A play and a prologue in five acts.

Disillusion with Revolution which achieves only capitalistic democracy.

Seven indictments of fickleness of the mob.

The struggle between the Right, Center and the Left; Nazis, Bolshevick and the Liberals.

A series of episodes rather than a drama



ERNST TOLLER THE MACHINE-WRECKER

A drama of the English Luddites in a prologue and five acts.

Labor's struggle against the machine.

The Bind revolution which wreaks disillusion upon the machine (Ned Lub) against a real revolution of the mastering of the machine by the working man (Jimmy Cobbet).

Searching analysis of the mind of the masses changes frequently. Its own worst enemies easily mis-led.

Play in prose and poetry.

The terrible poverty of the English weavers in 1815 dramatically portrayed.

The beggar is very much like Shakespeare's "Fool" -- or like the Greek "Chorus."

The mob kills the true revolutionary (Jimmy Cobbet.)

MAN AND THE MASSES -- ERNST TOLLER (Masse Mensch)

A Play of the Social Revolution. Playwright of the proletariat -- Characters nameless -- Types.

Striking -- impressionistic -- symbolic -- so is stage setting.

There is a biography and introduction.

Theme -- The Humanitarian (symbolized by the woman) is opposed to both the war-built system (symbolized by the man) and the war-built revolution (symbolized by the nameless one). The humanist is victimized by both the State and the Revolution and is finally crushed.

The Humanitarian wishes to bring about a new world through a peaceful bloodless strike. (see pgs. 38 ff.)

Though still in his early thirties, - he was born in Vienna in 1881. Mr. Zurig has already achieved an enviable reputation as a lyric poet of distinction, as an able essayist & literary critic, & as a successful dramatist and short-story writer. The essentials qualities of this. Zweig's mend the enthusiasm generosity of appreciation, a tendence, to here-worship, and a franks and been zest in living accompanied by a desire to feel himself permeated by the spoint of his line of to health to que fitting and adequate expression to it. His style is rich and full, with a mailsed tendency towards the decorating. Olviously he is what Dr. Istwald would class as a "romantic" Naturally posses the defects of its qualities. The decorative element in his style tends towards the too profusely arnate or rococo, this glowing appreciation of other wens genus is apt to lack in discrimination.

The latter art at once menistered to his need of hero-worships and gave hem an incom parable command of language & facility in its use,

a service it has so often performed for men of letters, as in the case of hafcadio Hearn, for example. It was but a Doep from the interpretation of his hero's works to the writing of critical essays upon such congenial themes. His essays & monographo include studies of Dideens Balgac, Bandelaire, Verlaine, Reinband & Verhaeren. while all are sympathetic, it was in the last that he found his master. In Verhaeren his oand recognized a kindred spirit. His lengthy monograph upon the great Belgian writer established him as an authority. Thiswords, which has very recently been translated into Eng, very promptly appeared in French & was more widely read & appreciated in France than in ger. Juieg's earliest book of lyrica Silver Strings" vas Rublished uchen he was a mere youth. Later ap. peared some remarkable short stories, natably "The love of Erica Ewald" & the value called first Experience! The theme of the former is that of the woman who, in the wild pain of a scorned love, seeles a wed reverge in the castein of herself away, but is saved from her fally at the contined moment.
