destruction come upon the world:

Teach us, O God, to set Thee always before us;  
to find in Evil a challenge to our spirit, and  
in ~~the~~ prosperity a reminder to ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> helpful-  
ness and humility. Forgive the doubts which be-  
set us when we are overwhelmed by ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~sorrows~~  
~~the~~ violence and wickedness. ~~comfort us~~ - For thou  
knowest the inhabitants of our <sup>and the</sup> ~~earth~~ <sup>and the</sup> ~~heavens~~. Send us thy  
light and they <sup>will</sup> ~~turn~~ to pride us - Amen  
Bless all endeavors, <sup>wherever we may be</sup> left of the  
fallen to help the broken hearted, to break the chains of oppression  
and to bring light to them who dwell in darkness  
and in the <sup>and the</sup> ~~dark~~ shadows - Amen

1) 2 Versions Ps 14 = 53 - Theme - "The fool says in his heart the ~~ch-~~  
"Fool" - ~~counterfeiter~~ - lacks wisdom - the man who jumps at conclusions - makes hasty  
generalizations.

Why does not a man arrive at ~~#~~ his conclusion: "There is no God"?  
The second half, that verse gives the answer: Men act basely, they  
do abominable things. Then is now that does right.

And the 3rd verse: "All have strayed from the path, their souls  
are all polluted. Not a man does right - not one!"

① It is: the evil, the world, the gross injustice everywhere, the abomi-  
nable things which are <sup>in society</sup> common that compels the ignorant  
& rel. ignorant man to say: "There is no God!"

② Men become atheists, b.c. they cannot reconcile the existence  
of Evil with the existence of a just God.



3) This acute of profound exists, & causes, <sup>rather</sup> for the good man, ~~not~~ for  
the wicked.

The wicked man, as the Ps. says in another Ps. "in the pride of his countenance does not seek God. All his thought is: There is no God." He rejects God! He moves forward in his mischief, his deceit and his violence, ~~so~~ "singing the praises of his own desires", and confident ~~that~~ there is no God ~~to~~ who will find him out and punish him. — as Job ass-

But the good man - the poor man - is <sup>frequently</sup> ~~constantly~~ troubled by the fact ~~that~~ the righteous ~~is~~ often suffer, and ~~not~~ the wicked triumph over them. Once more again in the Ps. we hear <sup>sad</sup> plaintive cry: "My tears have been my meat day and night - while they continually say unto me: Who is they God"

3). "Wherefore do the wicked live, because old, wax mighty in power?  
Neither is the rule of God upon them... They spend their days  
in prosperity. Yet they say: ~~we do not know~~ 'We do not know  
~~why~~ they say: 'Who is the Almighty that we should serve  
Him'?"

4) This Ps. 14 - however, does not lose faith in God, because the  
righteous suffer, & the wicked prosper. He does not wish  
to harshly condemn! He is aware that his audience is  
fogmentary and mere chance. The finite, mortal man, is  
able to see only a fragment of reality, and only a minute  
part of the ~~arc~~ <sup>can</sup> of human experience. What perspective  
can he have as the ~~whole~~ <sup>can</sup> life of humanity? How far  
his vision extends? How deep ~~can~~ it penetrate?

@ Could ~~the~~ society really exist, as it has existed for  
thousands of years - if evil always triumphed? or if the  
Morons, Evil were weaker > of good? Evil is in essence  
Destabilization, disruption; It ~~can~~ make In anarchy &  
chaos. But mankind has been steadily, although painfully  
~~overcoming~~ emerging from chaos - constituting <sup>newness by</sup> social forms &  
organizing other's ways of cooperation life; ~~which~~ These are  
frequent their dark and disastrous lapses. But ~~it~~  
never fatal enough to stop permanently the  
Advancing - forward and upward. ~~It~~ Humanity has  
strayed <sup>advice</sup> lost hope form, organization. At the heart  
of all progress must be the struggle of Good! It is  
that which is finally triumphant!

