I. HAVDALAH \_\_\_\_\_ Zilberts

The last moments of Queen Sabbath, before her departure at dusk, are moments of magic and longing. Soon the appearance of the "first star" will proclaim the end of the festive day. After the completion of a quaint religious ceremony (using wine, spices, and the Havdalah candle) the young people break into song and dance in honor of the new week.

II. PALESTINIAN ROMANCE \_\_\_\_ Goldfarb-Kadison

A Palestinian girl comes to draw water and meets her lover at the well. He persuades her to remove her yeil and dance for him. As night begins to fall, she is reminded of her mission and returns home.

III. IN BETH HAMEDRASH \_\_\_\_\_ Saminsky-Kadison

A student of the Talmud encounters a very difficult passage. His determined efforts lead to confusion. Finally, upon striking a solution, he forgets his academic restrictions and begins to celebrate in true chassidic form. His hilarity is interrupted by the fear of being discovered away from the book, and he returns to his studies.

IV. SHALACH MONOS \_\_\_\_\_ Traditional (Based on Sholom Alachim Theme)

A little girl is suddenly distracted from her childish pastime by the arrival of the "Purim Spieler" who come to enact the story of Purim. She plays the role of Queen Esther: she is called away by her mother and given a plate of Purim goodies to bring a neighbor. On the way, she finds Temptation too great for her.
