Dr. Emmanuel Neumann, Président du Comité Administratif de la Confédération Sioniste Mondiale et de l'Organisation Sioniste d'Amérique, envoie, au nom des sionistes américains, le message suivant au peuple juif :

« 5718 sera une année lourde de problèmes pour le peuple juif. Elle demandera de nouveau du peuple juif entier d'accepter avec pleine conscience la responsabilité de l'avenir.

Nous sommes obligés d'envisager de la manière la plus sérieuse les dangers très graves qui menacent de plus en plus près l'Etat d'Israël.

Mais de même qu'Israël, malgré les ombres sinistres de l'agression soviétoco-arabe pesant sur elle, n'a pas cessé d'avancer dans sa tâche historique de recréer la nation israélienne, de même chaque Juif poursuivra son travail pourachever l'édification et la sécurité d'Israël. Il travaillera pour la libérer des menaces de guerre continues. Il aidera au développement de son économie nationale. Il contribuera à enrichir sa culture et, en consé-

quence, à rehausser l'existence juive partout.

En Amérique, ainsi que dans les autres pays de la Diaspora, nous sommes obligés de combattre les forces corrosives de l'assimilation, en donnant une expression plus

complète à notre grand héritage spirituel.

A l'occasion de la nouvelle année, dédions-nous tous à nouveau à ces objectifs, qui sont ceux du Sionisme. En remplissant nos responsabilités envers Israël, en conservant nos valeurs juives et en gagnant de nouveaux membres pour notre Mouvement, nous serons les bâtisseurs d'une vie pour notre peuple à la fois plus sûre et pleine de signification profonde. »

LE SIONISME GÉNÉRAL TRIOMPHE malgré les mensonges de ses ennemis

Il y a un mois que Mme Rose Halperin, de la Hadassa, et ses alliés essayent de briser l'Organisation Sioniste le plus grand de tous les partis du Congrès Sioniste — la Confédération Mondiale des Sionistes Généraux. Depuis Août, la « Zionistic Stimme » publie maintes déclarations aussi loin de la vérité que leurs auteurs ne le sont du sionisme.

Ils racontent, par exemple, que les Sionistes Généraux de l'Australie, de l'Afrique du Sud, de l'Amérique Latine se sont ralliés autour du drapeau... — pardon, ce n'est pas exact, puisque la seule idée de ces messieurs est justement de renoncer à avoir un drapeau — disons donc : de se rallier autour du bureau de Mme Halperin et du Dr. Goldstein à New-York et autour de M. Bakstanski à Londres.

Nous publions ci-dessous l'affirmation du Secrétaire Général de la Z.O.A., qui nous autorise à déclarer que ce sont des **mensonges grossiers**. Ni l'Afrique du Sud ni l'Australie n'ont cessé d'être loyales à la Confédération Sioniste Générale légale, celle qui maintient l'unité inébranlable entre les sionistes de la Diaspora et ceux d'Israël — la nôtre.

Ce ne sont pas seulement les racontars de l'hebdomadaire progres-

siste parisien qui propagent ces mensonges. Leur maître, M. BAKSTANSKI, commandant en chef de la fédération sioniste anglaise, aime, lui aussi, à tromper son public.

Il a, par exemple, publié dans le « Jewish Chronicle » que, le 8 septembre, un « special meeting » (séance spéciale) de l'Exécutif de la Fédération Sioniste Générale d'Europe et d'Afrique du Nord a voté « support et adhérence » pour la Confédération Mondiale dite « ré-organisée » des dames de la Hadassa et des progressistes dits non-partisans. Son rapport prétend qu'à cette séance « spéciale » ont participé des délégués de presque toute l'Europe.

C'EST UNE TROMPERIE RIDICULE :

■ Les deux vice-présidents de l'Exécutif de la Confédération Européenne, Dr. KLEE (Président de la Fédération Sioniste Suisse) et M. ANISFELD (Secrétaire Général de l'Organisation Sioniste Belge), ainsi que les deux membres de l'Exécutif représentant l'O.S.F., MM. LE CONSEIL EUROPEEN DES SIONISTES GÉNÉRAUX

Comme premier pas vers l'Organisation des Sionistes Généraux d'Europe et de l'Afrique du Nord, un conseil européen fut créé, le 2 septembre, à Paris, constitué provisoirement par cinq membres pour la France, quatre pour la Belgique, quatre pour la Grande-Bretagne et quatre pour la Suisse, deux pour l'Autriche, deux pour le Danemark, un pour la Tunisie. L'Exécutif du Conseil Européen est composé comme suit :

M. ORFUS (Paris), Président; M. LUKSENBURG (Paris), Vice-Président; M. ANISFELD (Anvers), Secrétaire Général; Dr. Hans KLEE (Zurich), Trésorier.

