveland to urge upon them to contribute to this Deficit Fund, thereby insuring the uninterrupted progress of the movement in this country.

It is very difficult to appeal for such a fund to non-Zionists. It clearly devolves upon those who are members of the organization and who realize the absolute importance of enabling the American Zionist Organization to carry on a firm and aggressive Zionist educational program in this country to wipe out this deficit. The burden of debt once lifted, our leaders will be able to devote themselves to the many pressing problems which are involved in the Palestinian situation today.

It is, of course, impossible to launch any extensive campaign for this purpose at this time. The appeal must necessarily be limited to a small number of interested men and women. I would deeply appreciate any helpful contribution which you may make to this cause. Please send these contributions to me.

My dear Alfred:

I am very much perturbed about the fact that the Cleveland Zionists have not as yet made good their pledge of \$10,000 towards the Deficit Fund. It is extremely embarrassing to receive a stream of communications from New York asking what Cleveland is doing to make good its pledge.

As you well know the Zionist District has so far failed to beatir itself and it is now more than a year since the pledge was made. I suspect active sabotage on the part of some members of the District.

Unless some substantial funds are raised before next Fall nothing will be done before the next Zionist convention because the Community Fund Campaign will intervene.

I am leaving the city next Tuesday for my summer vacation. I shall be gone until the first of September. Unless we can count upon someone who would take the responsibility and the initiative in this matter there is very little prospect that anything will be done.

At the time of Robert Schild's visit to Cleveland you expressed a desire to help in the work. I wonder whether you would not undertake to supervise this activity during the summer. I believe that if five men would take the matter earnestly and personally interview a group of people in our community who are still able to make a contribution, a substantial sum of money could be raised, if not the entire amount.

The Zionist Organization of America is in desperate need of funds and only this morning I received a pleading letter from New York asking for immediate help because the banks were pressing very hard.

Dear Rabbi Silver:

Replying to yours of June 25th, please be advised that I have similarly been somewhat worried about the fact that the Cleveland Zionists have not yet made good their pledge towards the deficit fund. Personally, I do not consider it a consolation that the other districts have even done worse than we.

Sunday morning I had a meeting with George Klein and several other active Zionists, when we discussed the matter thoroughly. They seem to be of the opinion that it would be next to impossible to raise a substantial sum during the summer, especially since the purpose is to cover part of an old deficit and since the deficit continues to grow, and that any amount raised in Cleveland at the present time would in no way alleviate the situation.

As to the latter consideration I believe we must all be in accord. However, as to the possibility of raising a few thousand dollars I am still of the opinion that it can be done if a real effort be made. I do not know how much cooperation I can get, and frankly, I am afraid to undertake the sponsorship of this effort since I have been working hellishly hard during the last few months and I do not believe I can give this the necessary time.

However, I have agreed to prepare a list of names of people of some means and who are on the periphery of the Cleveland Zionist movement. It is these men especially that I believe we can induce to give us some money for this purpose on the basis of a general Jewish obligation to liquidate the present indebtedness of the Zionist Organization of America. I shall prepare this list during the week and again confer with my committee. I hope to be able to work out some plan of approach to the problem. If you will send to my office your vacation address I should be glad to communicate with you in a week or two to tell you what progress we are making.



My dear Mr. Magida: In Re: New Cleveland Zio District

Your letter addressed to Rabbi Silver was forwarded to me and I am of the opinion that we should do everything possible to encourage this new group and give them any possible assistance that will enable them to attempt to build up Zionist membership.

The matter of the formation of this new group has neither been discussed by the Cleveland District nor our Executive Committee. My personal opinion, however, is that this effort should be assisted.

With reference to their retaining one third of the dues collected, I might say that this matter of local operating expense is one that is very troublesome and we discussed this matter at length with Mr. De Haas in New York City some time ago.

While he agreed with us that no local group could operate on \$1.00 per head, he intimated that some groups were retaining a larger portion than one sixth of the dues collected even though there is no legal provision for so doing and inasmuch as the group which Miss Tarletz refers to spend a large portion of their time on J.W.F work and represent the major portion of J.W.F workers in Cleveland, they will be unable to raise money through side affairs without depreciating their J.W.F collection. So if it is at all possible to allow this additional money I would recommend it.

I would also ask that a letter be sent to them urging them to enroll new members rather than dividing the present district.



Dear Friend:-

A new era in American Zionism began with the union of all the forces in the movement which was accomplished at the Convention held in Cleveland last month.

Justice Brandeis of the United States Supreme Court and Judge Mack have officially returned to the leadership of the movement. The hope is universally held that the movement will now enter upon a great period of growth and development.

One of the serious problems which confronted the new administration was a deficit which had accumulated over a period of years and which had to be liquidated in order to enable it to function smoothly and without financial embarrassment.

At the Cleveland Convention I appealed to the delegates present to wipe out this deficit and a sum well over \$100,000 was pledged by the spokesmen of the various communities in this country. Cleveland, as the convention city, pledged the sum of \$10,000.

I am writing to a small group of men in our community urging upon them to contribute to this deficit fund, thereby insuring the uninterrupted progress of the movement in this country. The burden of the debt once lifted, our leaders will be able to devote themselves to the many pressing problems which are involved in the Palestinian situation today.

It is, of course, impossible to launch any extensive campaign for this purpose. The appeal must necessarily be limited to a very small number. I will appreciate any helpful contribution which you may make to this cause.
