My dear Mr. Ziv-Ab:

I am deeply grateful to you for writing to me and for sending me a copy of the article on "Silver Without Dollars," which appeared in the "Haboker" on March 27. I read it with deep interest and I appreciate very much your spirit of fairness and your penetrating analysis of the situation.

On my recent visit to Palestine I became more convinced than ever that the Yishuv has not been taken in by the inspired propaganda motivated by party interests against American Zionists or against me. The rank and file Zionist, both in Palestine and in the United States, is not a dunce.

I agree with you fully that I should spend more time in Palestine. Nothing would please me more. But you realize I am sure, that our political front line is at present in the United States. It is here where we must concentrate our maximum political power. Those of us who know the American scene and understand the decisive role which America must play in the United Nations feel duty-bound to remain here until the work is done, or at least until the first decisive stage is passed.

Please convey my best greetings to all my friends on the "Haboker." This important newspaper ought to become the mouthpiece of a united and aggressive General Zionist movement in Palestine.

My dear Mr. Sullivan:

The United States Government has made positive commitments in favor of a Jewish National Home in Palestine since the Wilson Administration.

Your own Democratic Party in its platform of 1944 made the following pledge: "WE FAVOR THE OPENING OF PALESTINE TO UNRESTRICTED JEWISH IMMIGRATION AND COLONIZATION, AND SUCH A POLICY AS TO RESULT IN THE ESTABLISHMENT THERE OF A FREE AND DEMOCRATIC JEWISH COMMONWEALTH".

We are distressed over the stand the United States has taken in the U.N. proceedings to date. However, we expect our Government to carry out its pledges. I assure you that the Administration's record on Palestine will be remembered by me, and those whom I can influence, either with gratitude or with bitterness.
