Statement for European Relief Council, 1921.

No nobler task now confronts the American people than that of saving the lives of the starving children of Eastern Europe. No cause is more vital to the future welfare of the race, or more immediate and essential in the work of restoring Europe to ~~normal~~ conditions of life.

The American people, responsive at all times to the call of the needy, will not now fail in this fateful emergency.
