Honor Roll Dedication

11-1-42

From the midst of our congregation have gone forth these two hundred ^{and} fifty ^{two} men to serve their country.

They are our sons -- our husbands -- our brothers. They are our nearest and dearest, and our noblest.

They went forth eagerly to defend their beloved country in its grave hour of peril. They left home, their kith and kin, their careers in response to the call of duty and citizenship.

They are in all branches of the armed services of their country -- the Army, the Navy, the Air-Force.

They are now in nearly all the camps and training centers of our country. Many of them are already overseas, on all the far-flung fronts of the United Nations, on the five continents and the seven seas. Some of them have already seen action and have received their baptism of fire. Some have been wounded in battle. Others have been in imminent danger and have miraculously escaped. Two have laid down their lives for their country.

The Temple is proud to honor these valiant sons. On this Honor Roll are inscribed their names for everlasting and proud remembrance of brave men who bravely met the challenge of their day and their destiny.

Other names will be added as more of our sons join the armed forces of our country and go forth to battle in this cruel and bitter war ~~and there will be more~~ -- until the blessed day comes when the mortal foe of all mankind is finally destroyed and peace is vouchsafed our ravaged and suffering world.

This Honor Roll is Testament of their ^{of these men} loyalty and sacrifice, an earnest symbol of their patriotism, making manifest their supreme love of America. It enshrines the spirit of these brave, young American Jews, their love of country, their readiness to serve it, and their pride in that service.

It also radiates the spirit of the homes from which these young men have come -- the high sense of patriotic duty which was fostered by their parents and

kinsmen.

It is the symbol of a fulfilled pledge on the part of us all.

There is an electric cord which ^{stretches} ~~strikes~~ invisibly athwart the centuries and connects the Maccabees of old, in whose honor we kindle lights on ~~the~~ ^{our} Feast of Dedication, and these their descendants, the younger Maccabees, whose Table of Honor we dedicate in this sanctuary today. The same high courage which animated the champions of freedom in ancient Judea animates ^{these} their descendants to-day, the same faith in God and man, the same vision of a better day to come, fashioned out of struggle and sacrifice.

We salute these men. We pay them the tribute which is their just due. We dedicate this Honor Roll as a permanent and treasured Record to become part of our congregation's long and honored history.

We pray, silently and deeply in our hearts, for their safety and their safe and early return to us. We pray to the Father of all Nations, to prosper their arms and the arms which their country was constrained to take ^{up} to defend life and liberty and the threatened sanctuaries of mankind.

We pray, too, that we who remain behind, ~~in our homes~~, may find the strength and devotion to match theirs, and the courage to bear whatever burdens may be placed upon our shoulders. For this hour, so fraught with destiny, is summoning ~~all men~~ ^{young and old alike} ~~us all~~ to greatness, to renunciation and to sacrifice.