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LES SIONISTES GENERAUX GAGNENT LA BATAILLE

M. ILUTOVITSCH, Secrétaire Général de l'Organisation Sioniste d'Amérique, venant d'Israël, a déclaré à une réunion avec des membres de l'Exécutif de l'O.S.E., le 20 septembre :

« Les manœuvres des progressistes ont échoué.

« Excepté les organisations du Canada et de la Grande-Bretagne, il n'y a pas une seule organisation sioniste d'importance qui ait suivi les auteurs du coup d'état de la Hadassa.

« L'immense majorité des 600.000 Juifs de l'Amérique Latine est avec nous ; leur enthousiasme pour notre cause, pour l'unité avec les sionistes d'Israël, ne cesse de grandir. Ils ont engagé une véritable lutte dans leur pays.

« L'Afrique du Sud, ainsi que l'Australie et la Nouvelle-Zélande, restent loyales et sont avec nous.

« En Europe — du moins sur le Continent — la majorité des sionistes organisés s'est ralliée autour du Comité Administratif de la Confédération Mondiale légale et

ce ne sont que quelques organisations plutôt faibles de pays avec une minuscule population juive qui supportent la séparation entre la Diaspora et les Sionistes Généraux en Israël.

« Dans les Etats-Unis personne ne prend au sérieux les défaitistes qui se rangent derrière le Dr. GOLDSTEIN et les dames de la Hadassa. On ne prend pas trop au sérieux la Hadassa elle-même. La Z.O.A., par contre, jouit d'une popularité sans précédent. Sa conférence annuelle, la semaine dernière, était une démonstration de force et de puissance presque inimaginable. Plus de deux mille délégués ont fait de cette manifestation un véritable TRIOMPHE pour notre ligne sioniste. »

M. ILUTOVITSCH a discuté ensuite la prétention de la Hadassa et de M. BAKSTANSKI au titre de "Confédération Mondiale des Sionistes Généraux" pour leur regroupement à eux. Comme on a pu le lire dans la "Zionistische Stimme", M. BAKSTANSKI essaye de fonder ses récriminations sur le fait que le nom "Confédération Mondiale" fut adopté pour la première fois avant la guerre mondiale par des hommes qui ont eu les mêmes idées défaitistes et pro-Mapai qui animent M. BAKSTANSKI aujourd'hui. Il avoue sans se gêner que ses confrères étaient (et sont) ceux-là mêmes qui se sont opposés au Dr. SILVER et à la lutte politique contre les Anglais, ceux-là mêmes qui ont trahi la classe moyenne en Israël en la livrant sans soutien quelconque à la guerre des classes du Mapai et aux semi-communistes du Hachomer Hatsoïr. Il avoue naïvement : "Les fondateurs de la Confédération Mon-

diale (d'avant-guerre) étaient en faveur de la collaboration soumise avec l'Angleterre et (dans la politique intérieure) avec le mouvement Haloutz", c'est-à-dire avec le Mapai.

Un bel argument pour revendiquer le nom de la Confédération Mondiale des Sionistes Généraux aujourd'hui, 10 ans après la création de l'Etat juif, pour les serviteurs du Mapai de 1957 !!!

M. ILUTOVITSCH affirme que la Confédération Mondiale sera représentée, pour toujours, par ceux qui restent fidèles aux principes du Sionisme Général, à l'unité d'intérêts et d'idéaux entre les Sionistes du monde entier avec ceux d'Israël. Les six membres du Comité Administratif qui ont quitté la Confédération ont perdu le droit d'user de son nom. Les six autres qui sont restés loyaux sont les seuls représentants parlant en son nom.

M. ILUTOVITSCH est d'avis que, pour la même raison,

LES MEMBRES DE LA CONFEDERATION EUROPEENNE, qui sont loyaux à la Confédération Mondiale légale, SONT LES SEULS AUTORISES A PARLER DES MAINTENANT AU NOM DE LA CONFEDERATION SIONISTE GENERALE DE L'EUROPE ET DE L'AFRIQUE DU NORD. M. ILUTOVITSCH ne voit pas de quel droit M. BAKSTANSKI pourrait continuer à parler au nom d'une Confédération Européenne des Sionistes Généraux dès qu'il a cessé d'être un Sioniste Général et veut devenir un "non-partisan". C'est illogique au point d'en être ridicule.

