אנשי המדע ומן ההסתדרות, יהיו נכונים להצטרף ולקבל הצעתך, בהיות רבים
יודעים כי זה יותר מחמשים שנה אני עובד במדע ובספרות. הואל בא לכתוב

חברים נכבדים,

אני מרשה לי לפנות אליכם, לבקש על ידכם סיוע ממוסד ליטוויאר בסביל הוצאת כרך שני, ואם אפשר גם שלישי מספרי "מחקרים במסגרת ותלמוד ובטפרות הרבנית". אני שולח לכם על ידי הרב אבא הלל סילוור את כרך א' שהופיע כבר תרצ"ח, וזה לא כביר באה עליו בקרת J. V. R. (אוקטובר 1939 עמ' 198). עוד אני חייב לדביר חלק מהוצאות הדפוס, והכרכים הבאים אפשר לתדפיס דק כשיהיה סיוע מחובני המדע.

הכרך השני צריך להכיל מלבד עוד ענייני מקרא, גם את המחקרים הרבים שלי בתלמוד, אשר גילו נתיבות חדשות, ואלה אשר נדפסו הם פזורים במאמצי שונים שאינם מצויים ביד הלומדים, וצריכים להקבץ יחד כדי שתתברר שיטתם. בין אלה: מחקרים ליטודי ההלכה, הצופה לחכמת ישראל, כודפסט תרפ"ו, עם השלמות;

יהודה ויוון בדרכי המליצה והמוסר, כנסת לזכר ביאליק, ספר ה' עקביה בן מהללאל (ביאורים חדשים לגמרי על המסניות אודותיו), ספר זכרון, תל אביב תרפ"ד; הלל הזקן ומפעלו, במאסף האנגלי דז. קו. ר. אוקטובר 1939 הרעיונות הסודיים של ריש בן יוחאי, הגברו יוניון קולדז אנואל, כרך י המחקר על שאילתות דרב אחאי, ספר היובל של שווארץ 1917 מאמרים שונים על הרמב"ם, מפוקרים, ועוד מחקרים היסטוריים.

כרך ב' יכיל ערך 15 גליונות, אשר הדפסתם תעלה לערך 300 דולאר. אם אפשר לכם לסייע בסכום זה מן המוסד הנ"ל, אוכל למסור את הספר תיכף לדפוס, ולא אדבר לפי שעה על כרך ג' כדי שלא לתפוס מרובה. אבל אם גם הסכום הנ"ל הוא רב מכחו של המוסד, אזי יצטרף סכום פחות ממנו בתור התחלה טובה להשלמה שאבקש אז ממקום אחר. בכל אופן אכיר לכם טובה על הסיוע אשר תתנו לי מהמוסד.

בתקותי לשמוע בקרוב את החלטתכם, אני מרשה לי גם לבקשכם שתעוררו שימת לב הרבנים וכל חובבי המקרא על הכרך הראשון, אשר בו מחקרי ליטודי, לתהלים, לדניאל, ועוד דברים חשובים, ועל ידי קניין אכסטמלרים מאת "דביר" אני משלם לאט לאט את חובי בעד ההדפסה, באין לי כעת הכנסות קבועות אחרי הריסות מצבי בווינא ע"י הצוררים.



What It Is

A state Commission created by the Legislature on June 4, 1938. It is composed of fifteen members appointed by the Governor. These Commissioners serve for a term of three years without compensation. They are selected to represent all racial social and religious groups within the State.

Its Purpose

To promote Goodwill and to aid in bringing about a better understanding among all racial and religious groups.

In pursuance of this policy the month of May, since 1938, has been designated as Goodwill month and Governor Moore has again by official proclamation requested the citizens of New Jersey to observe May 13 as Goodwill Day.

The Commission plans observance of Goodwill Day throughout the State. It suggests ways and means whereby Goodwill may be the everyday attitude of everyone throughout the year.

How It Operates

Most problems between either groups or individuals are solvable if such problems are considered in the spirit of Goodwill. There are always some points of agree-

ment between people possessing even the most bitterly opposed viewpoints. The Goodwill attitude approaches every problem seeking these points of agreement.

This attitude is well expressed in the following Goodwill-in-Action quotation: "Let us meet on points of agreement, rather than clash on points of disagreement."

Through Whom It Operates

The Goodwill Commission has organized Goodwill Committees in every county, whose Chairman and Vice Chairman are appointed by the Governor.

These County Committees are composed of the various racial and religious groups in the County.

The Committees are conducting public forums. They also suggest means of expression of Goodwill to the schools, churches, fraternal groups, service clubs, women's clubs and all similar groups and organizations in the County.

What It Achieves

A recognition and appreciation of the needs and rights of others so that our varied convictions, traditions and interests can combine to contribute to the welfare of our State and its citizens.
