THE RABBI'S STUDY

Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, The Temple, East 105th St. and Ansel Rd., Cleveland, Ohio.

Dear Rabbi Silver:

In a letter you wrote me some time ago you referred to the attack delivered by Dr. Rabinowitch of Montreal on Zionism and Canadian Jewry. Herewith you will find enclosed a pamphlet copy of an address I delivered in answer to his diatribe. Perhaps you will be interested in reading it.

In your last Bulletin, I read that you delivered an address on Pastor Niemoeller, and rejected an invitation to attend a lecture which he was scheduled to deliver. I am in full accord with the stand you took in this matter and had planned to do that very thing when he visits Toronto. I understand that he will be here.

Although I have gathered some data about him from newspaper and magazine articles, I am wondering whether you would have secretary send me the facts on which you based your address exposing his Nazi sympathies and activities. Perhaps she could mail me a copy of the lecture itself; it undoubtedly contains the factual material that I am anxious to have at my disposal. I expect to speak publicly on Niemoeller, if his projected trip to Toronto materializes. Your assistance will be deeply appreciated.