LE SIONISME GENERAL TRIOMPHE MALGRE LES MENSONGES DE SES ENNEMIS

■ Quant à la Belgique, le rapport de M. BAKSTANSKI prétend qu'il y avait deux représentants belges à cette séance. La vérité est qu'aucun membre — et encore moins un délégué, — de l'Organisation Sioniste Belge n'a mis son pied dans la salle de cette séance.

■ Le même va pour la Suisse et le Danemark.

■ L'Organisation Sioniste de France, la plus grande de l'Europe continentale, a ignoré, naturellement, la séance.

■ Au nom de nos camarades britanniques, M. S. LANEMAN a présenté sa protestation formelle une semaine d'avance.

■ Certains participants de Finlande, d'Autriche et d'Italie n'avaient aucun mandat de voter et ne représentaient qu'eux-mêmes.

■ Résumons : La séance d'urgence de M. BAKSTANSKI se termina par un échec complet. À part son organisation britannique il n'y avait que les Hollandais et probablement la majorité des sionistes généraux de Suède, ainsi que la poignée des progressistes français qui sont restés avec lui dans son coup d'Etat.

La véritable Confédération Européenne a passé, dès maintenant, de Londres à Paris.

L'Organisation Sioniste Générale de la Grande-Bretagne et d'Irlande

Le premier résultat de la défection de la Fédération Sioniste Britannique a été la création d'une Organisation Sioniste Générale de la Grande-Bretagne.

La Jewish Telegraphic Agency annonce, le 17 septembre, ce qui suit :

« Le Dr. Wolfgang von Weisl s'est rendu à Londres pour une dizaine de jours, en mission de la part du Conseil Européen des Sionistes Généraux. Il a eu des entrevues avec des personnalités importants Juifs et non Juifs et a parlé dans deux (en réalité trois) réunions. Pendant son séjour il a réussi à constituer l'organisation Sioniste Générale de la Grande-Bretagne et de l'Irlande, qui sera représentée par quatre délégués, au Conseil Européen des Sionistes Généraux. Les représentants de Londres sont F. Ashe Lincoln, S. Landman et Dr. J. Jackson. Le délégué de la province n'est pas encore nommé. »

Les camarades londoniens ont commencé, immédiatement, l'enregistrement de nouveaux membres et la collecte d'un Fonds Politique. Dans les 48 heures, trois donations de 100 livres sterling chacune (environ 360.000 francs) et d'autres donations moins importantes furent assurées.

Un meeting interne a élu président de l'Organisation Sioniste Générale Britannique l'avocat bien connu Ashe LINCOLN, Conseiller de la Reine, Lieutenant Commandeur de la Réserve de la Marine Royale, etc... Notre fidèle et intrépide camarade Samuel LANDMAN, l'ancien Secrétaire politique de WEIZMANN au temps de la Déclaration Balfour et chairman de notre Comité en Angleterre, fut élu chairman de l'Organisation. Dr. J. JACKSON, Trésorier, Mrs ALLEN, Secrétaire honoraire, une dizaine d'autres personnalités complètent le Comité provisoire.

PROBLEMES DE L'EDUCATION JUIVE EN ISRAEL

Les journaux israéliens, ainsi que les journaux sionistes de la Diaspora annoncent que :

— L'année scolaire en Israël commence avec une rentrée en classe de 500.000 enfants (y compris les Arabes), dont 30.000 de plus qu'en 1956.

— Les difficultés dans l'enseignement public, causées par le manque d'instituteurs, semblent sensiblement soulagées. 1.500 nouveaux instituteurs portent le chiffre à un total de 20.000 pour l'année nouvelle.

— Tandis que le nombre des élèves atteint 4 fois celui de 1949, le budget de l'éducation est 6 fois plus élevé. (Cette disproportion est due à la hausse des prix de construction, pour les nouvelles classes, ainsi qu'à la hausse des salaires, etc.)

Commentaire : Le quotidien Général Sioniste « Haboer » (du 6-9) attaque cette manière de parler en chiffres « comme les Américains » quand il s'agit de problèmes spirituels, tels que ceux de l'éducation. « Ce ne sont pas les chiffres qui importent — ce sont les buts de l'éducation et ses résultats — qu'il faut examiner », dit notre confrère.

