

BIBLE READING (Hebrew)	

For hundreds of years the Jew has availed himself of the educational institutions of higher learning established by other people. Through the establishment of the Hebrew University, the Jew is beginning to pay his indebtedness to the world. At a time when many of the universities of Europe are in the grip of national chauvenism and are excluding hundreds of Jewish students, our Hebrew University is being opened to welcome, not only all Jewish men and women who are eager for knowledge but all people of whatever race or creed. The beginnings of this university are of course humble. Its possibilities for some time to come will be quite haturally circumscribed. But its promises are vast and epoch-making. The Hebrew University, through its scientific research departments and cultural contributions may bring about the revival of the whole Near East which once upon a time was a great cultural center of mankind. It will surely stimulate Jewish life throughout the world, setting up higher standards and inspiring Jews with a higher sense of dignity and selfrespect. It is evidence that we have not yet spent our intellectual and spiritual reservoirs; that we are not merely a people of the past and present, but also a people of the future.

We arenow laying the foundations of our Empire, - an Empire not of force or violence. Our sovereignty will be of the heart and mind, our tributaries of truth and our dominion of sacrificial service.
