12. I recommend to friends & foes alike to read a page of our history, found in the Bible, and connected with our first restoration after the Babylonian exile. It is as fresh and reverberating to-day as it was 2500 years ago - When ~~it was~~ Hebrews wrote it

in his diary. The walls of Jerusalem had to be rebuilt. (9)
The exiles who had returned lived precariously in midst
of other peoples in Judea - who were determined to keep

And the symbol of that was the rebuilding, the walls of Jeru-

Samballat the Samaritan, Tobiah the Ammonite, and Geshem
the Arabian were grieved when they heard that there was
now a man (Nehemiah) to seek the welfare, the children of
Israel.

At first, when Jews began to build, "they laughed them to
scorn and despised them."

"What can these feeble Jews do? Will they revive the stones
out of the heaps of rubbish?"

Tobiah, the Ammonite, who had no business there in the
first place, any more than I have said to-day, expressed
the thought that "even that which they build, if a fox
go up, he shall break down their stone wall".

But Nehemiah went on with the building. And to the ladies
(the ladies he declared. p. 111, 125, 133) plus the poor
(same answer -)

And when these enemies saw that the rebuilding¹⁰ ^(Fa)_B went forward and the breaches began to be stopped - they conspired to come and fight against Jerusalem and to lay it waste.

Then Nehemiah organized his ^{3 יְהוָה}!

"And it came to pass from that time forward that half of my men carried on with the work and half of them held the spears, the shields and the bows and the coats of mail .. Everyone with one hand carried on with his work and with the other held his weapon..."

It was only after the work was finished, and the stone wall was built that Sanballat and his friends decided to invite Nehemiah to a "Round Table". 4 and 5 times they invited him and even offered him assistance. They were ready to negotiate, now that the wall was built.

I suggest that history may repeat itself in connection with our second restoration, provided we remain true to the spirit of this-hearted Nehemiah - and when we hear the challenge ^{3 יְהוָה} so, we respond as did the Jews of his day - ^{3 יְהוָה} פִלְפַל !

Dr. Silver's Statement

Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, President of the Zionist Organisation of America, reaffirmed the pro-labour stand of his Organisation in an address before 3,000 Zionists at a mass meeting in New York.

can Zionism wants to capture the Jewish Agency Executive and other supreme bodies of the movement.

"We have never sought domination and do not seek it now. We have always stood for a genuine partnership between all the creative and constructive forces in Zionism. We stand for such a true partnership today. We extend our hand in friendship, in a spirit of comradeship to all groups that have a vital contribution to make. We are convinced that such a partnership is possible, without the domination of any particular group or party and without the suppression of the principles which they hold dear. It is our purpose to help bring about such a stable and fruitful coalition of forces at the forthcoming Congress.

"Another question asked is whether we approve the social and economic policies pre-

vailing in Palestine labour with regard to the upbuilding of the country. The social and economic pattern of the Yishuv must be determined primarily by the Yishuv itself. ZOA President Denounces Anti-Labor Charges

Statement by

Dr. ABBA HILLEL SILVER

I have been asked about my attitude towards Palestine labor. There is scarcely a Zionist in America who does not appreciate the tremendous contribution Jewish labor in Palestine has made to the growth of the Jewish State. It has been creative, far-sighted and imbued with an admirable spirit of self-sacrifice.

The ZOA has been traditionally pro-labor. We have given and continue to give our full moral and material support to the great constructive efforts of Jewish labor in Palestine. That does not mean a blanket approval of every policy and every measure proposed by Labor Zionism but it does imply a basically sympathetic attitude on our part. Nor does our positive attitude towards labor imply a lack of appreciation of the great and constructive achievements of other sections of the Yishuv and indifference to their needs and legitimate interests. As General Zionists we stand for a balanced and comprehensive program of development.

Another question asked is whether we approve the social and economic policies prevailing in Palestine labor with regard to the upbuilding of the country. The social and economic pattern of the Yishuv must be determined primarily by the Yishuv itself. It cannot and must not be imposed from the outside. But the political future of Palestine is a matter of concern to the Jewish people the world over. It is the concern of the Zionist movement as a whole. To be sure, to the extent to which the World Zionist Organization and the Jewish Agency for Palestine, representing the whole Jewish people, influence the development of the Yishuv—to that extent the policies pursued become the proper subject for discussion and regulation by the World Zionist Congress. Worthless Pledges

When the new anti-Zionist policy of the British Government was announced in 1939, Winston Churchill declared that it was a clear breach, a violation of a pledge. When he became Prime Minister, however, he did nothing to honor that pledge, while six million Jews perished because the doors of Palestine were closed to them in defiance of obligations voluntarily assumed by Great Britain when it requested and received the Mandate over Palestine to facilitate Jewish immigration into that country and to assist in the establishment there of the Jewish National Home.

When the Labor Government came into power in 1945 it lost no time in breaking a solemn pledge of its own, this time one which was made by the Labor Party itself, which time and again passed strong pro-Zionist resolutions and demanded the abrogation of the White Paper of 1939.

When Prime Minister Attlee rejected President Truman's humanitarian request that 100,000 refugee Jews be permitted to enter Palestine at once, he made a counter-proposal that a joint Anglo-American Committee of Inquiry should be appointed to investigate the situation. The members of this Committee were told by the British Foreign Secretary, Mr. Bevin, that their recommendations would be implemented forthwith if they would be unanimous. The Committee unanimously recommended that 100,000 certificates be authorized immediately for the admission into Palestine of Jews who have been the victims of Nazi and Fascist persecution, and that these certificates be awarded as far as possible in 1946.

More Conditions

The President of the United States declared that he was very happy that the request which he had made had been unanimously endorsed by the Committee. He

urged that the transference of these unfortunate people should now be accomplished "with the greatest dispatch." But the British Government again wailed. Prime Minister Attlee called for the disarming of the Jews of Palestine as a prior condition, which condition the Committee had considered and rejected. He made other unwarranted conditions.

Mr. Bevin declared that "if we put 100,000 Jews into Palestine I would have to put another division of British troops there. I am not prepared to do it." This trumped-up military argument is again trotted out to justify another broken pledge. And this latest act is accompanied by Bevin's cheap slur on the American people and a coarse bit of anti-Semitic vulgarity reminiscent of the Nazis at their worst.

In view of this shocking record of broken pledges and the repeated violation of solemn obligations, American citizens have the right to turn to their representatives in the Congress of the United States, who are now discussing the granting of a loan to Great Britain, and inquire whether the Government of the United States can afford to make a loan to a Government whose pledged word seems to be worthless. They should also inquire whether American money, including that of the Jewish citizens of the United States who have given such superb evidence of their loyalty and patriotism during the war and whose sacrifices helped to save a collapsing British Empire, should be used to back up a Government whose Foreign Minister has repeatedly given evidence of a virulent anti-Jewish bias.

We question very much whether Mr. Bevin represents the conscience and the spirit of the British people but it is up to them to repudiate this maligner and cheap vulgarian, and to demand that someone who more truly represents them should occupy such an important post.