« Et les résultats sont assez insatisfaisants », se plaint le « Jewish Herald » de Londres, le 20 août. Il cite deux exemples :

L'un est le cas de plusieurs élèves d'un des meilleurs lycées de Tel-Aviv, des fils de bonnes familles, qui ont commis, dans l'année où ils devaient passer le baccalauréat, des crimes tels que vol d'automobiles, vol avec effraction dans des magasins, etc., et qui ont, en outre, fréquenté des maisons « immorales » — uniquement par ennui, tout comme la jeunesse corrompue en Europe ou en Amérique. Le journal voit dans ce fait une preuve que les méthodes pédagogiques actuelles en Israël ne savent pas former une jeunesse juive idéaliste. Le deuxième exemple souligne encore ce fait : parmi 300 étudiants israéliens qui fréquentent les universités des Etats-Unis, pas moins de 30 se firent baptiser, tandis que les autres étudiants en Amérique, ainsi qu'en Europe, s'éloignent des communautés juives locales, refusent de prendre part à l'œuvre sioniste, préfèrent — avec toute leur éducation « sabré » chauviniste, la compagnie de jeunes filles non juives à celle de leurs coreligionnaires.

A qui la faute ? Le « Jewish Herald » répond : « On a essayé de donner aux jeunes Israéliens une éducation juive sans religion. Or, cela n'existe pas. Cela ne peut donner que les résultats que nous voyons.

Le « Haboer », de son côté, accuse l'éducation socialiste d'être une source

de mal. Il souligne que malgré la loi sur l'unification des systèmes scolaires, l'éducation partisane socialiste continue d'exister dans les écoles des Kibbutzim, ainsi que dans d'autres institutions dominées par les partis

presque communistes Ahdout Avoda et Hashomer Hatsair. Cette éducation à la haine des classes se dissimule sous le nom innocent de « éducation sociale », permise par la loi. Elle consiste à donner aux enfants des livres marxistes, tels que le Manifeste Communiste, les œuvres de Kaussky, Baer, même du communiste Ber Borochov. Le journal alerte l'opinion publique contre cette transgression de la loi.

Nouvelles de nos organisations dans le monde

ETATS-UNIS

La 60^e Conférence annuelle de l'Organisation Sioniste de l'Amérique a eu lieu à New-York du 12 au 15 septembre. « Elle était remarquable par son esprit militant et son appui enthousiaste pour la politique formulée et poursuivie par le Dr. Emmanuel NEUMANN réélu, par acclamation, président. De même furent réélus le Président honoraire Dr. Abba HILLEL SILVER; les Vice-Présidents SOBELOFF, WEINBERG, Dr. FEUER, Dr. LEVINE et Jacques TORCZYNER, ainsi que A. GOODMAN comme Chairman du Comité Exécutif National.

A cette Conférence le Gouverneur HARRIMAN a attaqué l'administration d'Eisenhower pour sa politique dans le Proche Orient; l'ancien ambassadeur de l'U.S. en Israël, James G. MACDONALD, a critiqué amèrement l'attitude des Israéliens envers la Diaspora. Il a dit notamment que les leaders de l'Etat d'Israël ont le devoir d'expliquer à leurs citoyens l'esprit de la Diaspora afin que les Israéliens comprennent le Judaïsme mondial comme ils désirent que la Diaspora comprenne les Israéliens. Le grand écrivain Maurice SAMUEL, ainsi que notre camarade Israël ROKACH, Vice-Président de la Knesseth, attaquèrent fortement l'attitude de BEN GOURION qui veut regarder comme sionistes seulement ceux qui sont prêts à s'établir en Israël. ROKACH ajoute que la grande majorité de la Knesseth n'est pas d'accord avec BEN GOURION.

LA CONFÉRENCE NATIONALE DE L'ORGANISATION SIONISTE DE FRANCE

aura lieu, à Paris, le 9, 10 et 11 novembre.

Ce sera la conférence la plus importante qui fut jamais convoquée depuis la fin de la guerre mondiale. On s'attend à une participation record.

La préparation de la Conférence a été confié à M. Alexandre REITER.

L'ambassadeur français M. ALPHAND salue les « sacrifices et les efforts innombrables des membres de l'Organisation Sioniste face aux obstacles qui semblent insurmontables ». De même, Lord Russell de Liverpool, l'éminent homme d'Etat libéral, dénonce la politique des Nations Unies envers Israël.

