

Dear Rabbi:

This is the story behind the job I want and that I spoke to you about the other evening. Under the U.S. Public Health Service there are 7 ~~groups~~^{councils} through which U.S. Public Health funds are channeled to schools, hospitals and other research groups for the conduct of all kinds of research investigations.

There is the National Heart Council, the Cancer Research Council, the council on Opthamalogy etc. Each of these councils is made up of 12 appointees from around the country and they meet 4 times each year ~~to~~ allot the available funds to review the work being done.

✓ Dr. Irvine Page had the appointment from this district for the 4 years previous to November 1953. The American Heart Association did everything it could to have me named to succeed Dr. Page. Formerly Maj. General Leonard Schuele had the appointing power and had me all set for it, but then the administration changed and Mrs Hobby advised Sen Taft of this opening from this district and he in turn turned the matter over to Paul Walter who is Taft's manger here. He in turn, and in return for much support, appointed Dan Sherby to this even tho Dan had had no contact with the heart work.

Now that the place has been vacated I would like to have it and so would the American Heart Association and they are working from their end. However we need pressure from Cleveland.

Time is of the essence because I understand that two other men are already being considered-- neither of whom have ever done a darned thing in "heart". It is is a volunteer job but because I am so ~~immersed~~ immersed in every phase of heart work, I sure would like to have this job.

Will you phone (rather than write) whomever you are going to contact? I understand from Dr. Beck who phoned Geo Bender this morning that a nomination has gone in a couple of days ago, so it is not too late.

Thanks a lot.

Most honored Rabbi Hillel Selzer.

I must first ask if you are one of the
Advisory Committee in Mrs. Gerda Scheerer's
fine organization "Friendship among Children and
Youth" before requesting, as a great favor, that you
will pen a word as to its genuine and charitable
merits. I think I saw your name on the list.

I became acquainted with Tracy through
my dear friend, Miss Elvira Farnham Grogan,
a member of the committee. She sent me
from Elberton, Georgia, a newspaper clipping
of her article "Friendship Angel means Gifts for
Children" (or similar to it). It was the first time
I had heard of this remarkable organization,
being able within nine years to send gifts from
American children with name and address, to European
children in the war-afflicted areas and receive from
them in return a letter of friendship.
I feel conscience-stricken to think I am being in

this fully seven years and had never heard
of this great and good work.

The first thing I did was to visit the Principal
of the Kenwood Grammar School in my immedi-
ate vicinity, having the lovely Angel with me.
She had also not heard of it but became
interested and I sent this good news, through
Miss Grogan to Mrs. Schaefer. The Principal
has announced to me since she will form a
group in her school for the coming Christmas.

With joy in my heart I next wrote to the
American Friends Service Committee, Columbus, Ohio,
and Mr. Charles MacLennan, the Exec. Secretary,
wrote back that he had never heard of Tracy
and he asked for the address of the organization
and I promptly sent it to him.

Having lived fully 19 years in Germany as the
wife of a German medical man during the
Royal regime, and then returning after a course of

years to Germany under the Social Democrats
and seeing the rise of the Tyrant to political
power, and then leaving for Rome and witnessing
the excursions to their completion that brought
the spirit of Territorial expansion finally to
the mind of the Italian prime minister,
I have seen a great deal of different
people and my affection and my sympathy
have always gone out to the oppressed people.

Munich is well known to me. I know what
your wonderful people did toward her beautification,
her arts, her industry and how they gave to the
poor, and how one family after another gave up
their apartments to such a peaceful abode in some
other part of Germany for their conditions became
unbearable where jealous enemies were even
receiving their business and domestic peace. -
and then, in Rome, at the time the friendship
was formed between Mussolini and Hitler.

I feared a fresh sorrow might come to your people in the shells and affect the spirit of these wonderful lands I had often noticed during my sojourns in that ancient and interesting part of Rome.

I seem to know the miseries and yearnings of the peoples of many countries and I think of the children how they suffer - and that is why I became instantly interested in doing my part by making the Treasury known in Springfield and in Columbus so that heaps more of useful gifts can be sent around the world.

May I trouble you by making my letters more lengthy but such a kind deed was executed by Elvira Grozon

lately. I had spent one year in the home of
Margherita Savara, on Via Roma 16, at Naples,
whose daughter, Vittoria, an active member of
the Italian Holman Methodist Church there,
wrote me again of the impoverished state
of the church (no longer affiliated with the Amer.
Meth. Church). It had been bombed the same
time that the New Postoffice was during the
last world-war and there were no funds to
repair the damages, and there were never gifts
to go round at Christmas for the 200 Sunday
school children and at last New Year the Poor-
Boy was void of money. This is no unusual
story to me - I know of hundreds of such
heart-breaking instances. Well, Miss Grogan
communicated to Mrs. James Y. Swift, one of
the very active members in the Bethlehem
Methodist Church, at Elberton, Georgia. And Mrs. J.

formed a group of young people of her
Church and there are 14 packages of gifts en
route to the children of the Methodist Church in
Naples. That was through the fairy working
personally and effectively.

I am even taking the liberty of sending
you my story so far as I know it in
order to make the organization known in
the Capital City but Mr. Weaver, the
Editor of Columbus Estrogen would like
a testimony of the organization as to its
merit. I thought at once of you,
very esteemed Rabbi because I am
certain I have heard a broadcast
from the Ohio State University or from

elsewhere. And if you were a member
of the Advisory Committee of Jaccy
would you favor me with a few
good words that will satisfy Mr. Weaver.

If possible, the story concerning the
needs of unfortunate children -
children displaced from their fond homes, etc.
ought to be given so as to arouse
sympathy, help and love towards
them and make them feel they have
friends - That is what I strive
to do - And I fear that a Newspaper

may not give sufficient space for the whole story.

A few words from you if you can bespeak the merits of the cause will be of great help and stimulate me to keep going to make the good and the truth widely known.

I had the use of a typewriter to write my little story - but only for a day.

So kindly excuse the poor penmanship.






