Writing a quarter of a century ago, George Frederick Abbot declared: "Lange in Europ"

"Nationalism more than any other cause has helped to bring discredit upon the principles of liberty, equality and fraternity."

Renan, political critic and friend of the Jews, remarked long ago:

"Every Jew is essentially a Liberal, while the enemies of Judaism, examined closely, will be found to be generally the enemies of the modern spirit."

But thou, Israel, My servant, Jacob whom I have chosen, The seed of Abraham My friend; Thou whom I have taken hold of from the ends of the earth, And called thee from the uttermost parts thereof. And said unto thee: 'Thou art My servant, I have chosen thee and not cast thee away !: Fear thou not, for I am with thee. Be not dismayed, for I am thy God: I strengthen thee, yea, I help thee; Yea, I uphold thee with My victorious right hand. Behold, all they that were incensed against thee Shall be ashamed and confounded; They that strove with thee Shall be as nothing, and shall perish. Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, Even them that contended with thee; They that warred against thee Shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought. For I the Lord thy God Hold thy right hand, Who say unto thee: 'Fear not, I help thee.'
