New Year's Sermon, 1944.

No hit is good combat until R1144

My text on this New Year is taken from the fortieth Psalm. "I waited patiently for the Lord; and He inclined unto me, and heard my cry. He brought me up out of the tumultuous pit, out of the miry clay and He hath put a new song in my mouth."

"I waited patiently for the Lord." How patiently we have waited these long, bitter years! These years of disaster and war. It seemed as tho they would never end. Year after year the power and might, the violence and cruelty of the enemy increased and multiplied. Like an irresistible avalanche gathering momentum as it hurtled onward, ~~it~~ engulfed every thing before it as ~~the barbarian hordes~~ <sup>swept on over peoples</sup> and countries, leaving horror and death in its wake. ~~He~~ <sup>The bitter Je</sup> jubilated in his merciless triumphs as he taunted his victims. He trumpeted aloud his insolent boasts: "I am, and there is none else beside me."

Many people and nations had come utterly to despair. For it seemed as if no one -- not even God -- could put a stop to this fearful scourge of ~~men~~ or rescue them from the pit into which they had been hurled. Many weak men, ~~year~~, whole nations collapsed <sup>spiritually</sup> before ~~salvation~~ and collaborated with the enemy. Many others <sup>were convinced</sup> ~~believed~~ that all resistance ~~to him~~ should be abandoned, and that the world should come to terms with ~~this~~ unspeakable abomination.

But there were some who waited patiently for the Lord! They did not despair!

~~the~~ <sup>Beaten</sup>, they did not surrender! Terror-blitzed and bombed in their cities, or driven to the sea in shattered retreat, ~~and~~ <sup>or seeing</sup> their navies treacherously attacked and well-nigh destroyed, ~~they~~ <sup>nevertheless</sup> doggedly persisted and carried on in unbroken faith and incomparable courage. They waited patiently through the long, bitter, bloody years of danger and defeat. And in the end that faith and courage were rewarded! They were brought up out of the tumultuous pit, out of the miry clay into which they had sunk. Their feet were again set upon a rock. And today there is a new song in their mouths.

Certainly we Jews have waited patiently, prayerfully through the recent years of persecution, ~~organized~~ hate, <sup>honor</sup> and the menace of extermination for a turn in the tide of

misfortune which swept over our people. Surely no people was ever hurled into such a dark, horrible pit as were the millions of Jews of Europe -- millions, alas no longer -- for in the millions they were slain in vast human ~~abattoire~~ and crematoriums. What mouth can relate, what pen can ever indite the black chronicle of those terrible years! Where once there ~~existed~~ large and ~~thriving~~ Jewish communities, there remains nothing ~~today~~ but heaps upon heaps of charred human bones, and ~~large~~ mass burial grounds. For a dozen years the cold-blooded assassin, who mastered a nation of supine and willing slaves in his deeds of infamy, an hysterical ~~people~~ sick with ~~visions of race~~ ~~egoism and~~ ~~hatred~~ ~~and world-domination~~, went about the methodical extermination of our people, ~~all according~~ ~~had~~ Many among us Jews completely despaired, as they watched in helpless dismay the sickle of death upon one Jewish community after another, piling up ~~on a~~ a ghastly harvest of ~~two~~ millions slain, ~~in Poland alone~~. Surely the end had come for Israel!



But there were others, thank God, who did not despair, who walked by faith and not by sight, who felt themselves challenged, rather than crushed by their people's fearful suffering and who exerted themselves mightily in ~~deeds~~ of succor and rescue, confident that the hour of redemption and vindication ~~would~~ strike sooner or later. For this is an eternal theme in the prophecies of our destiny. If we are to ~~survive we must forever remain the~~ ~~they knew to be the~~ ~~Jews~~ ~~and so they, but then~~ ~~ancestors, in all the sad and weary centuries of the exile, remained~~ ~~171,101~~, the prisoners of hope.