AMERIQUE LATINE

Dans les élections communales en Uruguay, les Sionistes Généraux ont présenté une liste séparée en soulignant nos principes politiques et nationaux. Ils ont remporté une victoire éclatante.

En Bolivie, à l'occasion d'une conférence territoriale de la Fédération Sioniste, nos camarades l'ont emporté comme le parti le plus fort de la Communauté.

AUTRICHE

Dr. KLEE (Zurich) visita Vienne, parla dans un meeting arrangé pour la Fédération Sioniste et pris contact avec nos camarades militants.

ISRAEL

Le Vice-Président de la Knesseth, M. ROKACH, est en visite en Amérique. Le membre de l'Exécutif de l'Agence Juive, GROSSMAN, est parti pour l'Europe et visitera Paris au début d'octobre; le membre de la Knesseth Simha BABE visite, avec une délégation parlementaire, l'Amérique du Sud; le membre de la Knesseth Dr. HARELL a participé, comme membre de la Délégation Parlementaire Israélienne, aux séances de la conférence interparlementaire à Londres, où il a tenu un discours très remarquable sur le problème des réfugiés arabes. Il était aussi membre de la Commission interparlementaire à Londres, où il a tenu un discours très remarquable sur le problème des réfugiés arabes. Il a tenu une conférence dans une réception organisée en son honneur par l'Organisation Sioniste Générale de Grande-Bretagne, présidée par le Dr. HOMA. Le Ministre des Pensions et l'Assurance Sociale adressa une lettre de congratulations à cette réunion.

L'Angleterre voit le danger russe

Dans le « Haboker » le Dr. von WEISL donne un rapport sur les vues des cercles conservateurs parlementaires de Londres concernant la situation en Syrie et en Jordanie, dont nous donnons ici un extrait.

A) L'Amérique ne fera rien contre les Russes en Syrie et on ne voit même pas ce qu'elle pourrait faire maintenant.

L'envoi d'armes en Jordanie est un geste futile. Les Jordaniens (comme les autres armées arabes), ne sont pas en mesure de se servir d'armement lourd moderne sans aide et commandement européens (ou russe). D'autre part, l'envoi d'armes par air en Jordanie comporte même un certain danger puisque personne ne sait au juste ce que les Jordaniens feront avec ces armes, le cas échéant.

On n'est pas sûr si le commandant en chef de l'armée supportera aveuglément le Roi Husseïn, disent les Conservateurs en Angleterre. Mais qui osera prédire ce que ce jeune roi fera d'ici quelques mois ? Il a changé sa politique plus d'une fois et il peut la changer à nouveau.

En outre, les déclarations des Jordaniens lors de l'arrivée du premier envoi d'armes américaines sont considérées, à Londres, comme un symptôme inquiétant de la situation morale en Jordanie. Ce serait sans importance si le roi et ses ministres croient sincèrement ce qu'ils disent en déclarant : « Israël est la plus grande menace pour nous et jamais nous n'emploierons ces armes contre la Syrie », ou s'ils se croient obligés de parler ainsi parce que l'opinion publique le demande. Mais encore plus dangereuse serait la situation qui se produirait si le roi était assassiné comme son grand-père Abdallah. Dans ce cas, les armes américaines en Jordanie seraient employées au profit d'un bloc syro-égyptien.

B) Le véritable danger pour le monde libre, naturellement, ne consiste pas dans l'attitude des Jordaniens ou des Syriens, mais dans les intentions de Moscou.

Et ces intentions seraient, d'après les renseignements reçus à Londres, alarmantes au plus haut degré.

Moscou serait convaincu que — dans le cas d'une attaque syrienne, avec ou sans intervention égyptienne — aucune puissance européenne, même pas la France, viendrait en aide à Israël et ceci par crainte de la Russie.

