Truman on 'Right Track' On Palestine, Bloom Says

MONDAY, APRIL 5, 1948.

Representative Bloom, Democrat, of New York said at the White. House today that President Truman "is on the right track" toward settlement of the Palestine dispute.

Emerging from a talk with Mr. Trunca on the Palestine question, Mr. Bloom said he is optimistic that a truce agreement between the Jews and Arabs might be reached by the

time the United Nations General Assembly meets April 16.
