June 22nd 1851. —

We can say less on the watershed that we have builded well for years and decades, and let us hope for generations-

evening. There is one thing which we have

alone will enable us to dedicate this structure
next Sabbath with a free heart, and joy and
happiness - We must free this Temple of
debt - of all debt, of every debt - We
must not begin our great work in this
here, burdened with debt, hampered and

reduced at every step in our expansion - by
the ever-present ~~overseas~~ financial cares
and worries. We do not wish to be compelled
to appropriate a very large part of our income
which should go into more extensive and ex-
pensive educational and rel. work - for us to meet
interest charges. Nor do we ^{we} wish to be compelled
at any future time to launch additional
campaigns for funds. That is ~~an~~ very affairs
at best - a waste of effort - and an unprofitable
nuisance -

4. You committee, after almost 6 months of
thorough, painstaking and thoughtful labor, has
evolved a plan whereby this could be
effected, simply, speedily and without
harmship to any one - They have submitted
their scheme to you - If their plans come,
if the seats of in this Temple ~~are~~ so
classified and priced as you desire
adequately are sold, we shall be out of
debt to-night. Our annual budget will
be provided for, our future assured and
you will forever be freed from ~~any~~
further whitewash ^{or trouble} on the part of the Temple.

The financial burdens ~~should~~ ^{those} be placed upon
the shoulders ^{those} most able to bear them. They
we deal at ^{with} it most reverent impress. for
men bornen of modest means to be members
here, and to own fees in our Temple. Even
a hasty perusal ^{of} the chart will ^{show you} ~~convince~~
~~you~~ that the interests the com. has protec-
ted the interest of the average man of modest
means - The men who have been blessed
by God with means of the world's goods
will in their fee-will offering bring more
to the altar's foot. They ^{have} done so in
the past, freely, generously. They will do so now.
