THE BUILDERS OF TOMORROW

The portion of the scripture which we read this morning tells the story of the desecration of the Temple and of its re-dedication at the hands of King Hezekiah. The Temple of Jerusalem ~~was~~ had been desecrated. The burning coals upon the altars had been extinguished, the sounds of the sweet voices of the Levites no longer echoed through the great halls of the sanctuary. It was desolate, forgotten, and King Hezekiah, inspired by a great desire to re-establish a covenant with God, summons the priests and Levites before him in the great Eastern Court of the Temple, and addresses them. He recounts the misdeeds of their forefathers, the evils they had committed, the sins they were guilty of, and the consequences~~x~~ of these sins and evils. The sword had passed over the land, their sons and their daughters and their wives are in captivity. "Now is the time to re-establish a covenant with God," says King Hezekiah. "Now is the time to cleanse the Temple of its pollution, now is the time to rekindle the fires upon the altars of God, to sound anew the songs of praise to God, the most high", and, turning, King Hezekiah says to them, "My children, be not now negligent, for you hath the Lord chosen to stand before Him, to serve Him, and to be unto Him, servants and offerers of sacrifice."

If the spirit of America were to address itself to you, young men and young women, I cannot think of more pertinent and appropriate words that this great ruling spirit of our people, could find to express its wish, its prayer, its faith, than these words of King Hezekiah.

Three years ago the temple of humanity was desecrated, hands of greed and lust have polluted the sanctuary; upon the altars dedicated to human idealism, the swine of avarice were offered to the gods of corruption, the holy of holies was profaned, ideals of brutality and covetousness were set up, where once dwelled the spirit of human brotherhood. The voices of the sweet singers of humanity's hopes and aspirations, have been drowned in the dim of crashing arms, in the shouts and the groans and the curses of men. The temple of humanity

has run red with blood, and now, my children, would the spirit of America say unto you, "Be not now negligent. This is the time to re-dedicate the temple of humanity and this is the hour when you must wash it clean of its filthiness and its pollution. My children, be not now negligent, for you hath the Lord chosen to stand before Him, to serve Him and offer sacrifices unto Him."

I believe that this age presents a greater opportunity to young men, than any previous age, I believe that the greatest opportunity of history is being presented to the young men and young women of today. I say "young men" and by "young" I mean more than a mere time designation - for youth is not measured in terms of days and years but in the fullness of hope. I know young men of twenty and thirty, who breathe the spirit of senile decrepitude, and I know old men, so called, whose hearts are filled with ambition, with ventures, with new thoughts, new ideals, men that fairly breathe the spirit of virile youth. I say "young" men, young in daring, young in outlook, young in their uncompromising devotion to ideals in life, and I say young men (x x x x)

By men I include more than its generic connotation - I mean, men, fashioned out of the living fires of God's own soul. I mean men who are conscious of their exalted dignity as co-workers of God, as the apostles of deity. I don't mean the clay man and I don't mean the earth man, but I mean the soul man, I mean the God man.

I say that the greatest opportunity of the world is being presented to young men today, and why: Life is in constant flux and change. Everything is undergoing a complete transformation, a metamorphosis, nothing is stable, art, science, religion, etc., everything is being re-evaluated, the world is on tiptoe of expectancy. We live more in a year than past ages have lived in a lifetime. Everything has been tremendously intensified. There has been a speeding up process all along the ~~WXX~~ line and this war has more than accelerated the speed.

Why men and women, history today moves in avalanches. (x x x x x)

The old Greek saying, "Everything flows, everything flows and moves,"

why the soul~~s~~ of men today is like liquid, molten steel, ready to be molded and fashioned and beaten into new forms, the world is being transformed, and not only that, but the minds of men are so inordinately alert, there is this sublime curiosity and inquisitiveness everywhere.

The war with its sudden crushing blows, the war with its poignancy, has startled men out of their lethargy, out of their luxurious neutrality. Men today are questioning their friends and enemies, men today are actually becoming partisans (x x x) to the great vital issues of life.

Now this condition is full of promise and full of danger, because society is in such a formative, plastic stage, because men today are so susceptible to influence. Every beneficent act has tremendous telling powers and every evil act likewise, has tremendous telling powers. We can make or mar the world today. Every generation is the builder of tomorrow, but more so today, because the war has batted down the crust of conservatism, because the war has destroyed the inertia of human souls, because today, men are more susceptible to influences, more plastic, more sensitive than ever before. Because of that, the greatest opportunity is before you, men and women - young men and young women - life has laid at your doors a bleeding humanity, life has brought you wonderful opportunities. Humanity is anxious to be led, to be taught, to be healed. You are no longer faced by a great wall of conservatism, people are calling today for leaders to lead them out of the great gloom and darkness of the world. Men are ready and willing ~~XXX~~ and anxious to listen to you. You have this opportunity now. Are you ready to meet your opportunity? Have you prepared yourself or are you preparing yourselves for it? Are you preparing yourselves, young men and young women, to become an influence in the world, for every one of us is an influence in the world. It is not given to each of us to be a hero, and fill the hemisphere with deeds that mock at fear, but we all can fill a lifetime with kinsly acts. There is always a noble service for noble souls to do. You might work ~~XXX~~ in a little sphere but your influence

will radiate and extend to the furthermost parts of the world. It is like casting a pebble in the bosom of the lake (x x x x) but the circlets of influence reach out into the great beyond.

You are to serve in this land. Are you preparing yourself for it, have you studied your duties, your obligations as citizens?

It was Socrates that said that "Even a cobbler must study his trade." but in the business of government, the most important of all, it is somehow taken for granted that no training is essential, but the moment a man reaches the age of 21, he is thoroughly fit to perform his sacred duty of citizenship. Are you training yourself for your work of tomorrow, for remember, dear friends, that the work will tell, is the work that will be done in this country. What profit will we have, when we extend the blessings of democracy to the furthermost ends of the world, if we lose our own soul (x x x x) while we remain with all our weaknesses.

Within a day or two, we shall be celebrating the centenary of the greatest Jewish historian, Heinrich Graetz, the great historian, who revealed to the eyes of an astonished world the glories of a great people. Whenever I read the volumes of Graetz, I seem to hear a certain sad, sweet music, and when I listen to this sweet, sad music, the ages of memory burst in upon me. I seem to hear their voices, the voices of my people, from foreign lands and distant shores, calling unto me, their voices always sweet and always sad, and the theme that runs through it all, the theme that seems to be heart spun and brain spun, the theme is always one, service, service, service to all.

I read where a recent speaker in this city, an ex-ambassador to Germany, made the statement, "You speak", he said, "of the great German Kultur, take the Jews out of German Kultur, out of its art and science and music and poetry, and you have nothing left." Of course that is a gross exaggeration, of course that is not the product of calm reason, but heated

prejudice, but somehow, in reading it, I felt a keen satisfaction.

It is the irony of life. Why that is exactly what the German anti-Semite used to say of the Jew. Everything that a talented Jewish individual in Germany created in art, or science or music (x x x x) The Jew was only imitative, he could not be creative. As (xxx) would say, "The noble Teuton, why he was the creator, the Jew was merely the second hand reaction (x x x) of things, and so it was (x x x x) a certain keen satisfaction, that I had, when I saw this boomerang come-back to the German group that has constantly decried every genius or evidence of genius among the Jews, but it is true that the Jew has always given his share to the world, in dreamers, in fighters, in scientists, in creators, and the Jew has, moreover, always stood for the most sublime in life (x x x x) service to the world. 


