


The Camp will be in full operation and visitors will be accorded an opportunity to inspect the grounds and buildings and see the children at play.

HOW TO REACH CAMP WISE BY AUTO

Via State Route No. 2 thru Willoughby and Painesville



Miles

- 0.0 Cleveland. From Public Square go straight east on Superior Av. 5.5 Turn Left onto Euclid Av.
- 10.0 Euclid. Straight.
- 13.6 Wickliffe. Straight.
- 13.0 Wicknine. Straight.
- 18.6 Willoughby. Turn Right at xsts and cross new bridge.

Miles

- 22.5 W. Mentor. Straight.
- 23.1 Mentor. Straight.
- 27.1 Cross RR.
- 28.6 Painesville. Center of town ahead. Bear Left at 5-corners and straight thru xsts.

Miles

- 30.2 Cross long bridge and turn Left at end under RR. bridge. Then follow paved road curving Right.
- 31.6 Turn Left at xrds at first road past Stows and Harrison greenhouses. Follow dirt road straight to
 33.0 Camp Wise.
- All roads are either paved or recently scraped and cindered.
