3) Memorial Service would tell us - needless, disturbed

4/- When the tomb of a Roman lady, who died over 2000 years

One I leave behind me alive, the other I buried
in his youth.

I served my household. I spun my wool.

while ^{was} hard to define exactly - not difficult to ~~understand~~ ^{see their meaning}
- Inherent in term is the idea of 'separation'
- a form of life which is different - = לִּישׁוּב אֲחֵר

- Separated from what? First place - from the low standards - abominations of the heathen ^{לענות ממש} among whom our ancestors found los.

- Bible - לֹא תִלְכוּ אַחֲרֵי עֲשֵׂוֹת הָעַמִּים - ^{their abominations - human sacrifices - cruel} ye shall not walk in the customs of the nations which I am casting out before you, for they did all these things, and therefore I abhorred them... But ye shall be holy unto me, for I the Lord am holy, and have set you apart from the peoples..."

- The Israelites ^{writes} writes Prof. Loeb of the Sorbonne in his great classic study of ancient Israel - (Quint)

→ It was not much different in later times - in the pagan days of Greece and Rome. The moral practices and standards in Rome were shockingly low - the bloody arenas - the ~~the~~ cruel treatment of slaves - the licentious - + moral corruption.

- Israel knows their faith - Yehovah God - See author of moral law - demand called for a sharp

- break with these mores of the heathen & the pagan
- J. ethics was a revolu. ethics - original, indep. diff
- Our ancestors were admonished not to be submerged - dragged down
- not to isolate - be submerged - dragged down
- coarseness - cheapness - brutality.

5/ And "holiness" implied "separation" in yet another sense
 - To separate ourselves from ourselves - under impulses

- degrade us - and rise to higher levels

- It meant obeying whole moral law - but more!

→ We must obey - even when it involves struggle hardship

- We must obey - without expectations rewards for ourselves

- We must practice holiness - in matters permitted - Ford - Drink - Jews etc

- Holiness has to do with "the something new"
restraint - restraint - restraint - modesty

6/ Holiness requires us to do the right with a great searching of heart - ^{generosity of spirit} and to look upon all things as "Vessels of holiness".

- We do not know where it came - nor when - nor why
- From what mysterious realm did it emerge - and to what end?
Some have called ^{it} life - a dream - a myth - a game
a joke - a tragedy - a disaster

"Life is but a walking shadow - comes from Macbeth - a poor player that struts and frets his hour upon the stage - and then is heard no more. It is a tale told by ^{an} idiot, full of sound and fury, signifying nothing"

- That the play called Macbeth - is not a tale told by an idiot, full of sound and fury, signifying nothing"
- It is the masterpiece of ^{the human} mind - an exquisite artistic expression of the creature's life in man.

Life is holy - says Judaism - and "life is meat - and a pleasant thing it is for the eyes to behold the sun"
And because it is holy and precious and sweet - it should not be wasted or idled away, frittered away
Life is too great for petty things
Men pray for a long life. They should also pray for a deeper life.

There are many whose years are long but ^{whose days are} empty
A good life is three dimensional. It has length and
breadth and depth.

Because life is holy - it should be revered especially in
the afflicted, the weak, the aged, ~~the~~ in all who are
in need, or have been beaten in the battle of life.

To be cruel is to be guilty of murder.

8/ Life is holy and every individual human life is holy.

1st single human being - to emphasize the importance

- The dangerous trend of our day is to lose the man in the
multitude. - to sacrifice the rights, the ind. to the
demands of the State or society.

It is more a trend - engulfed 1/2 the world.
- There are saufant opinions and immoral philosophies,
which would deprive men of their inherent and
inviolable human rights and make them the slaves
and puppets of a Nietzschean Superman or an
Hegelian absolutist state or a Marxian proletarian
dictatorship. There are plenty of heresies
aboundant.

The good society must make possible the freedom
and justice for all men and for the good society.

Cooperation among men, ^{conscious and voluntary} is one of mankind's noblest ^{of its} achievements & (6) as characteristic and as important as speech and thought.
~~Cooperation~~ ^{Cooperation} and repentance are evils which desecrate life.

9) The mind, man is holy (and is) as great a mystery as life itself.

It is man's pre-eminence in creation.
The humblest mind is a higher form of being & stars

What use do we make it?

Some use it as God intended it to be used - ~~for thinking~~ ^{to think}
~~auto reasoning~~ - ~~for learning~~ and study - ~~to acquire~~ ^{to acquire} knowledge and wisdom and truth which make a man free.

Some minds look ~~to~~ ^{to} the ~~world~~ ^{universe} as to a marvellous university - where every place is a class-room - all ^{voices in} nature a faculty of inspiring teachers - and the ~~so~~ earth and the fullness thereof - a crowded library of exacting revelations.

Others use their minds as a write-paper basket and fill it with stuff and non-sense, with superstitions and prejudices - and with dull, repetitive trifles. They allow these ^{keen blades of their} intellects to rust.

Organized societies and government have in some instances developed a technique for undermining the human mind. It is called propaganda - a gross form of intellectual defilement.

10/ Wife - Marriage - Home are holy!
They mature and enrich human life - only as they are looked upon and revered as holy.

- It is a spiritual force ~~which is a thing of a~~
quality of adoration and personal devotion, which makes love something more than infatuation, and warmth something more than an arrangement, and the home something more than a house.

- If reverence is there - all is there! If it is not there - there is little there that will sustain and endure & endure

11) And so the call of an Holy Day - Y.K. - is "Worship the Lord in the beauty of Holiness".

~~On the other hand,~~th Israelite writers of every period agree that among the Canaanites, family ties were lightly regarded, the paternal authority was flouted, while in the matter of sexual morality, liberty was carried to the extent of licence.

The depravity of the Canaanites was notorious: witness the vices attributed to the inhabitants of Sodom and Gomorrah, the reason alleged for their destruction by the fire of Jahweh.

The very religion of the Canaanites, with its bloody ritual, its female deities, its frequent ceremonial orgies, the halo of sanctity with which it surrounded prostitution, all tended to foster licence rather than to eradicate it.
