Confirmation addresses, circa 1920s-1957.

1. This year, you children have called myself &c. You are now about to enter upon the estate of young men. Look forward - You are children no longer - but as far as the duties of the old life - well known now - As far as all other concerns, life - more widely - more open to yourselves - Use the words of Jesus however more your own master -

"While the last of your parents will shield you in the future as it did in the past - & allow you their life - you will nevertheless from now on - be thrown more & more upon your resources - You will be called upon to make your own decisions to solve your own problems, to accept the consequences of your own acts - life will become a little more serious and exacting, your path to you, more rugged will be given you to carry - more duties to perform -

2. This day is, in a measure in your life, the end of a period which is gone past recall. Be beginning of another which is hid in the future - You will believe us, when we say, that our deepest wishes go with you on your ~~journey~~^{trip} to-day upon the second stage of your journey. May the road not be hard and unsmooth. It is bound to be uneven; full & at times it will be broken & stony. beset with pitfalls or obstacles. May you surmount them all. & May your arrival at the close, the day of your life, at the end of the road - a happy transfigured Friend.

1. What am I blessing you for in the few moments. I should like to recall to you what a phrase of the Rabbi - recited here this morning - P. Keren said. There are 3 crowns, "the Crown of the Torah (1) The Crown of priesthood (2), the Crown of Royalty but the Crown of a good name excels them all —

1. There is a world of soundest plib. here & profound under & deep - there crowns are not & even to be taken literally. said, "we will pursue two obvious and simultaneous courses: we will extend to the opponents of force the material resources of this nation and at the same time we will harness and speed up the use of those resources in order that we ourselves in the Americas may have equipment and training equal to the task of any emergency and every defense."

The latter utterance was the President's only reference to plans for compulsory universal military training for which he already has expressed sympathy and which have been gaining in popularity during the past fortnight. He had withheld release of his address until after hearing Premier Mussolini's war declaration and revised the text accordingly.

After characterizing an America isolated from a world dominated by the policy of force as a prison into which its liberty loving people would be thrust by the defeat of France and Great Britain, the President said this country must now concern itself with how to prevent the building of that prison and the incarceration of its population.

"Let us not hesitate—all of us," he added, "to proclaim certain truths. Overwhelmingly we, as a nation, and this applies to all the other American nations, we are convinced that military and naval victory for the gods of Force and Hate would endanger the institutions of democracy in the Western world; and that equally, therefore, the whole of our sympathies lie with those nations which are giving their life blood in combat against those forces."

American Future at Stake, He Says

"Once more the future of the nation and of the American people is at stake," the President said. "The program unfolds swiftly and into it will fit the responsibility and the opportunity of every man and woman to preserve our heritage in days of peril."

To do otherwise was to entertain "the now obvious delusion that we of the United States can safely permit the United States to become a lone island in a world dominated by the abominations."

Following is the text of President Roosevelt's address to the graduating class of the University of Virginia at Charlottesville yesterday as recorded and transcribed from a radio broadcast by THE NEW YORK TIMES:

President Newcomb, my friends of the University of Virginia,

I notice by the program that I am asked to address the classes of 1940. I avail myself of that privilege, but I also take this very happy occasion to speak to many other classes—classes that have graduated through all the years, classes that are still in the period of study, classes not alone of the schools of learning of the nation, but classes that have come up through the great schools of experience. In other words, a cross-section, a cross-section just as you who graduate today are a cross-section of the nation as a whole.

Every generation of young men and women in America has questions to ask the world. Most of the time they are the simple but nevertheless difficult questions—questions of work to do, opportunities to find, ambitions to satisfy.

But every now and again in the history of the republic a different kind of question presents itself—a question that asks, not about the future of an individual or even of a generation, but about the future of the country, the future of the American people.

There was such a time at the beginning of our history, at the beginning of our history as a nation. Young people asked themselves in those days what lay ahead, not for themselves, but for the new United States.

There was such a time again in the seemingly endless years of the war between the States. Young men and young women on both sides of the line asked themselves, not, what trades or professions they would enter, what lives they would make, but what was to become of the country they had known.

There is such a time again today. Again today the young men and the young women of America ask themselves with earnestness and with deep concern this same question: "What is to become of the country we know?"


