Dear Rabbi Silver:


You are undoubtedly aware of the existence of this Committee which has been organized as a united front in support of the active fighters in Palestine, specifically the Irgun Zvai Leumi and the Fighters for the Freedom of Israel.

This Committee is completely and decisively apolitical, nonsectarian, and non-partisan, and is raising funds for the underground in Palestine on this basis. The monies raised here are being sent directly to Ralestine for use by the underground in the procurement of medical supplies, medical equipment, mobile underground hospitals, and for the relief of the families of easualties in the struggle in Palestine.

The writer is aware that on at least two occasions members of the underground spoke to you. These conversations were not reported to me, either in detail or in digest. It was recommended, however, that the writer communicate with you with an eye to a meeting to discuss the question of support in America to the Resistance in Palestine.

The writer would like to make it very clear to you that he is not a member of any Zionist organization and owes fealty to no sectarian politics within Zionism. His entire motivation is a deep rooted desire to join in this noble fight with his fellow Jews for the freedom of the land of Israel.

Dear Rabbi Silver:

We take the liberty of writing to you about a matter, which is of a very urgent nature and requires immediate attention.

We refer to the plight of the political prisoners and detainees and their families in Palestine. This matter had been brought to the attention of the Emergency Council which referred it to a sub-committee. We met with the sub-committee, but no conclusion had been reached.

As the subject is of primary importance to hundreds of families who are in dire need of help, and as we find ourselves in a very uncomfortable position due to the inconclusive attitude of certain Zionist bodies, we would very much appreciate if you could arrange an appointment to meet with us at your convenience, one of the very next days.

One of our representatives shall be Mr. Max Seligman, the well-known Palestinian attorney who, as the foremost defender of the political prisoners, has the best first-hand knowledge of the subject.

We would very much prefer New York as the meeting place and June 30th as a tentative date would be very convenient for us.

Should however, this date prove inconvenient for you, we shall very much appreciate if you could arrange an appointment for any other date. If you do not expect to be in New York City in the next days, we are ready to meet you at any other place of your choice.
