Dear Rabbi Silver and Danny:

I arrived home yesterday after a pleasant trip. I appreciated very much the opportunity of coming to Cleveland and meeting with you. I want to thank you for your most gracious hospitality which you extended to me during my brief stay.

The following is the additional information regarding my experience. I have conducted two Confirmation classes, and have also been administrator of the Religious schools for the past five years, both in my Jackson, Tennessee Bi-Weekly and here on the base. My Rabbinate has afforded me experience in adult education, where I have taught such courses as, "Introduction to the Bible," "What the Jews Believe," "A Survey Course of Jewish History" along with various Elementary and Intermediate Adult Hebrew Courses.
