February 27, 1947 Mr. John Foster Dulles 40 Wall Street New York, N.Y. My dear Mr. Dulles: Governor Dewey telephoned me this morning and told me of the conversation which hehhad with you. I need not tell you that I was delighted to learn of your continued and sympathetic interest in our cause and of your readiness to discuss the situation with the interested parties when you are on your forthcoming mission. It would give me great pleasure indeed if I could have a few moments of your time to bring one or vital considerations to your attention. I shall be in New York this coming Monday.