Those who hope in the ~~Lord~~, declared the prophet of the first exile, Isaiah, shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings as eagles." It is the ringing message of the Psalmist: "Wait for the Lord; be strong and let thy heart take courage. Yea, wait thou for the Lord." Twice is the phrase repeated: ~~"for I~~ ~~hope~~ The Midrash is quick to comment upon it. ~~After the~~ ~~hope~~ Hope after ~~life~~!

If you have hoped and have nevertheless not been delivered, hope yet again! And if you say: how long shall we hope, there is the answer in Ps. 131: "O Israel, hope in the Lord from this time forth and forever!"

And behold today this hope ~~is~~ ~~dark~~ ~~true~~ ~~is finally being fulfilled.~~ The hand of the avenger ~~desecrated~~ ~~burnt~~ ~~armies~~ has overtaken the assassin. His broken, bloody and ~~desecrated~~ ~~columns~~ are in headlong

flight. Death and destruction are raining down upon his retreating columns and his burning cities. He is fleeing in rout and disorder from the lands which he had conquered and wherein he had preened himself for so long on his might and prowess. He is ~~before you~~ <sup>m</sup>  
~~despots,~~ <sup>now</sup> ~~for peace,~~ fearful of the punishment of retributive justice which awaits him. This shameless regime faces annihilation and bottomless oblivion. But Israel, whose doom ~~he had decried,~~ <sup>now</sup> ~~Israel~~ though sorely wounded and deeply hurt is alive, rescued from the pit and the miry clay. Israel's feet are again set upon a rock. ~~For~~ In every land which is redeemed from the enemy, Israel is redeemed from slavery and death. And a new song is today in our mouths and hearts!

How different is this holyday season from that of previous years. It seems as though destiny <sup>had</sup> selected our Holy Day period in the last few years for world-shaking events. Recall September 1938! It was the month of "Munich," and the beginning of all political disasters which followed. With what <sup>beating</sup> hearts we watched through that fateful month, and ~~then on~~ <sup>through the</sup> Holy Day season the unfoldment of one of the most tragic dramas in all history -- the betrayal and dismemberment of Czecho-slovakia, the triumph of Hitlerism with the aid and backing of London and Paris, the collapse of the League of Nations and the break-down of Europe. Chamberlain was flitting about from London to Berchtesgarden and Godesberg, chattering about peace in our lifetime, but Europe had begun to dig trenches and fit gas masks.

That was during our Holyday season in September 1938.

In September 1939 -- the Second World War began! And we watched ~~again~~, even as we gathered in our places of worship, the lights going out all over Europe. Poland shattered and over-run in ~~that~~ one brief month, and the gallant but hopeless defense of Warsaw. ~~The~~ <sup>as we watched</sup> ~~blockade~~ <sup>had begun. The</sup> ~~blockade~~ <sup>again</sup> ~~and~~ <sup>of Europe</sup> ~~was attacked,~~ <sup>failure.</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>again</sup> ~~bombing of~~ <sup>as we watched</sup> ~~Europe had begun. The~~ <sup>again</sup> ~~blockade~~ <sup>and</sup> ~~embargo~~ <sup>had begun.</sup>

In September 1940, we were <sup>again</sup> tense and terribly apprehensive ~~for~~ London, nay the whole of England, ~~was~~ being subjected to the frightful all-out bombing from the air.) No city had ever taken such punishment. How long could London take it? Paris had fallen some months before and France had capitulated. ~~The~~ Dunkirk had witnessed

the British army beaten but miraculously evacuated. The air was full with ominous

rumours of the coming invasion of England. The British Empire was fighting for its very life, alone, with its back to the wall. This was in September, 1940.

September 1941 was no less tense. Russia was now in the war, but its armies were being beaten on every front. The Nazis were driving deep into Russia. They were in the Crimea and at the gates of Leningrad. The Russians suffered that month a disastrous defeat at Kiev. On October 3, Hitler announced triumphantly to the world: "Russia is already broken and will never rise again." His press chief proclaimed: "For all military purposes Soviet Russia is done with. The British dream of a two front was now dead." It looked very black for the United Nations in September 1941.