(b) Therefore, the Ps. his faith was shaken, seeing in the evolution of  
human society evidence that depravity and corruption do  
not triumph in the end, is able to reply to the man who is  
hastily drawn to the conclusion - There is no God! "Verily  
God is with the righteous ~~race~~ generations. - The Lord is  
the refuge, the rock!"

- (c) The Universe is a planned Universe - physically and spiritually  
nature, as well as human society, have their <sup>one common</sup> source in God!  
- God is their common architect! ~~He~~ has laid down  
the eternal laws of growth and change which control them.  
- The laws operate in such a way as to sustain the  
Universe - not to destroy it. God intended the world  
then to be inhabited, has human life to improve & develop.  
- Sorrow in the fact of progress & improvement is the fact  
of evil, inadequacy & want, from which ~~as~~ human life is to  
move forward. Human suffering, physical and moral, is thus  
part of the plan determined by an all-wise God for the progress  
of man - without which progress itself would have no  
meaning. All that has stood buster on human life - and  
given dignity to human existence, sacrifice, art,  
sorrows, disease & suffering, have been successive  
examples of man's ignorance, fear, superstition, desire,  
want and dunder - Evils' all, then!

- 5). The religious man; bears patiently the afflictions which <sup>they</sup> may  
be visited upon him - b.c. of his Faith in a God & his God.  
However God's ways may not at all times be comprehensible  
to him - but he does not in his ignorance or litteracy - "There is no God"

He will regard the ~~the~~ evil, Cainus Whity, has not as few (4)  
of God's importunities or his non-existence - but as first challenge to  
him - as God's memory - to mighty effort to overcome that  
evil!

He will look upon personal sorrows & tragedies not as evidence  
of God's indifference, or the cruelty - but as testing, as filtering  
our spirit thru trials, as purging our dross in the  
fiery furnace - <sup>thus</sup> The Ps. was able to say: - "I thank the  
Lord, that It is good for me that I was afflicted,  
that I might learn thy statutes" 15:3, 17 1/2 10  
T.P.D. 3<sup>rd</sup>, p. 11. "I knew, O Lord, that they persecuted  
me right - and that in good path has thou afflicted me"



- 6) World to-day. War ravaging the earth. Slaughter + terror + brutality.  
So many innocent lives destroyed. So much labor + men  
squandered + wasted. So much play + ruin + chaos -  
So many wicked to say - Surely, there is no God!  
- But, shamed enough, those who are closest to the  
heat of this desolation to the dangers, perils + death  
[war] - are best of all men welcomed to cry out - There  
is no God -  
- Rather - It is for God, that they cry out! - for his  
help. his warnings. his counsel, his sheltering arms.  
- They need God!  
- For the greater the shame + turmoils + tribulations of  
our lives the more we need our faith in God.

7) Faith is not a luxury! It is a desperate need for man involved in great undertakings, in mighty enterprises, in experiences which try their <sup>very</sup> heart and reins. ~~Faith is Power!~~

- There are many forms of faith - the most fundamental - faith in God but no significant living or undertaking or adventure is possible without Faith. (Judeo p60). Pres. Lowell of Harvard.

8) And the man man refuses to the challenge of the Evil in the world - the more he gives himself to the ~~stupor~~ vagabondries of the saint, the more keenly does he become aware that there ~~is~~ is God! For he ~~can~~ <sup>comes to feel</sup> that God has wrought him out!

Then the best that is in us - then our noblest aspirations do become conscious of ~~God~~ <sup>the greater</sup>

For then - the most convincing proof for the existence of God - is the goodness in man! the qualities of selfless devotion, love, sacrifice, pity, generosity - the qualities which ~~the~~ man <sup>traversed</sup> the physical in him and makes touches divinity.

It was Immanuel Kant: "Two things fill him with awe: the starry heavens above and the moral law within"

Man can find God in Nature - in the arrangement, order, majesty of Nature. This is the person's point

But even more so can man find God - ~~\* the testimony~~  
of his Being - in the release, their moral energies - in the doing of things great and good - for the have who