L'attaque syro-égyptienne contre Israël serait, cette fois-ci, dirigée par des généraux russes. Elle viendrait peut-être après avoir provoqué un incident sérieux à la frontière israélienne, dont le but serait de tâter la réaction américaine avant que les Russes ne s'engagent à fond. Mais on craint, à Londres, que les Russes soient déjà convaincus que n'importe quelle action arabe contre les Juifs passera sans intervention de part de Dulles et de Eisenhower, et que l'Angleterre et la France ne risqueront pas d'agir sans l'Amérique.

pour Israël

Moscou pense que cette fois les Arabes, grâce à leur supériorité en armement et en hommes, parviendront à remporter la victoire. Mais si les Israéliens battaient, une fois de plus, les Arabes, Moscou paraît être décidé à ne pas permettre une troisième défaite de leurs alliés. Les Russes enverraient alors des « volontaires » tandis que leurs bases sous-marines dans la Méditerranée, en Albanie, en Egypte et en Syrie empêcheraient l'envoi de volontaires occidentaux vers Israël. Seule une déclaration de guerre contre la Russie pourrait alors aider Israël. Moscou est absolument certain que Eisenhower ne s'y décidera jamais !

C) Londres sent que l'objet immédiat de la politique russe est l'élimination d'Israël.

Londres sait que les communistes tâcheront d'éliminer également la Turquie, mais seulement après qu'ils auront fini avec Israël. Les Russes considèrent que l'existence d'Israël constitue un danger réel pour leurs projets de conquête. Israël peut servir de base militaire pour le monde libre. Une attaque venant de la Syrie et dirigée contre la Turquie ne saurait se concevoir tandis qu'une armée israélienne menace la Syrie du sud. Ce ne sera qu'après l'élimination d'Israël que les Russes s'occuperaient de la Turquie.

D) Le seul moyen pour sortir de l'impassé serait une déclaration tripartite, suivant laquelle la moindre attaque contre

Israël déclencherait automatiquement la guerre des Etats-Unis, l'Angleterre et la France contre l'agresseur.

Les Russes seraient plus enclins à prendre au sérieux une telle déclaration si Israël était admise à la NATO. Les Anglais regrettent de ne voir aucune chance pour l'adoption d'une telle politique par M. Dulles, le groupe de l'Arameo et M. Eisenhower.

Malgré l'opposition permanente du Pentagone contre la politique de Dulles, l'Amérique poursuivra probablement ses efforts pour gagner les Arabes. Mais ce n'est pas seulement l'Amérique qui serait opposée à l'admission d'Israël à la NATO. En Grande-Bretagne aussi, la tradition pro-arabe est encore vivante et il est probable que l'Angleterre hésiterait elle aussi à s'engager définitivement en faveur d'Israël. Le seul espoir qui reste : le rapport de Henderson sur la Syrie a peint le danger russe en des couleurs si noires que Eisenhower fut alarmé sérieusement. Le Pentagone est depuis longtemps en faveur d'une réorientation de la politique américaine dans le sens pro-israélien et pro-anglais. Il y a des signes dans le ciel de Washington qui prédissent un changement dans ce sens. Mais Londres craint que l'obstination du Département d'Etat et le désir d'Eisenhower d'éviter à tout prix une nouvelle Corée n'emportent une fois de plus sur les opinions du Ministère de la Guerre et, en conséquence, ne rendent impuissant le monde libre tout entier.

LE DÉBAT IDÉOLOGIQUE

Dans tous les pays du monde, les deux discours de BEN GOURION à Jérusalem ont provoqué la plus vive réaction. Le parti des Sionistes Généraux, tout en condamnant catégoriquement les idées de BEN GOURION, approuve le principe de la discussion, nécessaire pour l'avenir du Mouvement Sioniste. Notre ami Jacques ORFUS, Président du Conseil des Sionistes Généraux d'Europe écrit dans "La Terre Retrouvée" (15 septembre) :

« La conception de M. BEN GOURION risque d'avoir des conséquences incalculables et même dangereuses pour l'avenir du jeune Etat et pour ses relations avec le Judaïsme Mondial. »

Nous connaissons les raisons qui ont amené M. BEN GOURION à prendre cette attitude, disons-le franchement, hostile au Mouvement Sioniste.

Sur le bien-fondé des reproches de M. BEN GOURION on pourrait ouvrir un débat. Quant aux conclusions, elles sont à rejeter dans l'intérêt même du peuple juif et de l'Etat d'Israël.

Des alliances, nous en cherchons en dehors du peuple juif. Au sein de ce peuple nous cherchons des "bâtisseurs".

C'est le Mouvement Sioniste qui représente le "partnership" du Judaïsme du monde entier, dans sa forme organisationnelle.

C'est à lui qu'incombe le devoir, en dehors des tâches quotidiennes citées plus haut, de transformer les donateurs juifs, les "alliés" d'aujourd'hui en partenaires, en "bâtisseurs".

