GENESIS AND SCIENCE

If David Morgenthau the author of *Genesis and Science* had stuck to his text for the whole book he might have made one more worth-while addition to even that overloaded subject. From the angle of a Hebrew knowing Scripture he establishes an Hebraic entente between Genesis and the scientists in the story of creation.

Some things about this are lucidly informing "the waters under the firmament and those above the firmament" have usually been a stickler to Sunday schoolers. The author makes it clear that the aqueous atmospheres of our earth and of one of the planets really coincided at one period, and as each planet cooled its waters condensed along with its aerial envelope unto itself.

Much of the book is utterly Hebraic, concerning the Jewish nation, language, and modern progress. Morgenthau sees in citified Hebraism a menace to the old Judaism without which he argues there is no real Christianity. He observes the decadence of the phonetic Hebraic tongue absorbed by the unphonetic English — and by other languages among which Hebrews live. He cites Quebec as a parallel. But Quebec has no fear of the extinction of French language. He might have made a better parallel with Ireland.

He regards Jesus as a product of the Essenes who were miracle-working mystics. He argues that Jesus had very little culture, but a great mystic personality.

The book is easy to read, highly informing and its biases are not bigotries. No doubt a great many Jews reading it will be startled as much as some Gentiles.





I counted from the last day of Pesach, May 1st to the first day of Shabuoth, June 14th and answered 6 weeks. The answer was announced as 7 weeks.


The question was not stated "How many weeks from the beginning of Passover, etc." Naturally I counted from the end of Passover.
