My dear Miss Cohen:

Enclosed you will find the Press Release and the Memorandum of which I spoke to you this morning. I hope that you will be able to put this into the works before the weekend.

The Memorandum is to be sent to the following people, with accompanying letters on the stationery of the American Jewish Trade Union Committee, and signed by Max Zaritsky as Chairman:

President Truman, Secretary of State Byrnes, Members of both Houses of Congress, Heads of the British Labor Party, the Jewish Agency for Palestine and Histadruth.

The Memorandum is also to be sent to William Green and Philip Murray with an accompanying note.

The Release and text is to be sent to the following:

1. All members of the American Jewish Trade Union Committee. (you have the cards)
2. Entire Labor Press.
3. General and Anglo-Jewish Press.
4. Yiddish Press.