Essayer de remplacer l'Organisation Sioniste Mondiale par des "Amis d'Israël" ou quelque autre organisation serait une déclaration de faillite de l'idée sioniste, ce serait aussi hâter le processus de séparation entre le Judaïsme israélien et celui de la Diaspora, avec toutes les conséquences désastreuses qui s'ensuivent. »

ADOPTED AT THE 60th ANNIVERSARY ZOA CONVENTION
HELD AT THE WALDORF ASTORIA HOTEL
NEW YORK SEPTEMBER 12-15, 1957


The 60th Anniversary Convention of the Zionist Organization of America reaffirms the resolution of the ZOA-UJA Mobilization Conference held in conjunction with the National Executive Council on April 7, 1957. Like that assembly, it urges the ZOA to further intensify its support for the 1957/1958 United Jewish Appeal and calls upon its leadership and membership in every Region and District in every city throughout the United States to cooperate with the local campaign in which the United Jewish Appeal is included. The Zionist Organization of America will:

- a. Endeavor to see to it that every ZOA member makes a contribution to the campaign which is adequate to the overwhelming needs of the moment.
- b. Organize, in cooperation with the local campaign, meetings, and Divisions which will enable that campaign to reach its goal.
- c. Urge its members to make contributions, individually, which will inspire the same type of sacrifice from all sections of the Jewish Community.
- d. Take on the responsibility at the end of the campaign to see that every Jew in the community is given an opportunity to make an adequate contribution.
- e. Take the necessary steps to enlist its entire membership as volunteer leaders and workers in the campaign.
- f. Help to speed the campaign, in order that the funds may be applied quickly for the life-saving purposes for which it is intended.
- g. Proclaim, publicly, in every community, its support of the local campaign with its resolve to help attain maximum results.

II

1. The ZOA Convention records its great satisfaction with the encouraging response given by many ZOA Districts throughout the country to the UJA program through ZOA.
2. The ZOA Convention calls upon the ZOA Districts where 1957 Fall UJA Campaigns are scheduled, to make immediate contact with the local Federations or UJA Committees in order to plan a UJA effort through ZOA.
3. The ZOA Convention calls for the establishment within the ZOA of a permanent committee to work with the UJA during 1957-1958 in order to further its ZOA-UJA program.
4. The ZOA Convention urges the Executive Boards of the ZOA Regions to cooperate with the UJA Regional Conferences during the coming year and wherever possible hold ZOA Conferences in order to achieve full implementation of the ZOA-UJA program.

5. The ZOA Convention records its gratitude to Mr. Max Bressler, National ZOA Chairman for Israel Funds, for his effective leadership in the promotion of Israel Bonds, United Jewish Appeal and Jewish National Fund. These achievements were made possible by his great devotion to the Jewish people and his deep concern for the welfare of the State of Israel.
6. The ZOA Convention records its satisfaction with the cooperation extended to the ZOA by the United Jewish Appeal Leadership during the year, especially the guidance and help it has received from the Executive Vice-Chairman of the UJA, Rabbi Herbert A. Friedman, and for delegating Mr. Harry Shapiro as liaison representative with ZOA. His understanding of the Zionist Organization and of the communities, combined with his devotion and counsel have, in a great measure, helped to further the ZOA-UJA program.
7. The Chairman, Max Bressler, wishes to record his full appreciation of the exemplary services given to the ZOA-UJA effort by our Director, Abram Salomon, and recommends him highly for the plaudits of the entire Convention.



III

The ZOA Convention welcomes the United Jewish Appeal's decision to hold a UJA Conference in 1958 in Jerusalem. Such a gathering will afford participation of a greater number of Jews of America in the celebration of the 10th Anniversary of Jewish statehood and will serve as a greater stimulus for the implementation of the UJA program of rescue.

- (A) It urges the ZOA Administration to arrange a delegation of ZOA leaders active in the UJA-program from all Regions and Districts to take part in the June UJA Conference in Jerusalem.
- (B) The ZOA Convention calls upon the Administration to so organize the mission of ZOA leaders to Israel that it will include visits to various countries of Europe, after which the mission will bring a report of conditions prevailing there and in Israel to a special meeting of the ZOA National Executive Council so that we may stimulate even greater activity on behalf of the UJA.

First, it is a distinct pleasure for me, as president of the Philadelphia Zionist Organization, to invite you to attend as a guest of honor the forthcoming 15th Annual Dinner of the Philadelphia Zionist Organization.