And not much brighter in September 1942! Rommel was at the gates of Alexandria. He stood poised at Alamein, after having chased the British forces clear across the whole of North Africa. The fall of Egypt would have opened Asia, the Near East, and Palestine to the Nazis, even India for a possible junction there with the Japanese. And the Siege of Stalingrad began just about that time, too, <sup>a</sup> ~~which~~ was to mean survival or extinction for Russia. A Million men were locked in that life and death grapple, <sup>and</sup> ~~men~~ fought hand to hand, from house to house, and inch by inch. Everything was in the scale on that fateful month of September 1942.

It was a happier Holyday season for us last September -- September 1943. The Allies were invading Italy. There was tense, bitter fighting on the beaches of Salerno in September 1943. But Italy was out of the war, and Russia, having drained the life-blood of the Wehrmacht at Stalingrad, was victoriously launching her own counter-offensive which within a year was to drive the invader completely out of Soviet territory and advance the Russian forces to the <sup>Very</sup> gate of Warsaw and the borders of Germany.

And now, thank God, we are in the month of September 1944! And what a glorious month it is! What epoch-making events have taken place during the last few weeks -- are taking place today. Our victorious armies are invading Germany! France, Belgium ~~Holland~~ have been liberated. The Nazis' Allies and satellite states have one by one deserted <sup>her</sup> ~~them~~. They and their <sup>former</sup> ~~wright~~, and their boasts and their lies are being

Lights are going on in England to-night - and all over the world  
beaten into the dust. Europe is liberated! The end of this evil, shameless regime  
~~the world and our own~~ Nazi  
which caused ~~our~~ people so much suffering, blood and tears is ~~here!~~ <sup>in sight!</sup> We are looking  
~~peace to us~~ forward to the return of our sons, brothers, husbands from the camps and battle zones  
to our homes, to blessed reunion and calmer happy days.

*God to the home front*

For the first time in many years, now, we come to our Holyday season with no  
load of sorrow ~~and~~ upon our ~~shoulders~~ hearts. Rather, restored in the strength of  
vindication, ~~redemption~~ and new hope, there is today a new song on our lips! And a  
prayer: -- the ancient prayer of thanksgiving:

The cords of death encircled me;  
The tortures of Sheol found me;  
I found trouble and sorrow;  
But I called upon the name of the Lord.  
O Lord deliver me....  
Verily Thou hast delivered me from death  
Mine eyes from tears  
My foot from stumbling  
I will now walk before the Lord  
In the lands of the living.



Dear Friends! *keep in remembrance*  
Let us ~~remember~~ the text of the Psalms *now* the text of these fearful years and  
*Courage, patience, faith!*  
never forget its message in the oncoming years. Much lies ahead of hope and promise  
for us, for mankind, but also much of what will try the patience and the fortitude  
of men's souls. The problems of peace will not be simple. The tasks of reconstruction  
and world organization will not be easy. Our world, ~~will enter~~ immediately after the  
~~will enter~~ armistice, a difficult and dangerous period of convalescence. Nations ~~we coming~~ come  
out of the war rent, shaken and shattered economically and spiritually. The passions  
of men will run high in the bitterness of defeat; in the hate, <sup>w</sup> revenge, in rivalry, in  
~~and~~ real or imaginary wrongs. At home we shall experience severe tests ~~in finding~~ <sup>as we try to</sup>  
~~the way~~ to direct and control our production system for <sup>and to</sup> as we had for war,  
how to maintain full production and general distribution and how to avoid inflation,  
depression and unemployment. There will be strong economic tension between labor and

management, which even war could not entirely ~~solve~~, obviate  
as we confidently hope