The function, to be held on Tuesday evening, January 21st, at the Drake Hotel in this city, will salute Congressman Earl Chudoff as he retires from Capitol Hill, where he was a stalwart champion of Israel and the Zionist cause, to become a judge of the Common Pleas Court of Pennsylvania. The evening will also mark the celebration of the 60th anniversary of the Zionist Organization of America and the 10th anniversary of Israel's freedom.

As you know, we made diligent and persistent efforts to have you grace the occasion as the principal speaker. While we aren't quite reconciled to the loss of your eloquence at our function, as good tacticians we are compelled to accept the possibility that you cannot be with us, and act accordingly.

Hence, should you be unable to attend, can we prevail upon you for a message which may be read at the dinner? This message is of great, almost critical, importance to us. In Philadelphia, our Zionist organization has suffered the brunt of whatever effective opposition the American Jewish League for Israel could muster, if for no other reason than because many of its leaders live here.

For the most part, these opposition tactics have not been crude, although there has been a share of that, too. Where the League has hurt us, and tellingly, too, is in the subtle influence which Judge Levinthal wields among the moneyed folk here, as well as among those who, in varying degrees and for varying reasons are beholden to the Judge and his followers. Truth and justice, of course, are on our side in meeting the League campaign, but the seeds of confusion sown in the community by the Judge's group have taken root.

This confusion has enabled those who have always been apathetic to our movement to withdraw completely with face-saving excuses, while those with meagre knowledge of the facts have been swayed away by the outrageous accusations being made against the Zionist Organization of America.

In asking for a message from you to be read publicly, we ask for no negative attack on the League. Rather, we want affirmative words, phrased as only Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver can phrase them, which point to the great need today for unity among Zionists, rising above personalities, and which underscore the great need for the Zionist Organization of America today to be able to carry out its historic tasks without being hampered and wounded by the pettifogging diatribes of a group of bitter men.

Your words will be heard by a distinguished audience that night. In addition to leaders of our Zionist and Jewish community, the audience will include such highly placed persons in the political and administrative structure of our state and city as our Governor and our Mayor, as well as lawyers and others who are friends of Congressman Chudoff. Your words will be a rich complement to those spoken by Dr. Emanuel Neumann, our principal speaker.

I do hope that you can find the time to compose the message we ask. It will help us immeasurably.

I would greatly appreciate it if you could spare a few minutes of your time and drop me a line about your personal impressions of the Convocation in general and the ZOA House and Kfar Silver in particular.

Although I already read most of the press reports in the Israeli and local newspapers, and I also received the first communications from our people in Tel Aviv, I still would like to know your own opinion.

Not speaking of the funds invested by the ZOA in both projects, a great deal of my own time and energies went into the reorganization of Kfar Silver last summer and into the planning and preparation of the Convocation.

You may be interested to know that a 10 minute film of the Convocation highlights taken on April 29th in the evening in the ZOA House Garden already arrived and is being developed. I hope to see the first print tomorrow morning.

I also received a complete tape recording of your and Ambassador Lawson's addresses, both of which I enjoyed very much.







I received your letter of July 8 regarding the contribution of the Cleveland Zionist Society in memory of Dr. Falkman.

The Medical Clinic in Kfar Silver does not exist as yet. It is not included in the development plan for 1958-59 since other buildings were considered more essential. For the time being, they are using in Kfar Silver for this purpose one little room in an old reconditioned small house which will be demolished eventually after the Clinic is built.

We would be prepared to put up a Medical Clinic right away provided we find a contributor. The present cost of a building (excluding furniture and equipment) is \$26,667.

Under the circumstances, it is impossible to put up a plaque in memory of Dr. Falkman.

Miss Hannah Stein, Director of our AZF Department with whom I discussed the matter this morning, tells me that she met with Mrs. Falkman in New York the other day and got the impression that Mrs. Falkman would be prepared to make a contribution of her own in memory of her husband.

Should Mrs. Falkman agree to contribute \$1,000 it could be earmarked together with the \$4,000 of the Cleveland Zionist Society for a room in one of the Dormitories in the name of Dr. Falkman.

The Dormitory I have in mind consists of ten rooms of which six have already been dedicated in the names of various contributors. They are all listed on separate plaques which appear on a bronze Honor Roll in the Dormitory's Clubroom.

If the above solution is acceptable, a plaque in memory of Dr. Falkman will be put up on this Honor Roll which is both dignified and nice.