In these approaching years, before the world finally settles down to a long period of political and economic stability and spiritual equilibrium we should remember to keep our courage up and our hopes unflagging, our minds cool and free from passions and fears, lest we repeat the disastrous folly of the years immediately following the last war — when in spiritual fatigue we ran away from the hard responsibilities of post-war reconstruction. We tired of war and of Europe, we wearied of ideals and noble purposes. We were disgusted and because all things did not turn out as we had expected, we wrote everything off as a bad job. We turned our back upon the League <sup>and</sup> upon the World Court, upon the vision of a united world. ~~We~~ returned to what we fondly hoped would be normalcy and quiet and peace for us. ~~But~~ We achieved no normalcy, but disastrous economic inflation and a restless armistice which was only a prelude to another world war in which we were again involved. We despaired of a better world. International relations forever doomed to remain in the reeking pit of intrigue and treachery and in the miry bloody clay of war. "For the winning of peace, ~~someone~~ truly declared, the same great virtues are needed as for the winning of war -- courage, ~~loyalty~~, discipline and ~~enduring~~ endurance." Let us never forget it.

As Jews, we should bear in mind that the end of Nazism will not end all our problems. Much of the dragon seed which the Nazis have sown all over the world will remain. Their damnable heritage will persist, and will make itself manifest from time to time in various ugly forms ~~and other~~. We have suffered severely. We have been set back a generation or more. We have lost many positions. There is no doubt about it. It of fighting back will take years to recover our former status, here and elsewhere. It can be done! But it will take a statesmanship ~~and courage~~ of a high order to accomplish it. And fearless loyalty, and pride in ourselves as Jews, and the intelligent exercise of our rights as free citizens in this blessed land.

We should not repeat the follies of the generations of Jews in Western Europe

The lesson of the recent events is that we must  
let us fight hard now for a just peace, and for the creation  
of a world organization which will insure peace for us and our  
children. It can be done! It is not beyond the capacity of man!  
There must be no repetition of that selfishness, that imperialism,  
that insincerity, that isolationism, that bloated nationalism,  
that wrecked the hopes of the world after the last war.  
Let there be an upsurge again of militant idealism,  
~~and~~ revolutionary faith in ~~and~~ man, in humanity, —

the children. There is room for all and food for all  
and much else besides. Courage to plan for a new  
order that ~~from~~ from freedom of abundance for all — ~~that~~  
~~is~~ and ~~for~~ above in the achieving of it and faith  
in the certainty of its achievement — that is the challenge  
to day a new enter the era of reconstruction.



who thought that by denying themselves ~~on~~ their Jewish allegiances, by assimilation and by loss of identity cultural or religious, they could evade anti-Semitism and thus solve the Jewish problem. It all ended in bloody bankruptcy. There is no protective coloration for Jewish ~~immunities~~ anywhere in the world. Assimilation and anonymity are worthless weapons. There is no security for us in wishful thinking in offering the world unrealistic definitions of ourselves ~~as~~. The world is not taken in by them. The world knows us as an historic people, not as a religious sect or a ~~group~~ - a distinctive group regardless of factors which helped to make it a ~~peculiar~~ <sup>only</sup> denomination; and as such we shall have to win for ourselves a secure and honored place <sup>to stand</sup> in the world.

in the future as in the past  
We shall continue to live as a distinctive minority group in the world and ~~wish~~ <sup>w shall</sup> be so recognized by the world whether some of us ~~wish~~ <sup>like</sup> it or not; and we shall have to defend our right to such an existence in full dignity and equality along with all other minority groups, religious, or racial in democratic society.

Our ~~second~~ tasks lie before us. We must unite with all men of good-will everywhere to champion and defend the right of all peoples, all over, all ~~nations~~, <sup>all nationalities</sup> in a world of just and equitable laws. The right to live, to work, to share ~~eq~~ in the ~~fair~~ democratic opportunities of education, and in the ~~rights~~ <sup>privileges</sup> and responsibilities of citizenship - that we must fight for on all fronts for all men, if we wish to make this secure for ourselves.

We must also with will our fellow-Jews every where to ~~lead~~ <sup>lead</sup> the world <sup>to</sup> what the world <sup>is</sup> expects upon an people - to rebuild shattered communities, reunite scattered families, care for the widows, orphans, assist in the economic ~~rehabilitation~~ <sup>restoration</sup> of fellow-Jews wherever possible, reopen their schools and academies and revivify their spiritual life.
